



Johnson wins third feature of the season

It was a four-lap sprint to the end in the Late Model feature last week and Chris Johnson held on to win his third win of the season.

The Bloomfield driver led all 25 laps and held off a late charge by Tad Pospisil of Norfolk.

At the start of the feature, Johnson managed to pull away as Eric Vanosdall of Winside and Nelson Vollbrecht battled for second.

Vanosdall slid into to second after a couple laps as the high side proved to be the quickest.

As third through sixth positions sorted itself out, Johnson and Vanosdall pulled away.

By lap 12, Ben Sukup of Norfolk and Pospisil had moved into third and fourth, respectively.

As the two drivers reeled in Vanosdall, Pospisil successfully got by Sukup. Laps later Vanosdall got pinched behind a slow-

er car which allowed Pospisil to make the pass for second.

By this time, Johnson had close to a half-a-lap lead. With six laps remaining, the lead was erased as the first of two cautions came out.

On the restart, Johnson managed to move away again as second and third place cars of Pospisil and Vanosdall raced side-by-side.

However, two laps later the caution was thrown again.

This time on the restart, Pospisil got a good jump on the restart and managed to get alongside Johnson through turns one and two. When they got to turns three and four, Pospisil tried a slide job, but could not get the grip needed out of turn four.

Johnson re-


gained the lead on the exit of turn four.

Johnson stuck to the cushion on the high side and pulled away as Pospisil looked for grip down low. Johnson quickly pulled away.

Johnson took his third win of the season and his eighth career feature win at the track.

Pospisil took second on his first appearance at the track. Vanosdall got back by Sukup and held off Jim Johnson of Plainview for third.

Jim Johnson was fourth and Sukup crossed fifth.

The Sport Compacts have gone sometimes weeks without a caution in the feature event, but last week there were three cautions before completing one lap.

The scariest came from Dylan Kesting who struck the wall out of turn two before rolling several times and stopping on his roof.

As the race got started for a fourth time, Shannon Pospisil of Norfolk got to turn one first and paced the rest of the field for the 10-lap feature.

Ramsey Meyer of Pierce, who has won the first nine features at the track, tried everything he could to get by

Pospisil.

On the final two laps, Meyer dipped under Pospisil in turn one, but his car pushed.

Pospisil took his first win of the season and his sixth top 5. Meyer was second for his 10th top 5.

Parker Vollbrecht of Stanton grabbed a third-place finish, the only driver to score a win last season besides Meyer.

Tanner Uehling of Norfolk took his ninth top 5, finishing fourth. Rounding out the top 5 was Bristol Arneson of Norfolk. It was his first top 5 of the season.





Robbie Thome of Spalding slipped passed TJ Wallingford of Bellwood four laps from the finish to take third place.


Joey Haase of Norfolk slipped in fourth place passing Wallingford as they took the white flag.
