

He entered turn one in third place, but on exit of turn two, Chris Johnson was pacing the field to his second feature win of the season.

The Bloomfield driver started on the outside of the second row and settled into the third position for the first three laps.

When he entered turn one for the fourth time, Johnson drove to the inside of the second-place car of Travis Birkley and made the pass.

While Johnson was moving into the second spot, the leader, Norfolk's Cory Haase, had pushed up the track giving Johnson a shot to the front of the pack.

The race was slowed two times, but Johnson pulled away at each restart to pick up his second win of the season and his fifth at the track. It was his sixth top 5 of the season. He has 21 career top 5s for the most in the class.

Johnson led 22 laps in this win giving him 44 for the season and 103 career laps led at the track, the third most for the class.

Haase slipped back to fourth at one point, but recovered to move back into the top 3 on lap 15. He took advantage of a restart to take second on lap 21. He finished second for his second top 5 of the season.

Jim Johnson of Plainview finished third, as Zach Zentner of Cedar Rapids captured fourth. Rounding out the top 5 was Robert Osborne of Norfolk.


Poessnecker recovered and did not lose any positions which eventually gave him the win when Hoskinson was disqualified.


