Dover takes Sprint special

Starting on the pole, Jack Dover quickly got out front and set his right rear tire on the cushion and blasted away from the field.

The Springfield Sprint Car driver picked up the feature win, as Dover said he wished they could run here more often.

With threatening weather staying away from the facility, track preparation gave the open-wheeled cars favorable conditions.

Dover, who led all 25-laps of the feature, dealt with lap traffic for most of the race until on lap 21 when Jason Martin of Lincoln had a chance to take the lead.

A slower car exiting the track caused Dover to hesitate going into turn one which allowed Martin to close the gap.

Martin caught the exiting car at the wrong time and he had to stay in the throttle to avoid running into Dover.

Entering turn one too fast, Martin washed up the track in front of Dover but

he still had too much momentum and he jumped the cushion and nearly the outside wall.

As Martin gathered his rocket back up, Dover slipped back by. Martin made another attempt to pass, but again caught a slower car at the wrong time setting up the wrong angle into the turn with just over a lap to go.

Dover won by a half straight-away. Martin was second. Ryan Roberts of Aurora was third, Cody Ledger of Omaha took home fourth. Rounding out the top 5 was Eric Lutz of Sioux Falls, S. Dak.

Seth Brahmer of Norfolk was the highest local finisher at seventh. Greg Schuetz of Norfolk finished 17th in the 20-car field. Brant O'Banion placed 19th. Formerly of Norfolk now from Omaha, Rick Hansen finished 20th.

Langenberg wins after penalties

A last lap incident involving the leaders in the SportMod feature caused track officials to take a couple of days to determine the finishing order.

Using every means possible to try and get a clear picture of what happened, the decision was released Monday noon.

Colby Langenberg of Norfolk was credited with the win and Nelson Vollbrecht of Stanton given second. Those two drivers crossed the finish line third and fourth, respectively.

Dylan Pospisil and Justin Addison, both of Norfolk, were penalized two spots for the incident that took place as they took the checkered.

Pospisil was dropped to third and Addison was set back to fourth.

Pospisil led the first 16 laps of the 18-lap feature, but it was not an easy task out front. Joey Haase of Norfolk made an early attempt at the lead before drifting back.

Haase closed back in on Pospisil's bumper on lap 11, but so did Addison, as all three cars dealt with lapped traffic.

Starting on lap 14, Haase put the pressure on Pospisil on the high side, as Addison started putting pressure on the lower side.

Pospisil and Haase got together on lap 17 to bring out the only caution. Haase was

sent to the rear of the field for the contact.

That setup the wild finish.

Pospisil restarted out front and Addison lined up right behind him.

Addison dove to the inside of Pospisil to take the lead at the white flag. Pospisil came back and dove to the inside to take the lead turn one, but Addison had the momentum out of turn two to take the lead back.

Pospisil and Addison went into turn three side-by-side and on exit they tangled. The contact took them into the frontstretch wall. Pospisil crossed the finish line first sideways, as Addison crossed the line second with one set of tires on the track and the other set on top of the wall.

Both drivers walked away.

The win for Langenberg was his third of the season and his sixth top 5. The second-place finish for Vollbrecht was his fifth top 5.

Third went to Pospisil for his fourth top 5 and Addison collected his seventh top 5.

Rounding out of the top 5 was Brian Barber of Platte Center.
