## Johnson wins title; Sukup takes feature

While it was a close battle for the feature win last week, it was a closer battle in the title race.

Norfolk's Ben Sukup won his third feature of the season battling with Chris Johnson of Bloomfield in the closing laps.

A late caution broke a side-by-side battle between the two drivers and on the restart, Sukup pulled away for the win. Brad Vogt of Pierce finished third and Chad Jensen of Norfolk placed fourth.

A bigger battle came in the hunt for the track championship as this season the cars were inverted, putting the top-point getters in the back of the field.

Zach Zentner of Cedar Rapids went into the night with a two-point lead over Jim Johnson of Plainview and a four-point lead over Travis Birkley of Wakefield and Robert Osborne of Norfolk.

Division rookie Zentner's title bid ended when his motor shutoff and he was pushed off the track after a mechanical failure on lap six of the 25-lap race.

With Zentner out, the atten-
tion went to Birkley who at the time had a three-point lead on Johnson.

Eleven more laps went by as Johnson tried to get by Birkley. Johnson pushed the issue and out-braked Birkley into turn one on lap 17.

The two touched as Johnson got by and Birkley had to slow up. That allowed Cory Dumpert of York to get by.
A half lap later, Birkley tried to get back under Johnson, but Dumpert also tried for the same real estate. They touched tires and Birkley's car spun out.

Birkley was sent to the rear of the field, giving Johnson a clear path.

Johnson picked up his first title at the track, topping Osborne by five points. Johnson also took titles in Albion and Columbus this season.

Birkley was fourth, eight points back, and Zentner fell to fourth in the points.

Ben Sukup (07) won his fourth feature of the season, the most in the class.

Mielke captures title

With only eight points separating first and second, points leader Lance Mielke just needed to have a good finish to capture his first track title.

As soon as the green flag dropped, the Norfolk driver slipped in behind Shannon Pospisil of Norfolk, who was second in the points.

As Dustin Jackson of O'Neill dashed out front, Pospisil was trying to quickly move through the field and put cars between him and Mielke.

It took until lap eight for Pospisil to move into second, but Mielke had followed him through the field. Pospisil came up a few laps short as he closed to the bumper of Jackson on the final lap.

It was Jackson's fifth victory of the season. Pospisil took
second, but Mielke managed a fourth place finish to win the track title.

Mielke had three wins and 15 out 16 top 5 s . He finished fourth in the standings last season with four victories and 10 top 5 s .

Pospisil was second in the points with two victories and 12 top 5 s . He was third last season with no wins and 11 top 5 s .

Brooke Fluckiger of Columbus was third in the points with one win and 12 top 5 s . Jackson was fourth in the standings with five wins, the most in the class. He had 11 top 5 s .

The 2015 point standings runner-up, Tanner Uehling of Norfolk took fifth in the standings with this season. He had four top 5 s .

Six cautions plagued the SportMods feature last week, but when it was over and done, Kyle Prauner of Norfolk picked up his $11^{\text {th }}$ win of the season and the track title.

Eric Haase of Norfolk led the first three laps, as Prauner climbed from his sixth place starting position to second in three laps.

A caution came out and bunched the field. On the restart, Prauner drove under Haase and picked up the lead.

He won the 15-lap race by half-a-straightway. Haase followed through for second.

Third went to Dylan Pospisil of Norfolk and Derek Sehi of Neligh placed fourth. Rounding out the top 5 was Troy Bruns of Wayne.

Prauner picked up his second track title with 20 career
track feature wins and 28 top 5 finishes in 30 feature starts.

He finished 58 points ahead of the second-place car of Nelson Vollbrecht of Stanton. Vollbrecht was second going into last week, but did not attend the championship night.

Vollbrecht had 10 top 5 s this season and has 18 career top 5 s . In the last two seasons, he finished second in the points.
Third in points went to Colby Langenberg of Norfolk, who also did not attend the final point night. Langenberg finished with nine top 5 s . The previous season he finished fourth in the points.

Derik Fox of Stanton was fourth in the standings and Derek Sehi of Neligh moved into the top 5 when Cameron Meyer of Pierce did not attend championship night.
