

It came down to a sprint to the finish in the Late Model feature two weeks ago, but it did not matter for Travis Birkley, who picked up his first win of the season.

Zentner made the pass on Johnson two laps later and set out to run down Birkley. On the first white flag, Birkley lead by four-car lengths, however when Birkley was expecting the checkered flag, the yellow was flying instead.

Tightening his belts back up, Birkley went back to work and held off Zentner for the final two circuits. It was Birkley's fourth career feature win at the track.


