Meyer returns to victory lane

It was a last lap pass by Pierce's Cameron Meyer to pick up his first win of the season.

But it was a dog fight to the end.

The previous winner, Jonathan Jensen of Norfolk, led the first nine laps and had opened a slight lead on the field.

However, a caution bunched the field. On the restart, Jensen had a slow start and allowed Wes Hochstein of Randolph to take over the top spot.

Another caution slowed the field and this time Hochstein had a bad start and allowed Meyer to grab the lead.

Meyer led for two laps before Hochstein recaptured the lead.

After taking the white flag, Meyer drove hard into turn one on the inside of Hochstein. The car gripped and the two drag

raced down the backstretch.

Meyer again drove deep into the corner and again the car got the grip it needed.

One the exit of turn four, Meyer pulled ahead of Hochstein and took the win by a car length.

It was Meyer's first win of the season and his third-career win at the track.

Hochstein took second for his third top 5 of the season.

James Roebuck of Genoa watched the top 2 battle it out as he finished third.

Robbie Thome of Spalding took fourth and rounding out the top 5 was Jensen.
