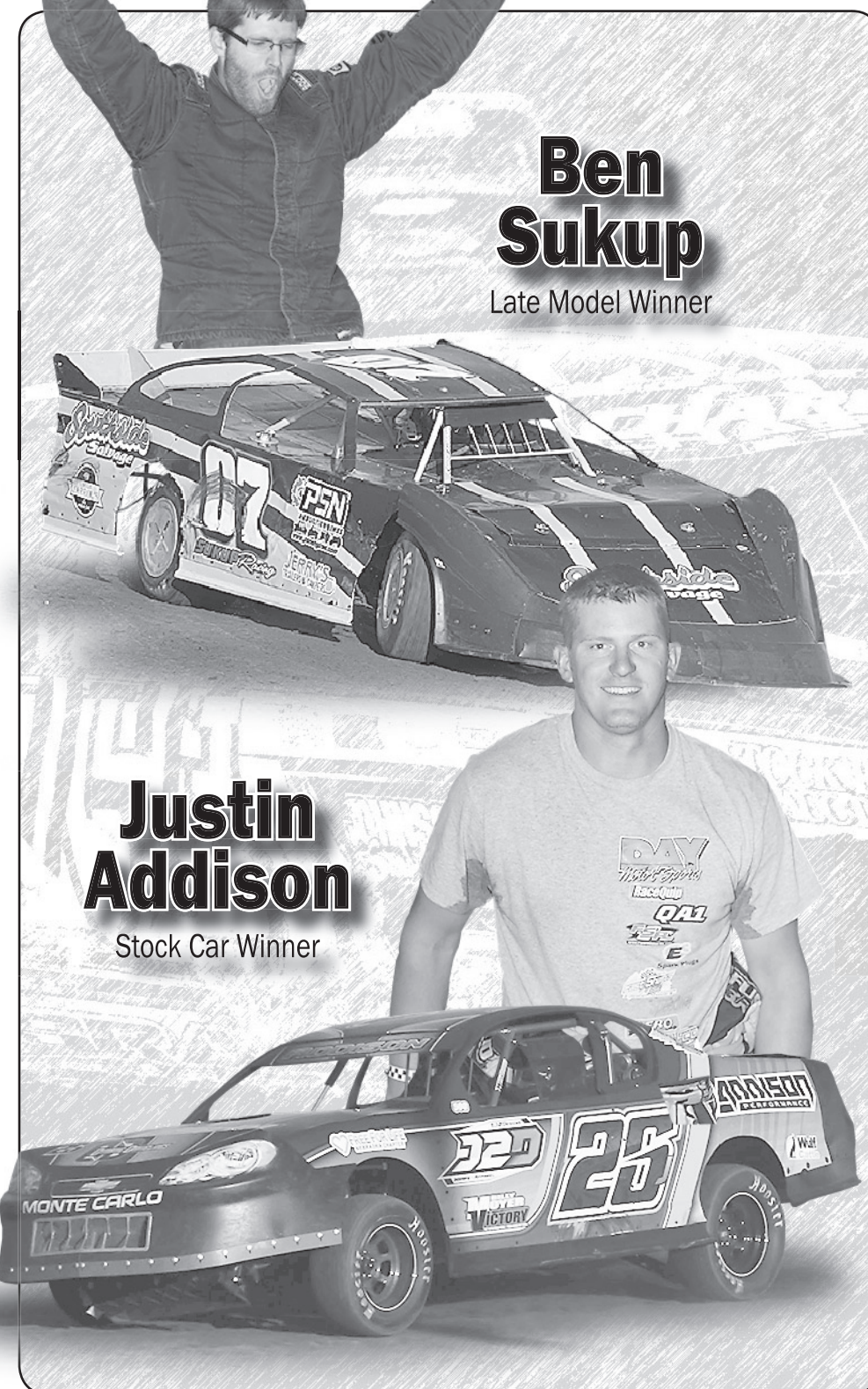

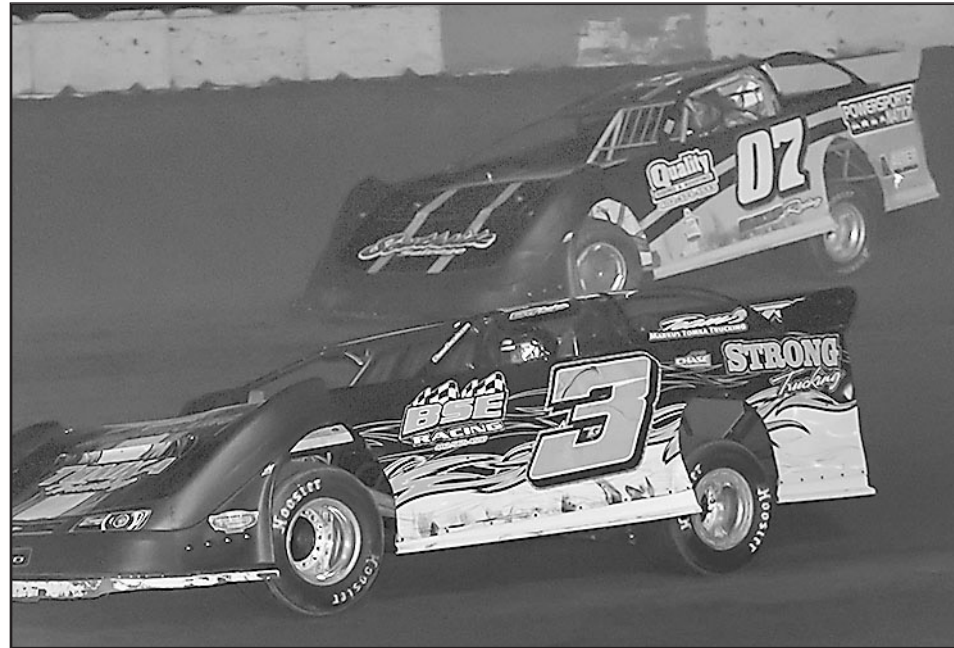

Sukup posts victory

After a caution and two red flags, Norfolk's Ben Sukup pulled into victory lane in the Late Model division.

The red flags had a few drivers shaken up but went off under their own power.

The first was for Eric Vanosdall of Norfolk when he clipped the wall before the entrance ramp and went nose first into the slanted wall after the ramp.

The car shot across the track involving more vehicles including Bob Milander of Pierce, who took his time getting out, but was able to walk away.

The second one was for Matt Haase of Norfolk when two cars in front of him tangled and sent him into the backstretch wall leading into turn three. Haase walked away.

But for the final lap eight laps, Sukup put his right rear on the cushion and drove away from the field, as three cars battled for the runner-up spot.

On the final restart, Norfolk's Robert Osborne held second, as

Jim Johnson of Plainview and Zach Zentner of Cedar Rapids were locked in a battle.

Soon all three were shuffling for second place, before Johnson grabbed the position. He quickly put distance between himself and third and fourth but did not have enough time to run down the leader.

Sukup took the victory for his first win of the season and his seventh career victory at the track.

Johnson finished second for his second second-place finish this season. Osborne grabbed his first top 5 at third position.

Zentner took fourth and Chris Johnson of Bloomfield rounded out the top 5.

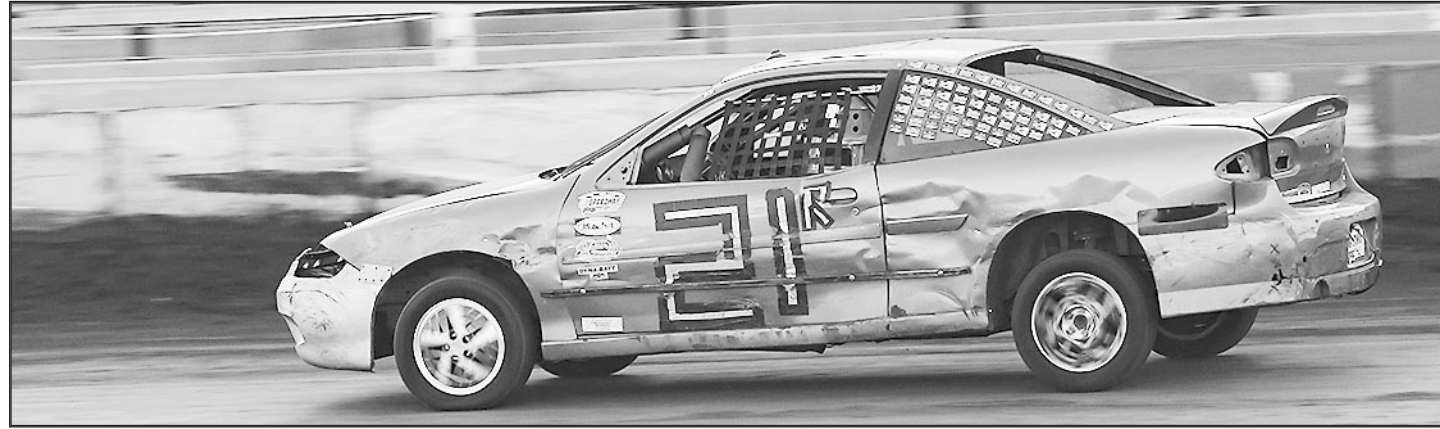

It would be after a rare caution in the class when the battle second began. Pospisil and Uehling battled for eight

Jeremy Shell edged out Bristol Arneson of Norfolk for

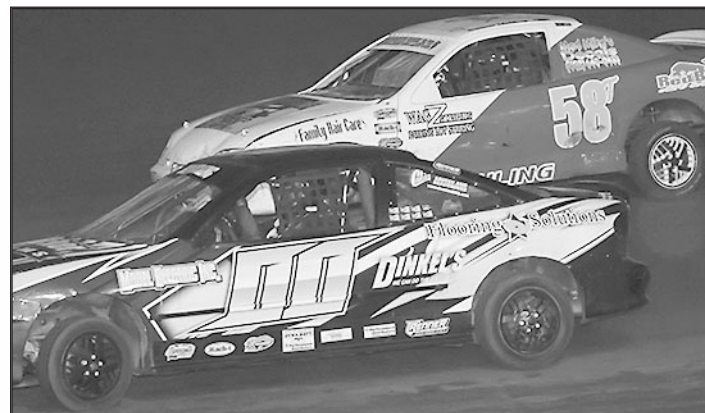


Above, Jeremy Shell (17s) finished fifth in the feature as Bristol Arneson took sixth, below.



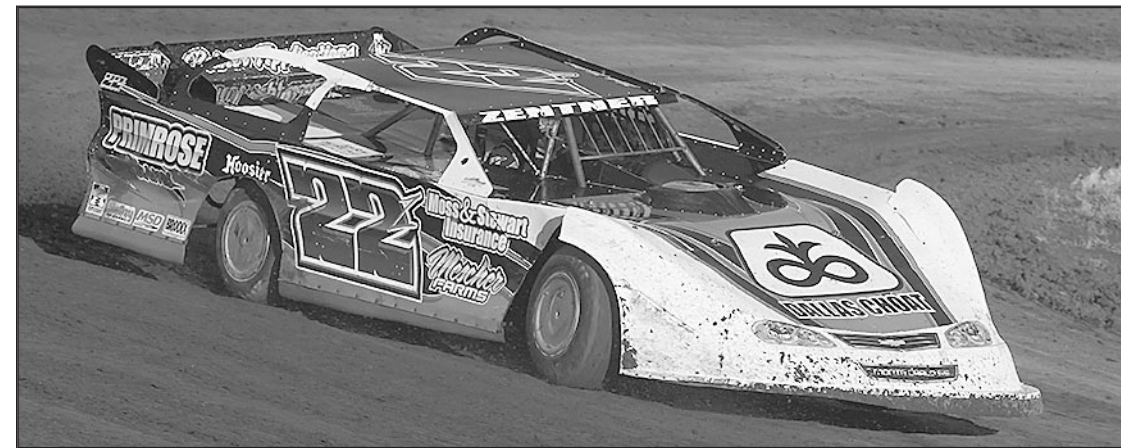

Svoboda a winner

Newcomer Austin Svoboda of David City rolled into town and went home with the top prize in the SportMods class.

Off Road Speedway was one of the few tracks to run last weekend and drew several new drivers looking to race.

Svoboda started on the sixth row inside of the 17-car field. In four laps, Svoboda was running in the top 5. On the final restart, it took him a few laps to get by race leader Eric Haase of Norfolk.

Once out front, he left the field behind. He took the victory by a straightaway.

Brian Osantowski of Columbus led the first three laps after starting on the inside of

the second row. It was after the first caution for debris when Haase got a good run off turn two to pass for the lead.

Haase led for three laps before dropping to second where he finished with a half straightaway lead over third.

Osantowski ran third for three more laps, but as he tried to get back around for second, Cameron Meyer of Pierce stuck his nose in for the third position. Several laps later Meyer completed the pass to take third.

Osantowski settled for four and rounding out the top 5 was opening night winner Robbie Thome of Spalding.

Neligh's Cameron Wilkinson pulled off several moves like his dad - was patient to wait for lanes open to pass and when he needed the car to stick, it stuck, just long enough for the young driver to win his third-straight Hobby Stock feature.

Earlier in the feature, the young Wilkinson's night looked bleak when he hooked bumper's briefly with another car, not only losing a position, he lost distance to the leader with only seven laps remaining.

Three laps later, as the leaders tangled, Wilkinson drove between two cars straight into second and a clear look at the

leader, Jeremy Hoskinson of Norfolk.

In the final three laps, Wilkinson closed the distance and in the final corner, he out braked Hoskinson, he got the car to rotate and was able to get the traction he needed off the turn to drag race Hoskinson to the line.

He won by just inches.

It was Wilkinson's third win of the season in four appearances. It also closed the gap to one point in the point standings gaining seven points on Sal Hernandez of Columbus.

Hoskinson finished second after leading five laps. Ryan Fajman of Albion, in his first night at the track, finished third. Fourth went to Dusty Poesnecker of Atkinson and rounding out the top 5 was Lance Mielke of Norfolk.

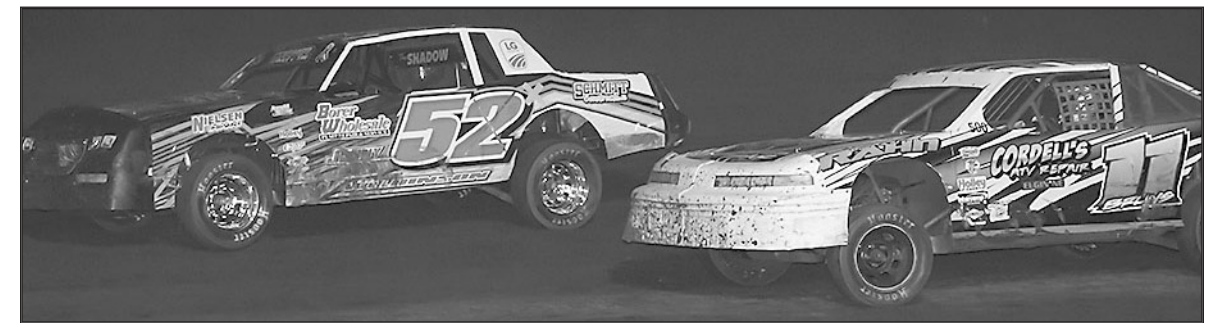
