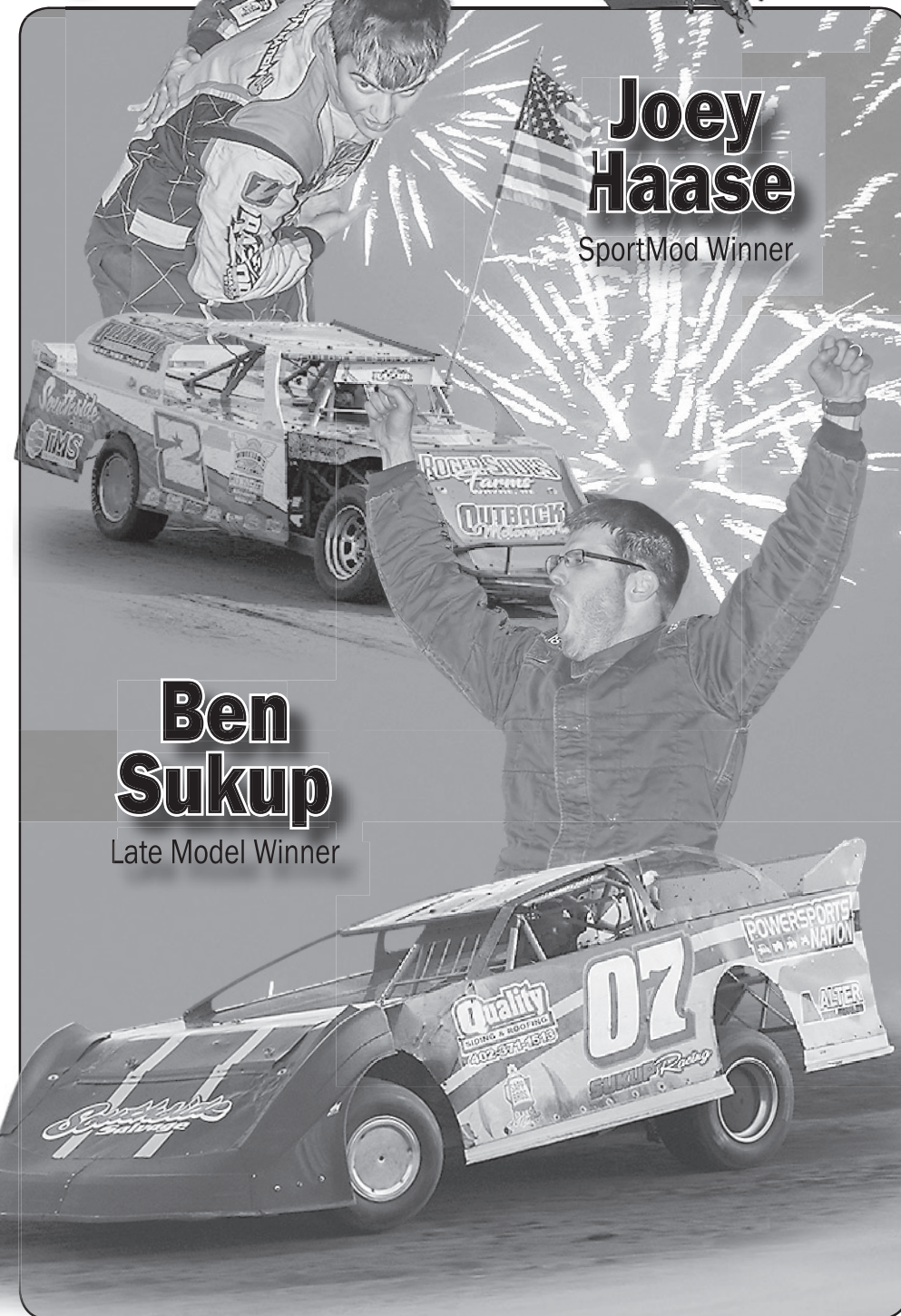

## Sukup does it again

It took three times to start the Late Model feature Tuesday night, but after it started action continued to the end.

Norfolk's Ben Sukup picked up his second win of the season, but Chase Osborne, also of Norfolk, chased him to the end.

Sukup started on the pole, as Osborne drew outside pole. A jumped start brought out the first caution and another caution flag was thrown for another sloppy start when a car pushed a barrier tire onto the track.

Finally, on the third try, the leaders had the perfect start. Osborne barely led the first lap before Sukup settled in on the high side and led the final 24 laps.

Osborne worked the bottom of the track until Sukup's lead increased. He then worked the high side to maintain the distance behind Sukup.

The two drivers then caught the back of the 18-car field just passed the halfway point at which time Osborne returned to the low side.

By now the lower groove

was a little quicker and between better grip and slower traffic, Osborne was back challenging for the lead.

Sukup found his way through the lap traffic quickly, but Osborne got held a split second longer, which opened up Sukup's lead again.

Coming down to two laps left, Osborne managed to regain the ground he lost, but it was too late.

Sukup took the win by a car-length. It was Sukup's second win of the season and the first driver in the class to have more than one win.

Osborne, who throw it into the last two corners with everything he had, came up short and finished at the runner-up position for his best effort of the season.

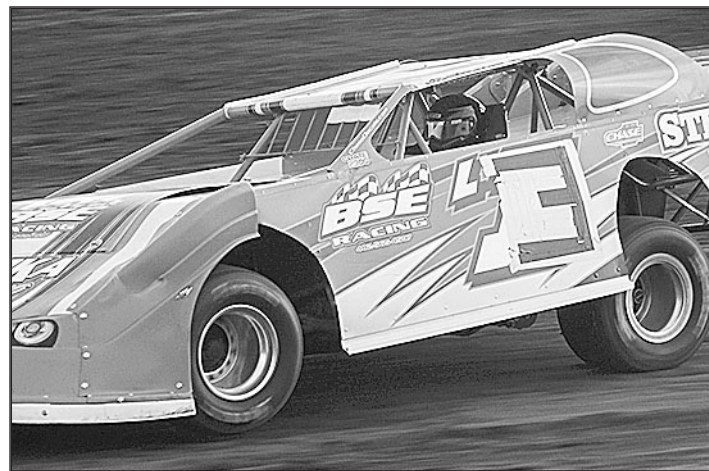
Zach Zentner of Cedar Rapids brought a third-place finish. He passed Robert Osborne of Norfolk for the position on lap nine.

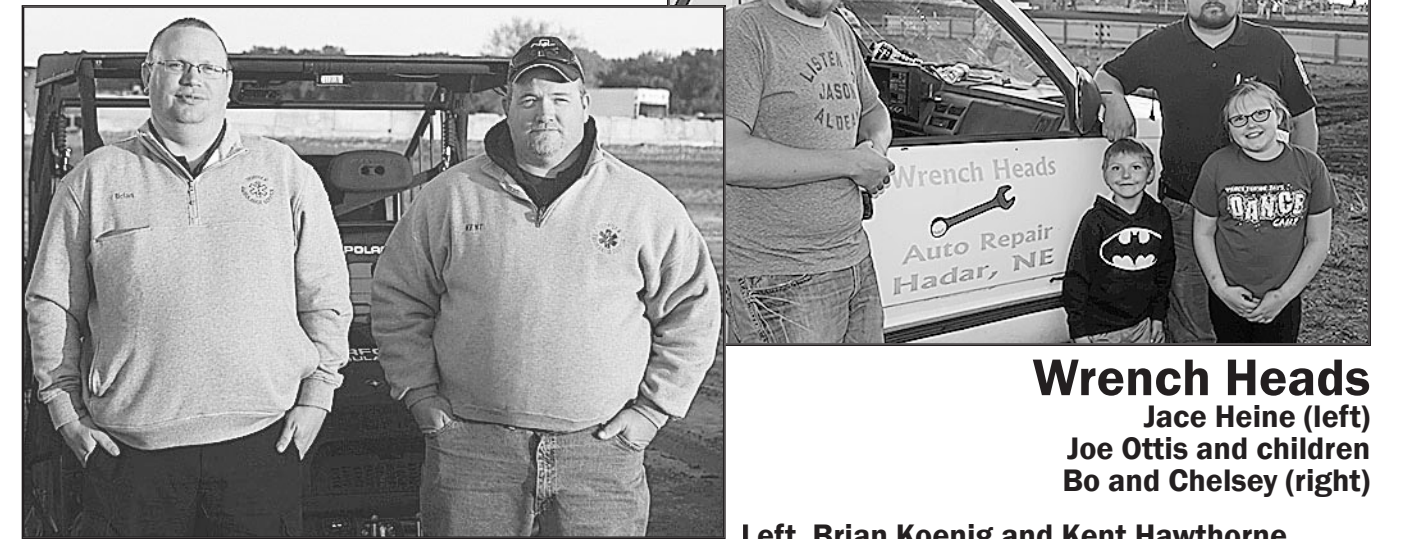

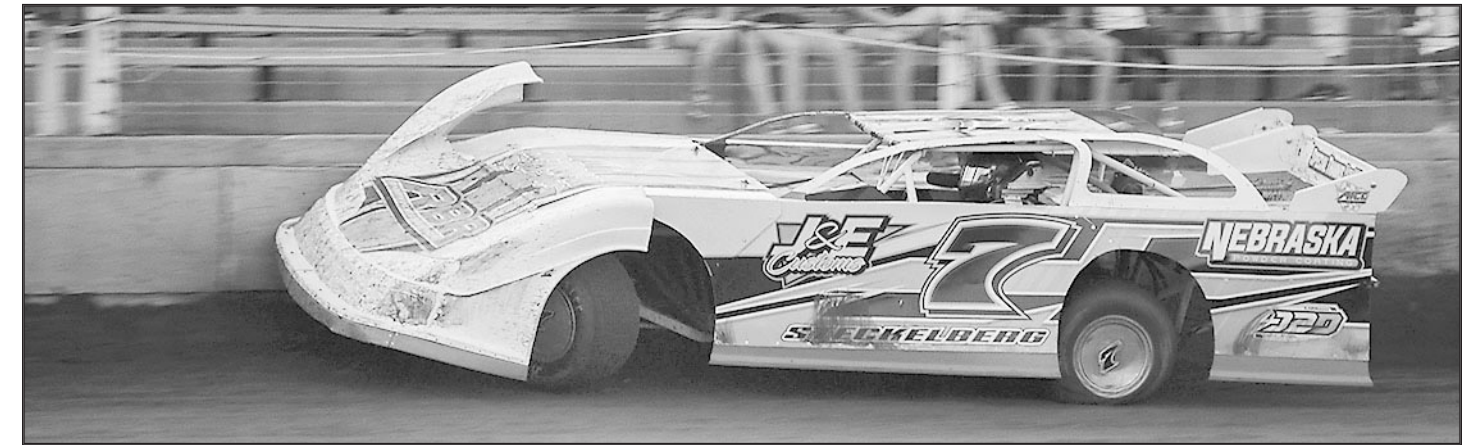

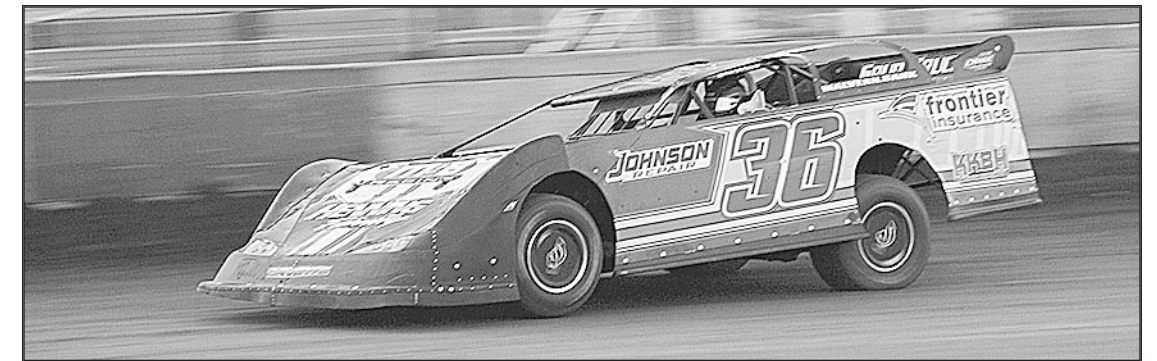

# Wilkinson wins back-to-back

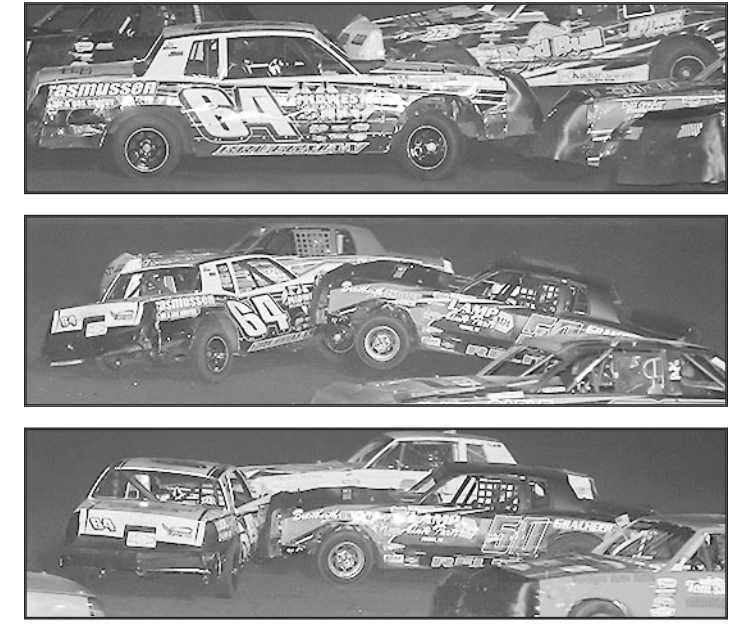

Hoskinson tried high and low but could not complete the pass. When it looked like

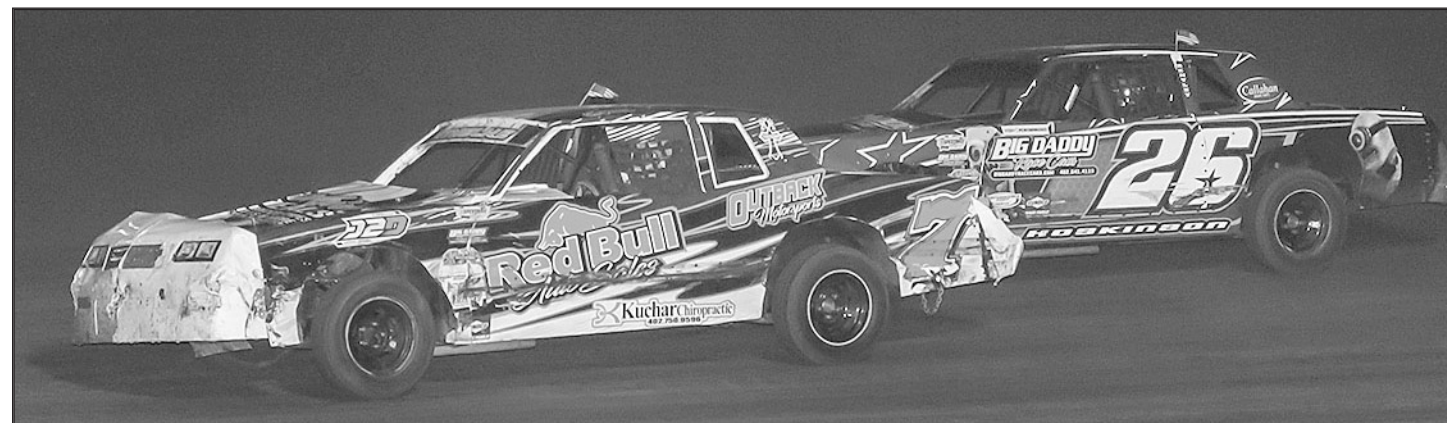
one driver had the advantage, the other one would charge back.

Hoskinson made the pass for second on lap 14, but it was too late to cut into Wilkinson's lead.

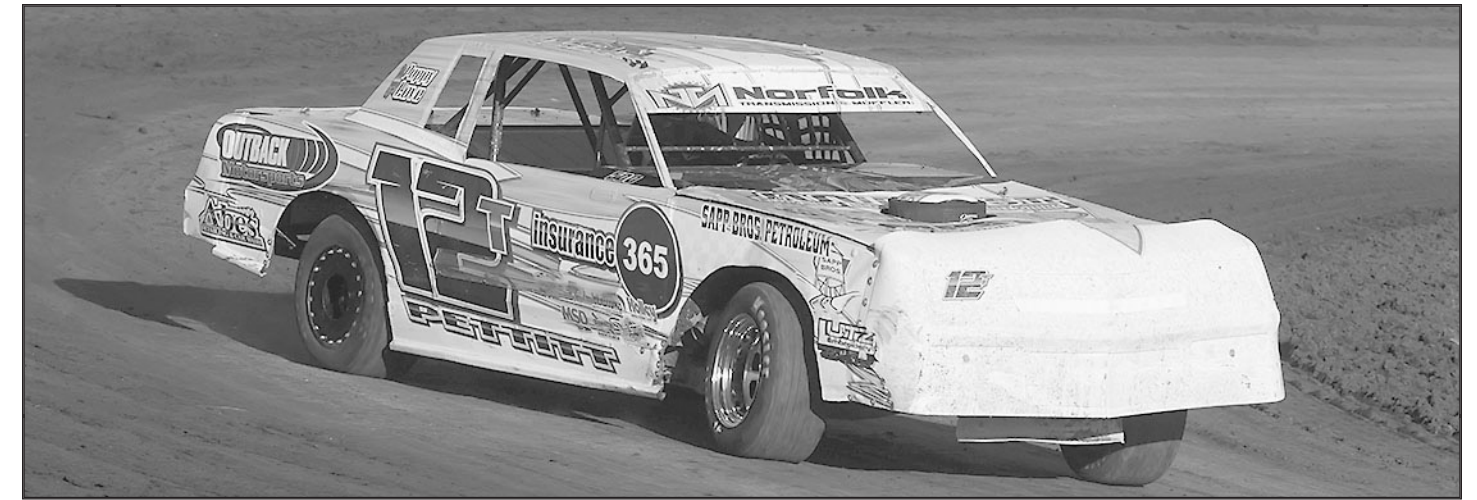

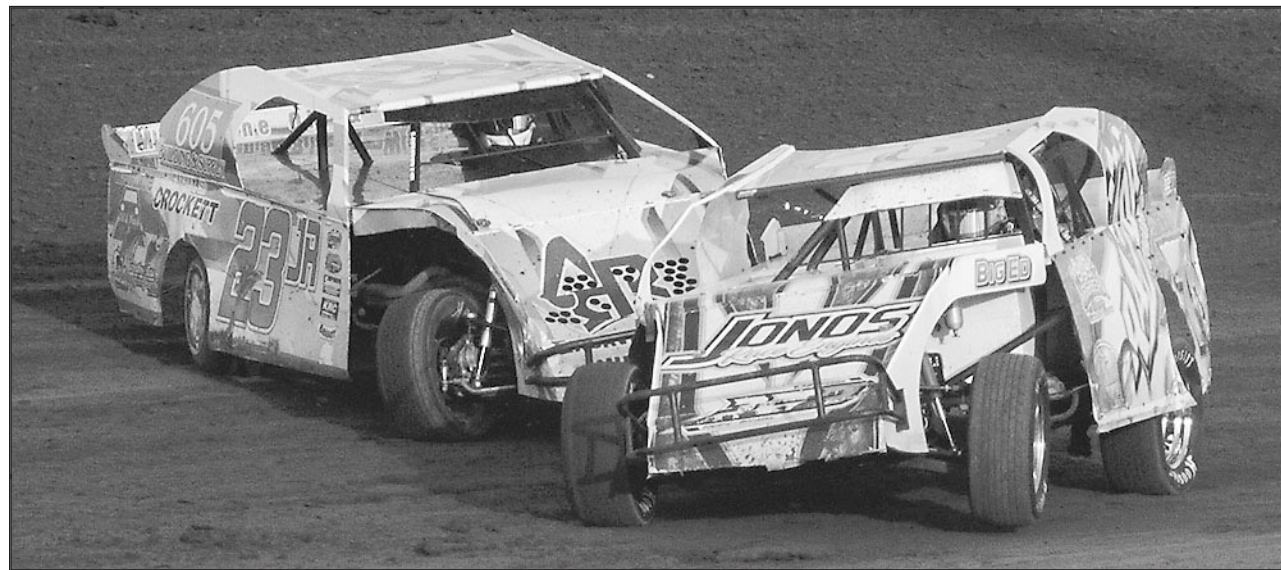

But the lead was erased when a caution was thrown with five laps remaining setting up a sprint to the end.

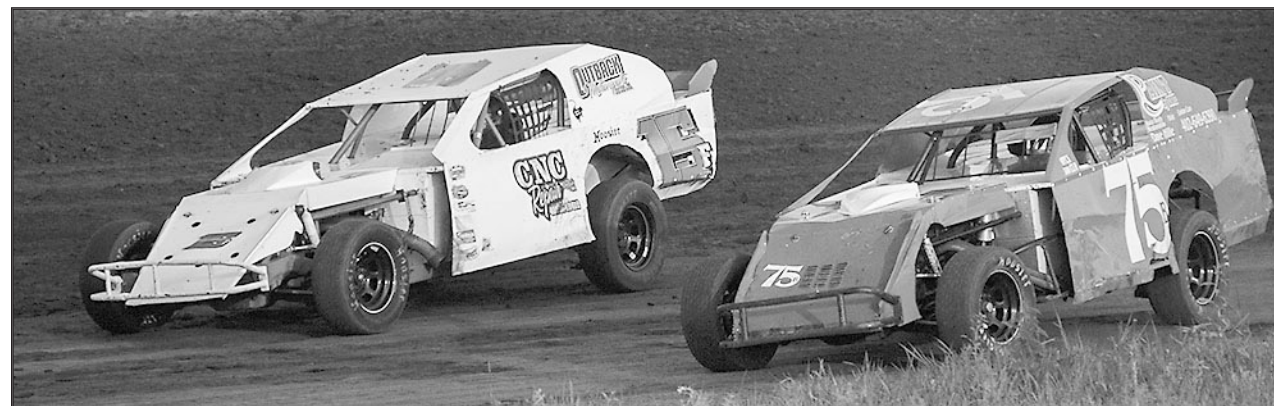
