



Wilkinson takes victory and third top 5

Using the same line as his son did to win the Hobby Stock feature, Neligh's Jason Wilkinson hugged the inside of the track to win the Stock Cars feature last week.

His son, Cameron won his second straight Hobby Stock feature never leaving the bottom side of the track.

The older Wilkinson started on the inside of the fourth row and was running fifth after one circuit. Two laps later he passed two cars in turn two and another two cars in turn four.

A lap later he was passing Austin Brauner of Platte

Center, who led the first three laps.

Once out front, the defending track champion ran consistent laps to pull off his first win of the season and his 10th career win at the track.

Chad Bruns of Wayne managed to keep on the heels of Wilkinson but could not challenge for the win.

Wilkinson's other son, Kyle Wilkinson also of Neligh finished third. Tanner Pettitt of Pierce crossed the line fourth and Brauner rounded out the top 5.



lap for Meyer to get around the lapped vehicles and with two laps remaining Meyer went after Pospisil again.


Getting the inside line on the final lap, Meyer pulled alongside and the two battled it out in the final turn. Meyer got the grip off the final corner and pulled off the victory.

Second straight for Wilkinson

Three of the youngest drivers in the Hobby Stock class went into turn three three-wide on the second lap and one came out with the lead and the eventual win.

Neligh's Cameron Wilkinson drove to the inside of Norfolk's Gage Koch, as Koch went to the inside of Wyatt Lehman of Norfolk. Wilkinson was able to hold the bottom on the exit of turn four to pass both cars and take the lead.

The race went uninterrupted as Wilkinson paced the final 13 laps for the win. It was his second of the season, his third career victory at the track and

his 20th career top 5.

Jeremy Hoskinson finished second, as he tried numerous lines around the track, but could not find enough grip to catch Wilkinson. Hoskinson took his first top 5 of the season.

Following not too far behind Hoskinson was Koch. Koch battled with Lehman for a couple laps before he settled into third. He then went after Hoskinson but could only get to a couple car lengths. Koch kept to the bottom to finish third.







Kay wins SLMR night at the track

It was on lap 19 when the Super Late Model Racing feature got shook up and waiting in the wings was Wheatland, IA driver, Justin Kay, who came out on top.

Kay led the final 12 laps to win the 30-lap main event by half-a-straightway.

At the drop of the green, it was Marquette's Kyle Berck putting on a show leading the field as he diced through lapped traffic. Close behind was defending series champion Tad Pospisil of Norfolk also working slower traffic.

After the first caution, Kay showed his power when he jumped alongside Berck on the restart. Kay was unable to make the pass but slid into second.

However, another caution was thrown,

and the field was grouped again.

This time Pospisil made the same move Kay did on the previous restart and challenged Berck for the lead and in the process, he passed Kay.

As Berck and Pospisil raced out front, Kay was watching from a couple car lengths back. During lap 19, Pospisil went into turn three and drifted up the track and Berck and Pospisil got together, leaving Berck sitting backwards in turn four bringing out another yellow flag.

The top two cars were sent to the rear of the field and Kay inherited the lead.

Putting his right rear on the cushion, Kay clicked

off the laps to pick up the victory.

Jason O'Brien of Atlantic, IA took home second. Ben Schaller of Omaha grabbed third.

Justin Zeitner of Malvern, IA went home fourth as Corey Zeitner of Omaha rounded out the top 5.

Pospisil recovered to finish seventh, as Berck went home 12th.
