Berck claims another Norfolk win

A first turn incident gave Kyle Berck the break he needed last Saturday night during the Super Late Model Racing special event, as it gave him a second chance at the start of the 30-lap feature.

The Marquette driver started on the pole and when he entered the first turn he pushed up the track and fell back to fifth place.

However, a quick caution came out when several stacked up behind him and brought out the caution and reset the field.

“We had the car setup a lot tighter than I thought it (the track) would be and it pushed real bad in that first corner,” said Berck. He adjusted the

brakes and on the second start he hit the corner better and pretty much left the field behind.

The race went uninterrupted as Berck and the second place car of RC Whitwell of Tuscon out ran the field.

Berck caught the back of the field by lap seven and continued to lap cars until he had all but nine cars overlapped.

Second went to Whitwell. Norfolk’s Tad Pospisil placed third and Bill Leighton, Jr. of Omaha was fourth.

Justin Zeitner of LaVista rounded out the top 5. Jim Johnson of Plainview was the highest Off Road Speedway regular at the 10th position.

Fluckiger led the first five laps, but as Meyer was working the inside of her, she slowed exiting turn two and eventually stopped on the track bringing out the only caution of the race.

On the restart, Meyer was

first leading Jake Timm of Pierce, who drives Meyer's back-up car.

The two drove away from the rest of the field. It was Meyer's third win of the season and Timm's second top 5.

Third went to Shannon Pospisil for his seventh top 5.

Max Anderson of Norfolk came home fourth for his fourth top 5 as Codie Mielke of Norfolk rounded out the top 5 in his new ride.



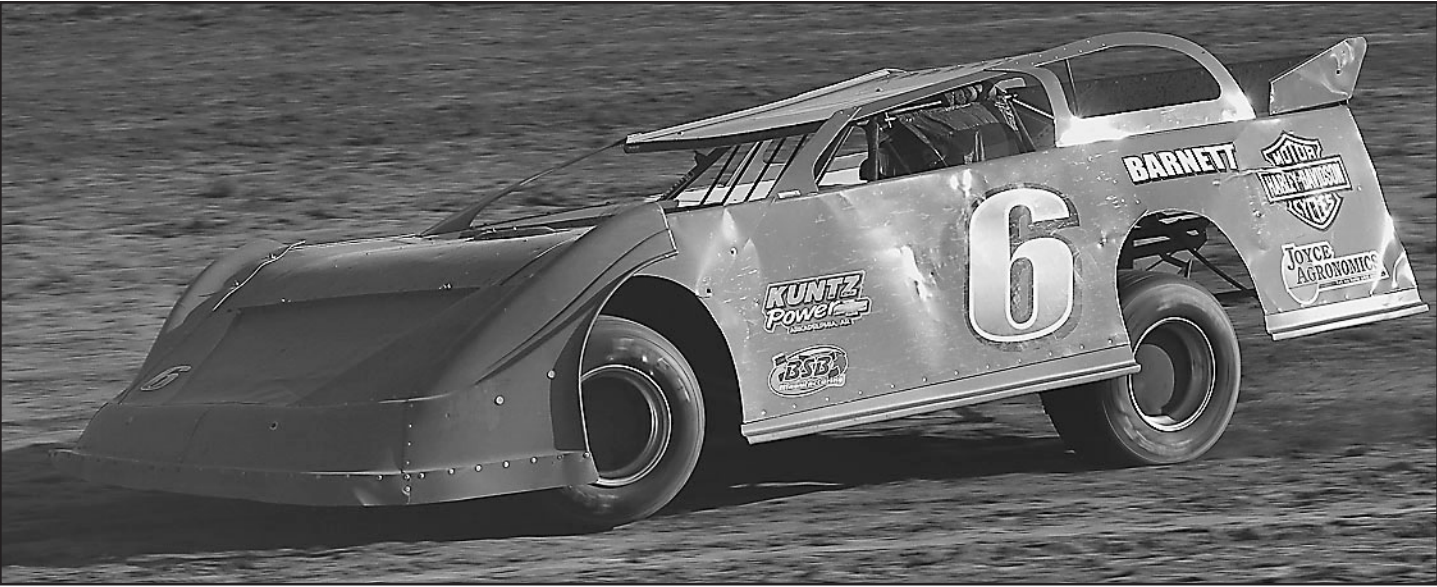

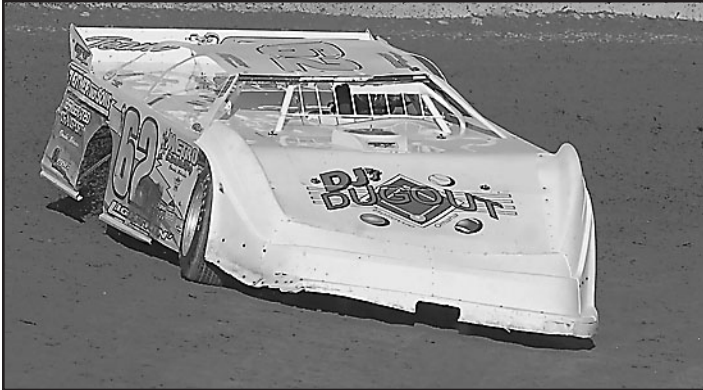

Nate DeSive of Verdigre led the first two laps before Gage Koch of Norfolk made the pass for the lead. Koch led for three

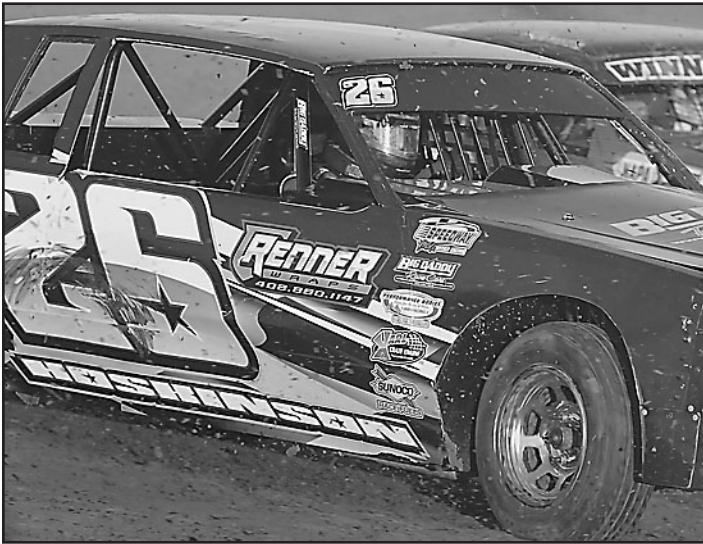
laps before Mielke worked his way by on lap six.
