In the standings race for the 2019 season, three divisions are decided when they take the track and only the average number of cars start the feature.

Late Models

The closest race comes in the Late Model division as Robert Osborne of Norfolk made a late charge in the season to take a two-point lead over Ben Sukup of Norfolk.

Osborne has one win, four top 5s and has been in the top nine every week. He also has scored 16 points in his heat races throughout the season.

He also won title in the opening season at the track in 2015.

Sukup has two feature wins, six top 5s, has had two finishes outside the top 10. He has scored 13 points this season in the heat races.

Chris Johnson of Bloomfield is third in

points 12 points back from the leader.


