Hochstein used the high side to get around Haase. Hochstein was able to open a gap from second when Haase, Robbie

Thome of Spalding and Kyle Prauner of Norfolk raced three wide.

Prauner nosed his way to second but was unable to chase down Hochstein.

Hochstein took the win and Prauner was second.

James Roebuck of Genoa got around Thome for third with four laps remaining. Thome finished fourth.

Rounding out the top 5 was Cameron Meyer of Pierce.

## Kyle Wilkinson scores second feature victory

Kyle Wilkinson took the lead on lap seven last week after Emerson's Hans Houfek led the first six circuits.

Houfek and TeJay Mielke of Norfolk battled behind Wilkinson for several laps before Mielke took the position and started putting pressure on the leader.

Wilkinson managed to maintain the lead to take his second win of the season.

With a couple laps remaining, Mielke started getting pressure from Austin Brauner of Platte Center.

Brauner got the pass completed in the final turn to take second at the checkered flag. It was Brauner's fourth runner-up finish this season.

Mielke took third as Houfek was fourth. Rounding out the top 5 was Tanner Pettitt of Norfolk.
