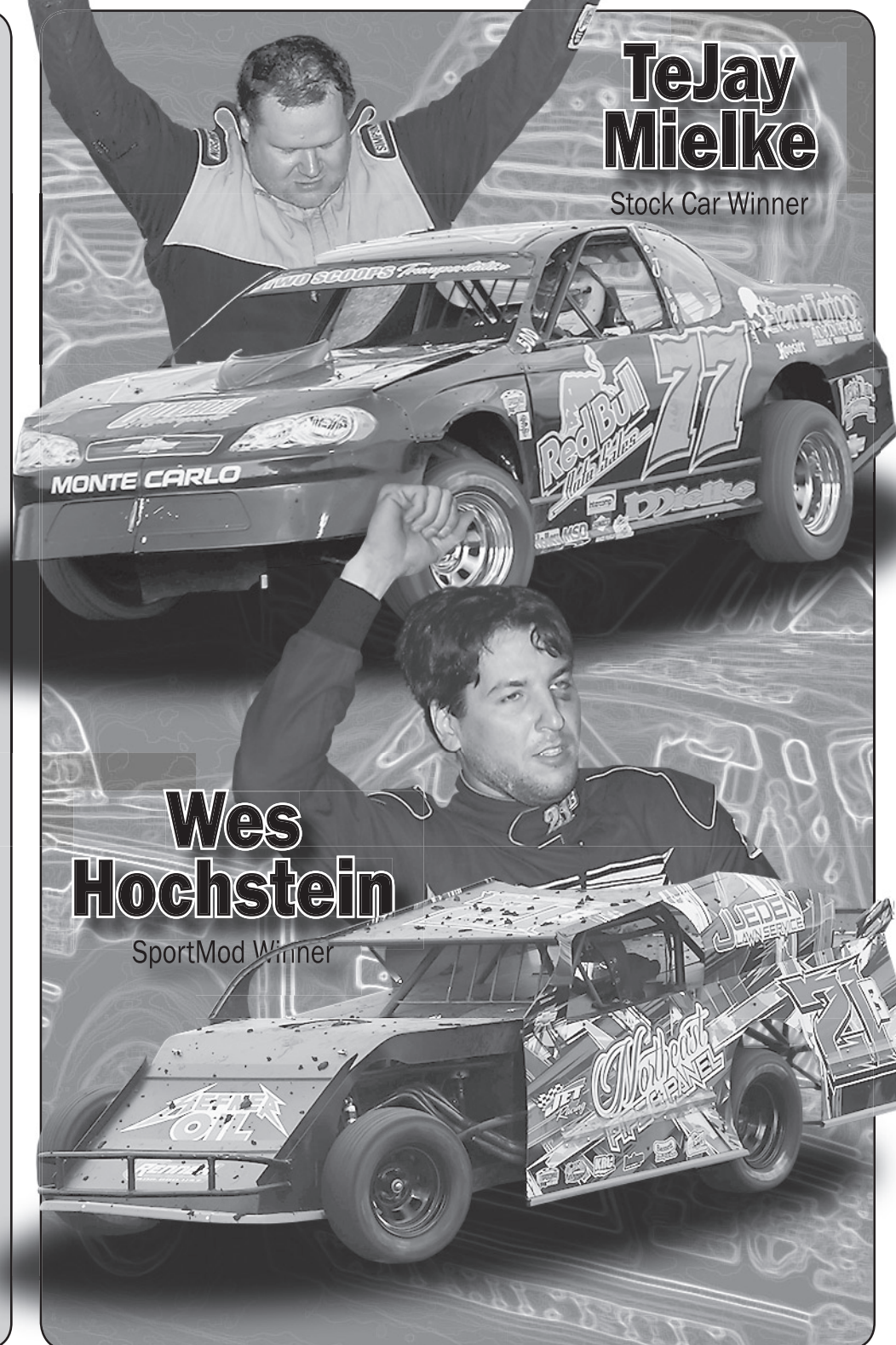

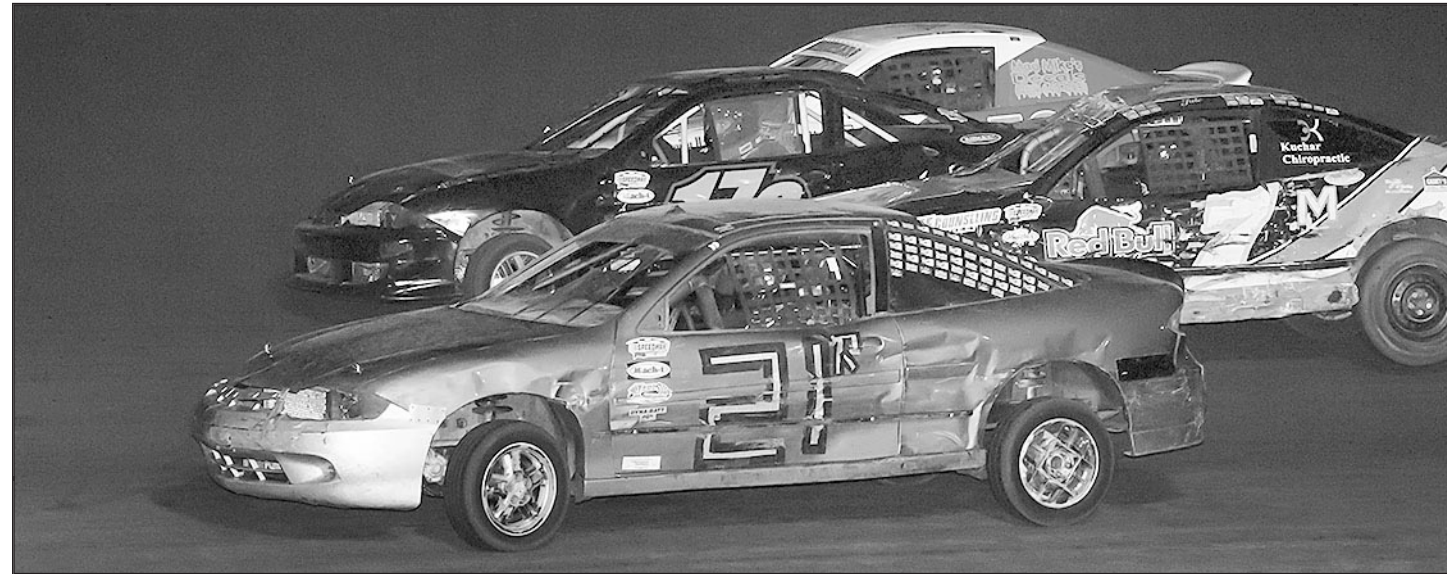

Hochstein continued to run up top until he jumped the cushion and Meyer regained the top spot.

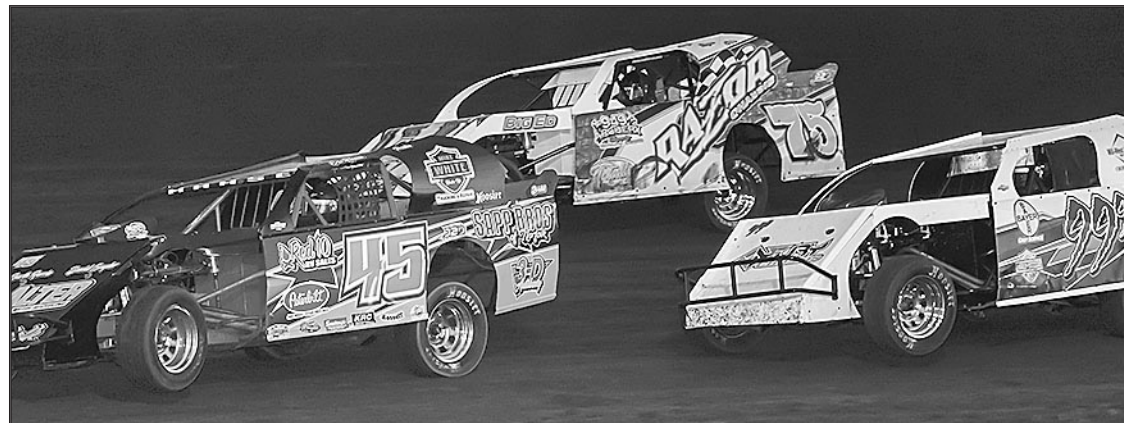
Meyer held the advantage on Hochstein until taking the white flag when they caught slower traffic.

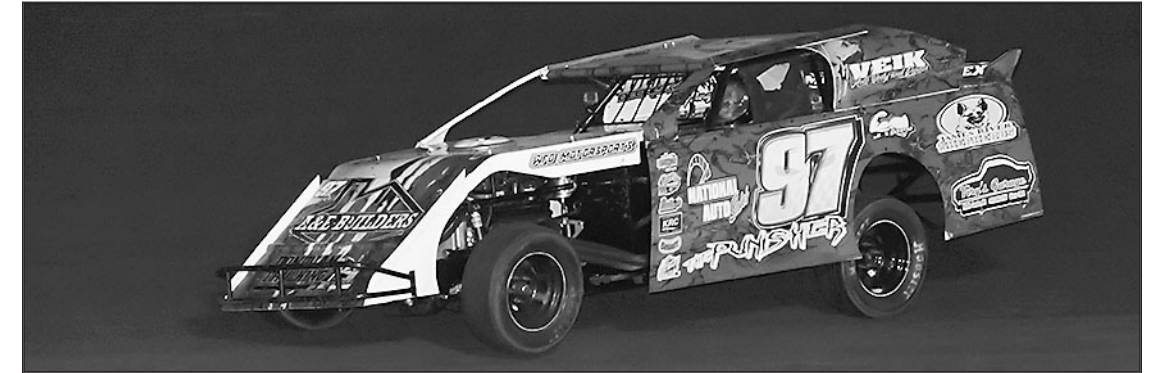

Another Johnson takes Late Model win

Bloomfield's Chris Johnson and Norfolk's Ben Sukup looked to be on a roller coaster with highs and lows in the Late Model feature last week.

When the ride was over, Johnson was sitting in victory lane.

Johnson started on the pole and led the first seven laps, before Sukup did the classic slide job to move out front.

Sukup paced the field for four laps before catching the back of the field. Sukup quickly passed the first two slower cars, as Johnson followed a half-straightway behind.

However, for Sukup, the next group of cars became tougher to pass as they tried to stay on the lead lap and racing two cars wide. Several times Sukup made it three wide looking for space to get by.

On lap 18, Sukup got together with one of the slower vehicles and lost momentum, which allowed Johnson to close back in.

As the two lead drivers raced side-by-side, they came upon a lapped car – Johnson took low and Sukup went high.

Johnson made it through, but Sukup made slight contact and it

was enough to send him sideways. Sukup managed to make a 360 spin and went on, but dropped a half lap to the leader.

Johnson had little trouble the rest of the way and took his first victory of the season and his 6th career win.

Cory Haase of Norfolk ran in the top three all race to finished second as Matt Haase of Norfolk rolled in third.

Nelson Vollbrecht of Stanton grabbed a fourth-place finish and Zach Zentner of Cedar Rapids rounded out the top 5.



Ben Sukup (07) struggled with lapped traffic while leading. He spun after leading 10 laps.



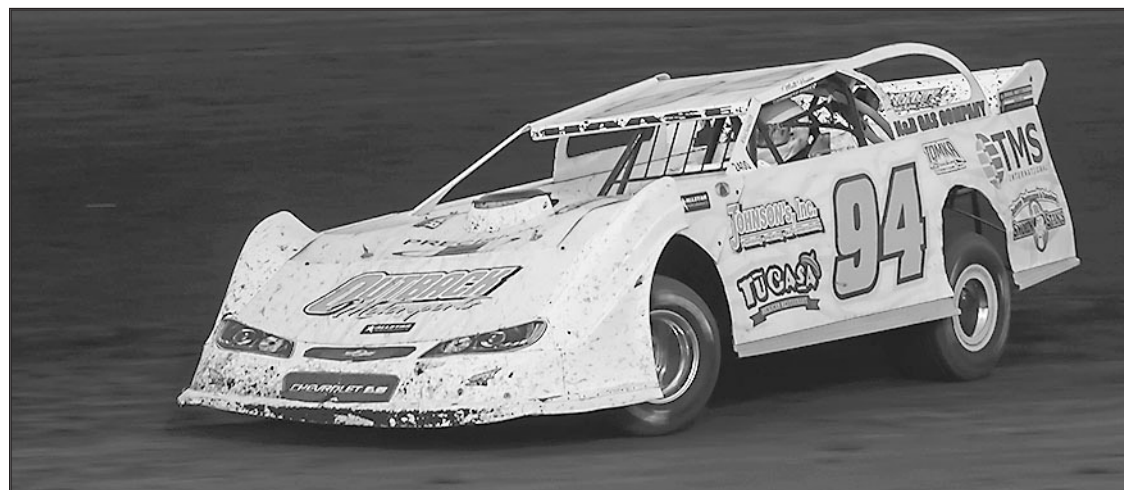
