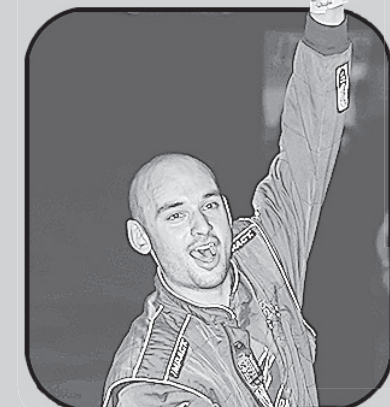

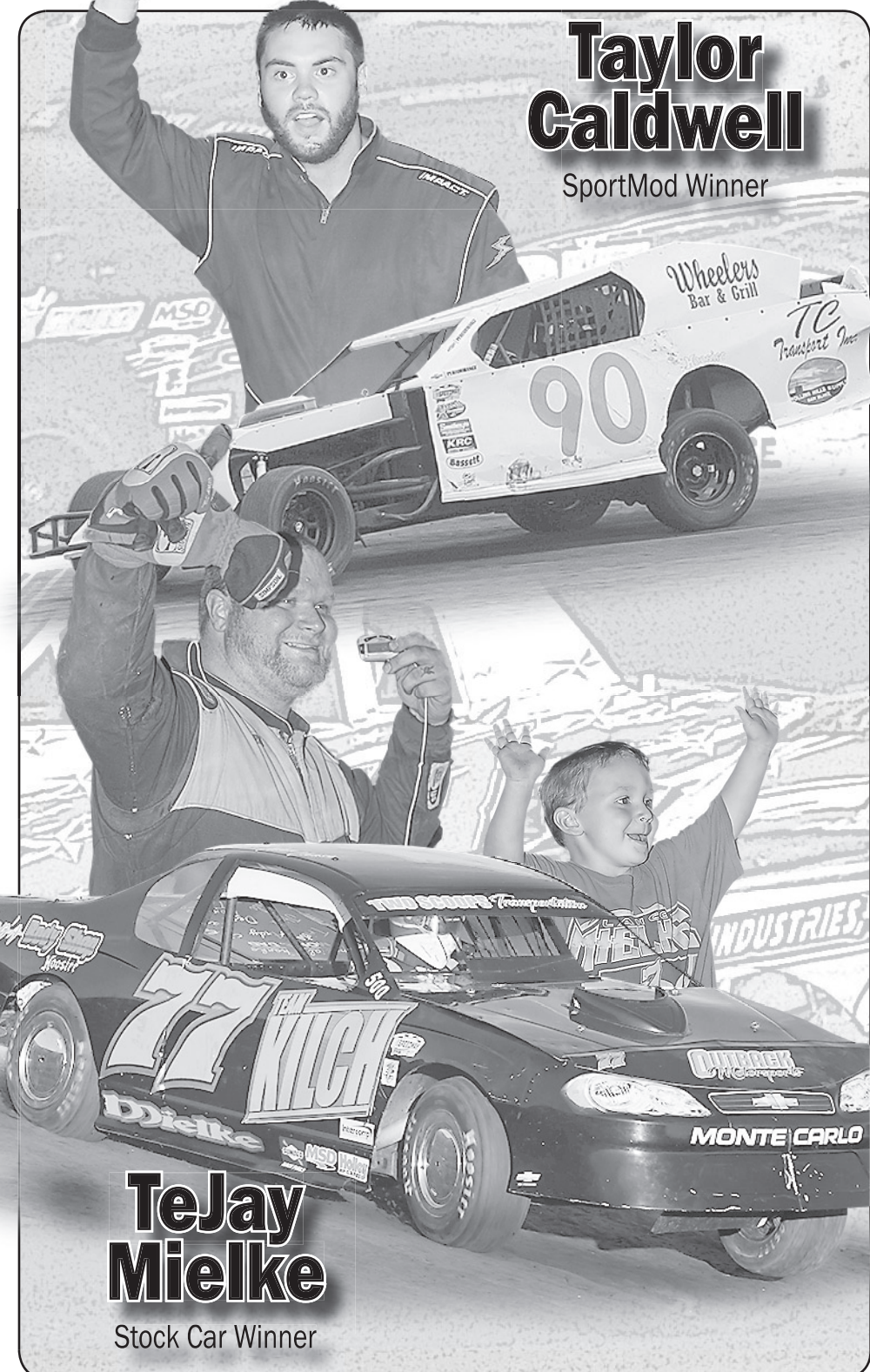

Mielke captures second win

Enduring four cautions in the 18-lap feature, TeJay Mielke nearly lost the race because of an oil plug.

The Norfolk driver exited turn four to take the checkered flag as a plume of smoke began rolling out behind the car.

Mielke said the car never got hot and figured it was something simple. It was. The oil plug came loose seconds from taking the victory.

Mielke led all 18 laps and was able to maintain a slight advantage over Kyle Wilkinson of Neligh for most of the first half of the race, but on the second restart, Wilkinson faded fast.

Wayne's Neil Bruns took over the runner-up spot but could not close the gap.

With four laps remaining, Shawn Primrose of Norfolk and Jason Wilkinson of Neligh were all over Bruns' bumper. Bruns jumped the cushion with two laps left and Primrose pulled alongside, but Bruns had the preferred line and regained the position.

Mielke took his second win of the season, as Bruns took second, Primrose alongside for third. Wilkinson finished fourth.

Austin Brauner of Platte Center ran second a couple laps before finishing fifth.

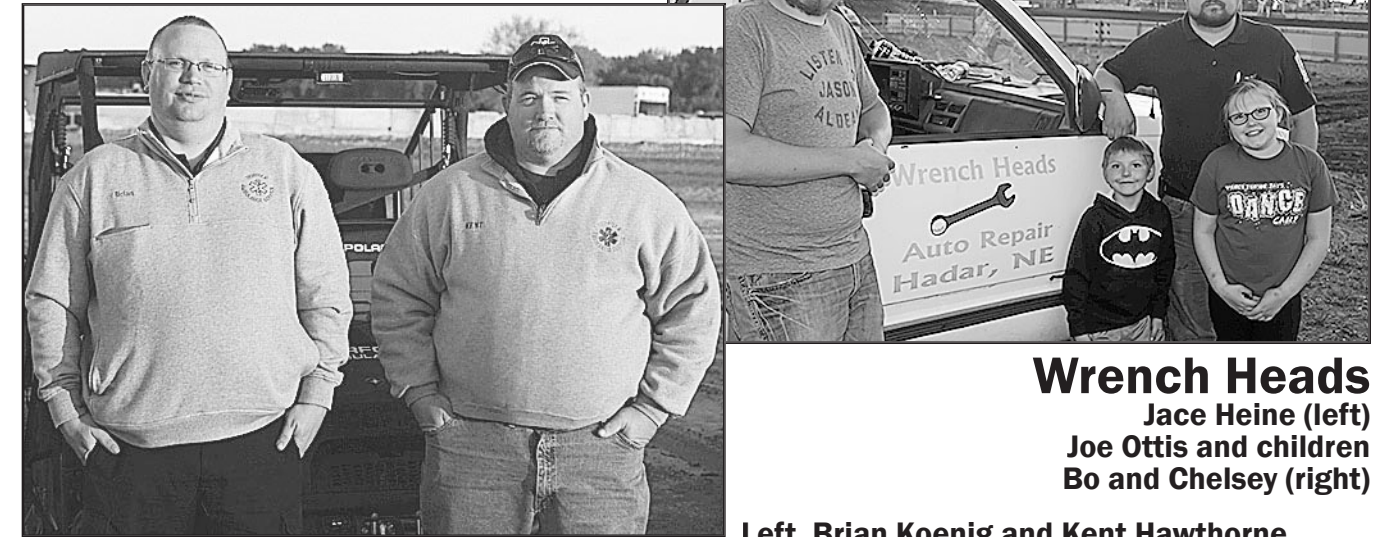

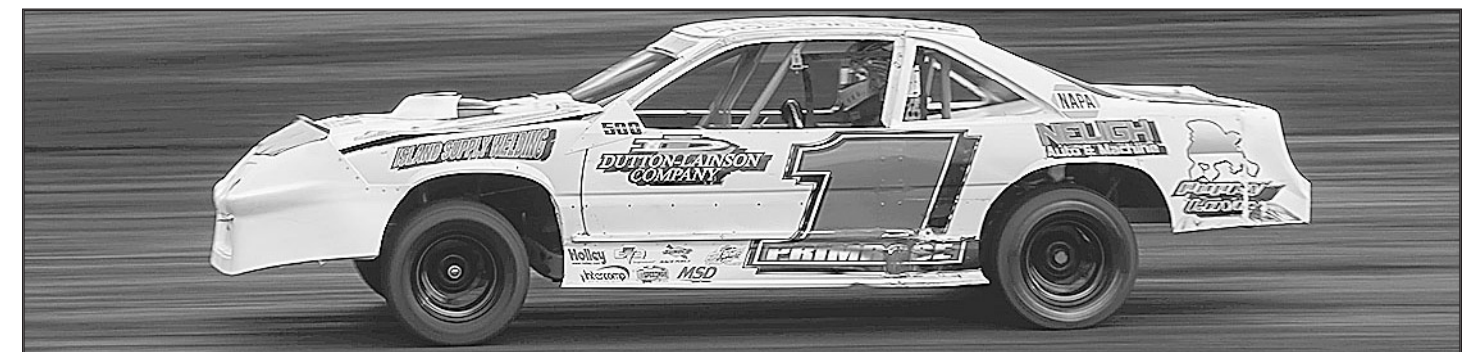

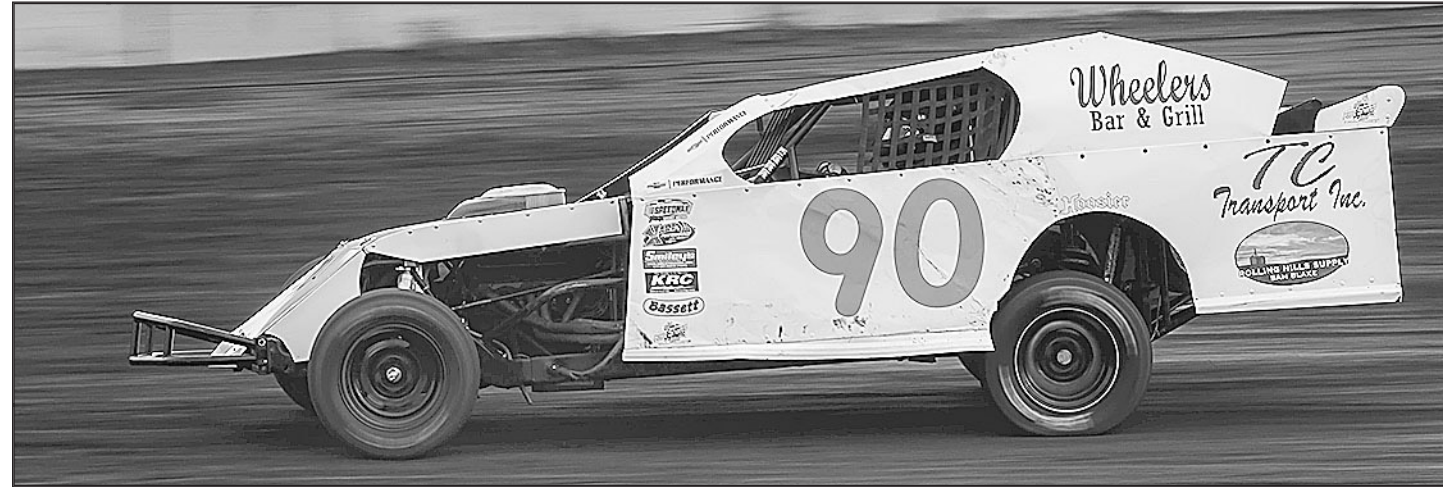

Haase tried various lines to get by only to allow Robbie Thome of Spalding to catch up.

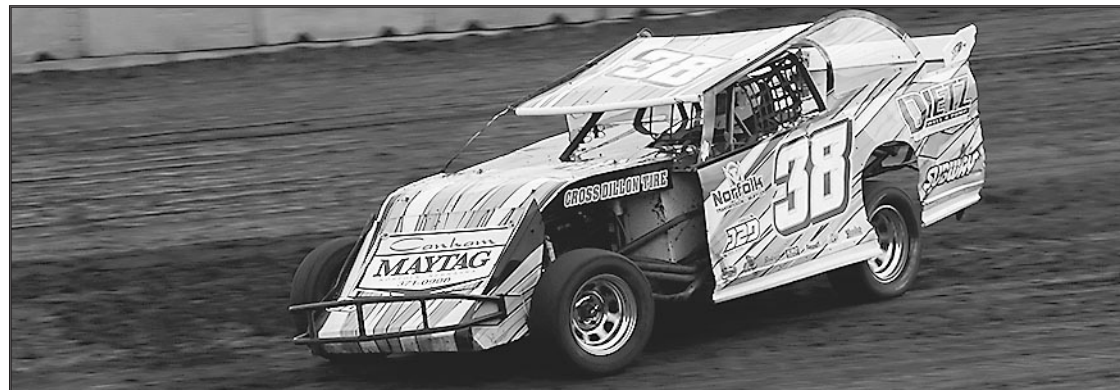
Caldwell took the win, Gnat was second, Haase was third and Thome settled for fourth.

Hoskinson takes first win of season

The race then came for second between Nate DeSive of Verdigre and Cameron Wilkinson of Neligh. The two slipped by Koch on lap six and ran side-by-side for most of the remaining nine laps.

DeSive worked the bottom of the track and Wilkinson ran the top side. It looked like it was setting up to be a close finish.

But when it came down to the end, Wilkinson narrowly missed a lapped vehicle with

two laps remaining and as the two took the white flag, another lapped vehicle slowed in the middle of the track.

With little he could do, Wilkinson plowed into the back of the car giving DeSive a clear shot to the finish line.

Hoskinson won his first feature of the season after taking two runner-up finishes.

DeSive finished second for the second time this season. Wilkinson followed up behind for third for his fifth top 5 of the season.

Jay Poesnecker of Ames matched his best finish of the season at fourth. Rounding out the top 5 was Koch for his third top 5 of the season.

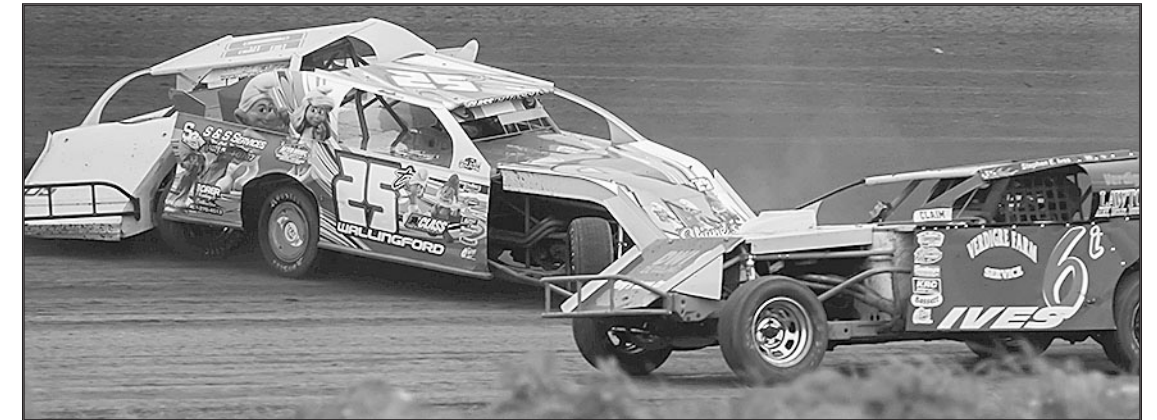

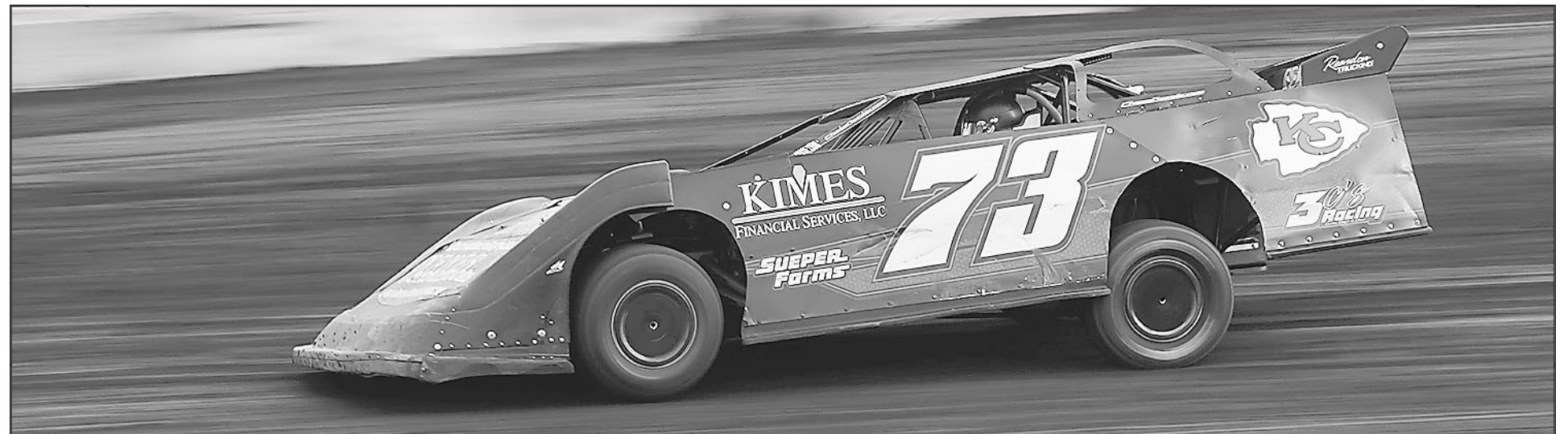
