Pettitt takes the win

Norfolk's Ron Pettitt simple drove through the middle on his way to the front to win his first feature of the season.

A quick caution after completing lap one slowed the 14-car field, but Pettitt was already running second and looking for the lead.

John Brudigan of Elkhorn led the first two laps, but it was all Pettitt after that.

Pettitt won by nearly a straightaway over his nephew, Shawn Primrose of the Norfolk. It was Pettitt's fifth career win at the track.

Primrose rolled through second. He moved into the third spot by lap six and was running second by lap 11. It was his second top 5 of the season.

Jason Wilkinson of Neligh took third. He was running second for most of the race, before Primrose got by. It was Wilkinson's third top 5.

Fourth went to Tiffany Bittner of Norfolk for her second top 5. Rounding out the top 5 was John Hadcock of Wayne. It was his first top 5.

It was win number three for Pierce's Ramsey Meyer as he has won each Sport Compact feature this season.

Shannon Pospisil of Norfolk led the first lap before Meyer jumped out front.

A caution with five laps remaining gave Dustin Jackson another chance to run down Meyer.

They managed to keep close to Meyer however

Meyer won by a couple car lengths. Jackson took home second for his third second-place finish of the season. Jackson broke into the top 3 on lap 7 and after the final restart, he was running second with 5 laps remaining.

Pospisil took his second third-place finish. Kyle Shutt of Atkinson placed fourth while Tanner Uehling of Norfolk rounded out the top 5 for his first top 5 of the season.

Pospisil wins first feature

Having knocked on the door for a victory numerous times, Dylan Pospisil finally picked up his first feature victory at the track.

The Norfolk driver has led close to 60 laps in the three seasons at Off Road Speedway, the most out of any other driver, except Kyle Prauner of Norfolk who has more than 200 laps led.

Pospisil started on the inside of the fourth row and was fifth after the first lap. Following a caution on the second lap, Pospisil jumped to second on the restart. Two laps later he was leading the 12-car field.

One more caution slowed the field leaving 13 laps to checkered flag.

Pospisil pulled away from

the field to take the win and his third top 5 finish of the season.

Second went to Justin Addison of Norfolk, who suffered a flat tire on the second lap. He managed to climb back through the field to pass Colby Langenberg of Norfolk for second on lap 15 of the 20-lap feature.

Langenberg, who led two laps early, slipped back to finish third.

Neil Bruns of Wayne picked up his first top 5 finish in this class on his way to a fourth place. He was sitting eighth at the final restart.

Jeremy Gnat of Battle Creek rounded out the top 5.

Leading the final 10 laps, Norfolk's Jeremy Hoskinson picked up his first win of the season.

Hoskinson started on the outside of the third row and moved into the top 3 by lap four.

One lap later he was running second and in another lap, he was leading the field.

There were three cautions, including a red flag when Tracy Buck of Neligh flipped his 28-machine. With a little assistance, Buck climbed from the car and walked away.

Following the final caution, Hoskinson distanced himself from the 16-car field and main-

tained a comfortable lead. He won by half-a-straightaway for his sixth career win at the track.

Nate DeSive of Verdigre led four laps before running second for the rest of the race. Lance Mielke of Norfolk ran third until Austin Brauner of St. Edward slipped by with three laps remaining.

Brauner, who won the first two nights, took third. Lee Kracht of Scribner crossed the line fourth for his second top 5.

Jim Kimmel of Norfolk rounded out the top 5. It was his first top 5 finish of the season.
