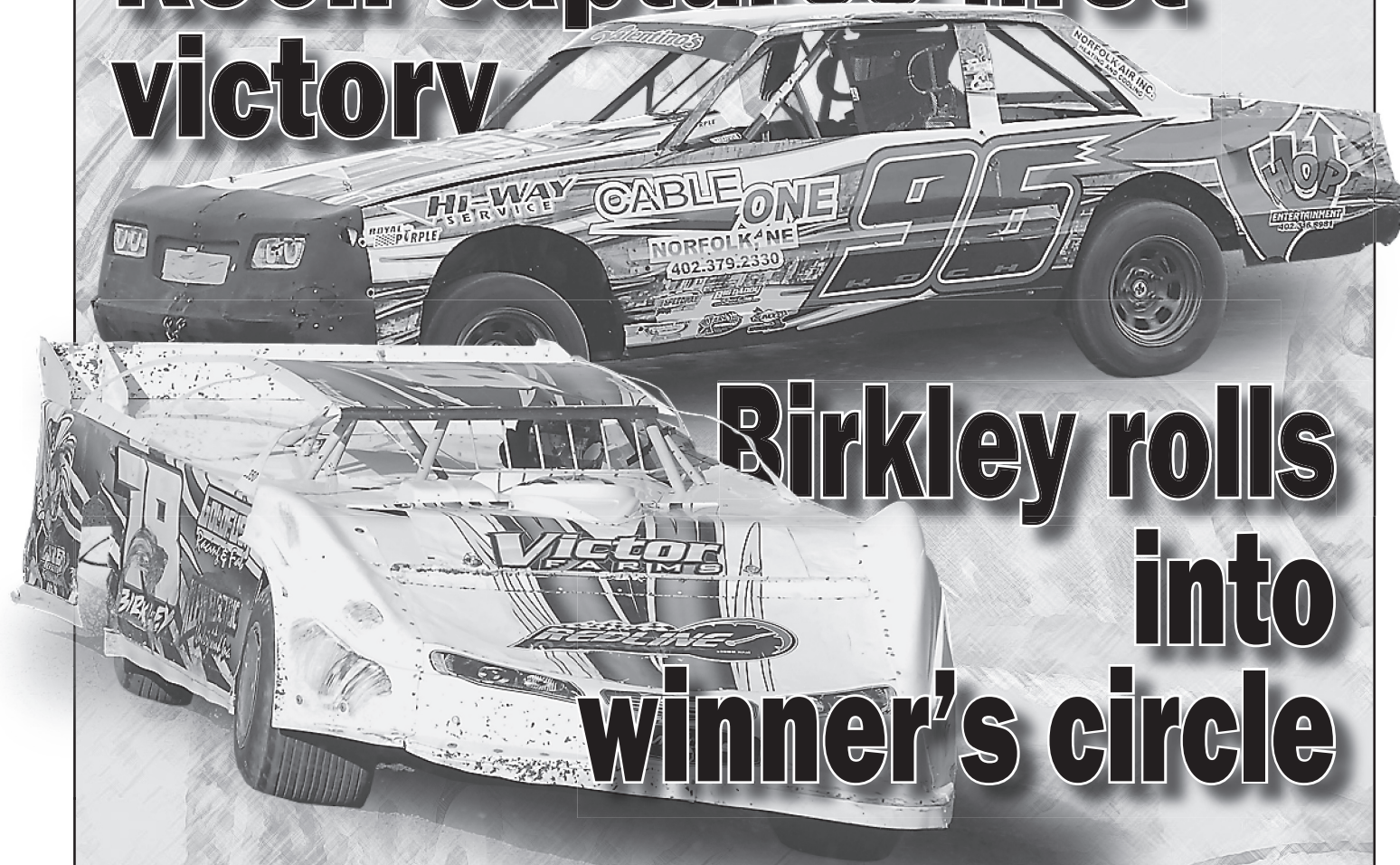

Prauner returns to winning ways

Norfolk's Kyle Prauner returned to his winning ways in the SportMods last week to give him his seventh win of the season.

Dylan Pospisil of Norfolk did a slide job on the field to take the lead in the first turn from his second row starting position.

He led for five laps, before Prauner passed on the inside for the lead. Pospisil tried to get the position back but spun.

Once racing resumed three more cautions slowed the field. The final caution was thrown after Prauner had taken the white flag. That set up a green-white-checked finish.

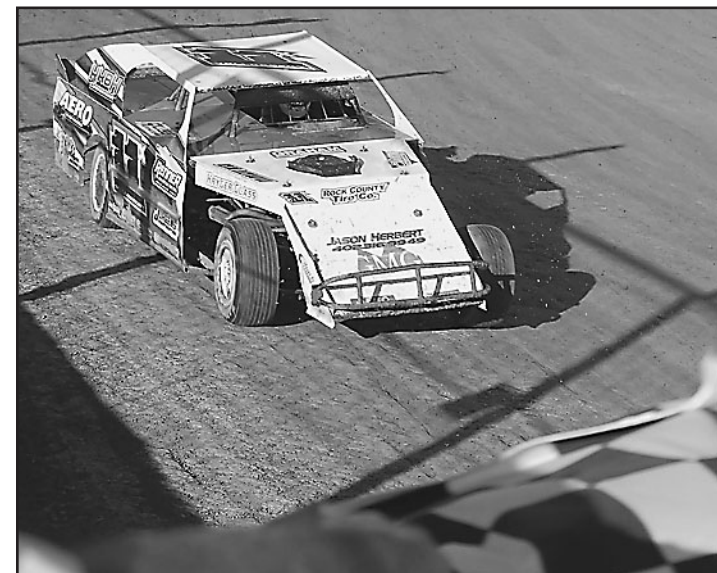
On the restart, Prauner took off with Oakdale's Dean Wilkinson in tow. Prauner pulled away for a half-straight-away win.

Wilkinson, who had run second most of the race, was challenged by Colby Langenberg of Norfolk.

The two nearly collided in turn two, but Langenberg backed out to avoid taking Wilkinson out.

Wilkinson went on to finish second, as Langenberg lost three positions to finish fifth.

Points leader Nelson Vollbrecht of Stanton finished third, as James Roebuck of Genoa was fourth.

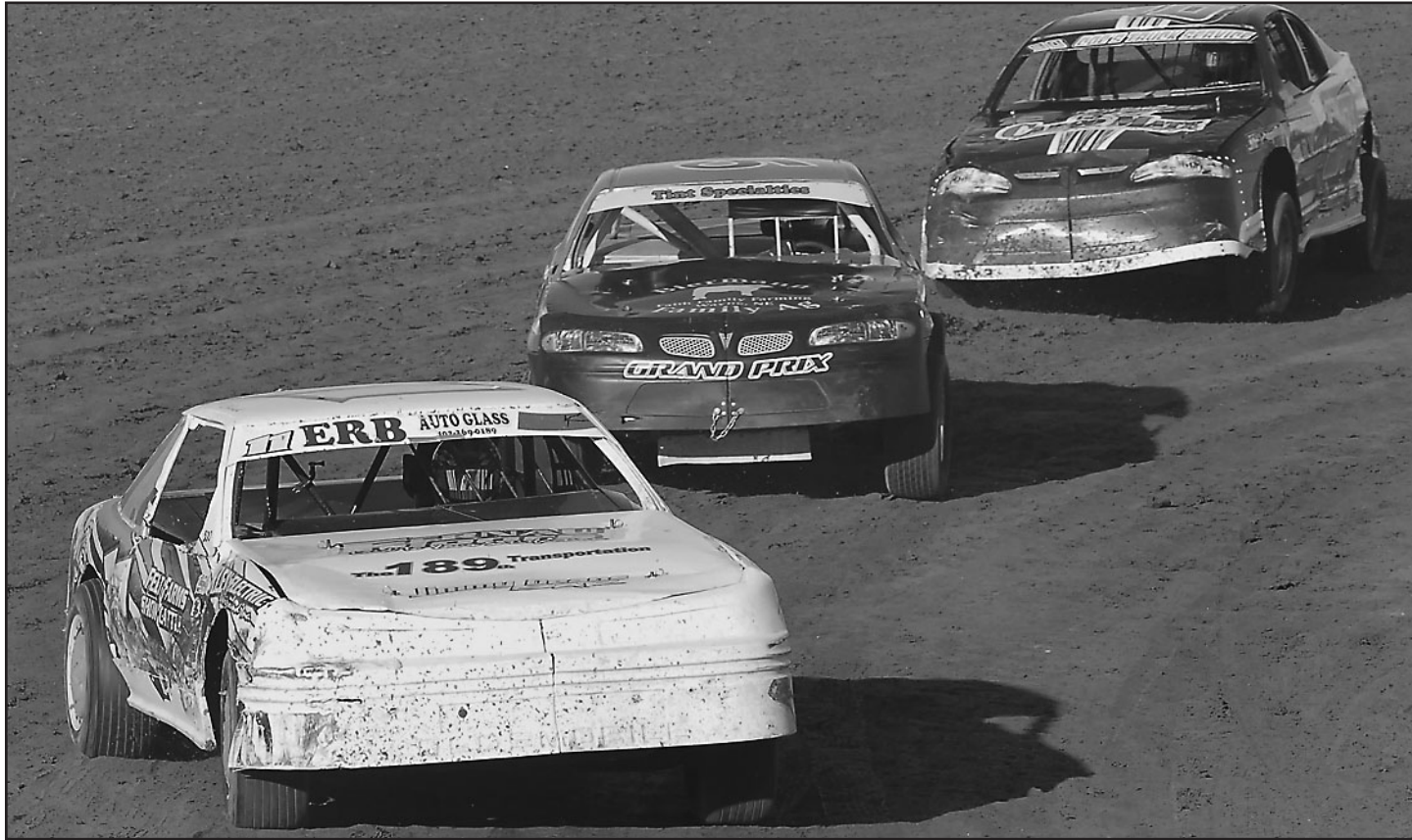

Bertschinger successfully made the pass for the lead to take the white flag. Bruns came back on the inside to take the win by a bumper.



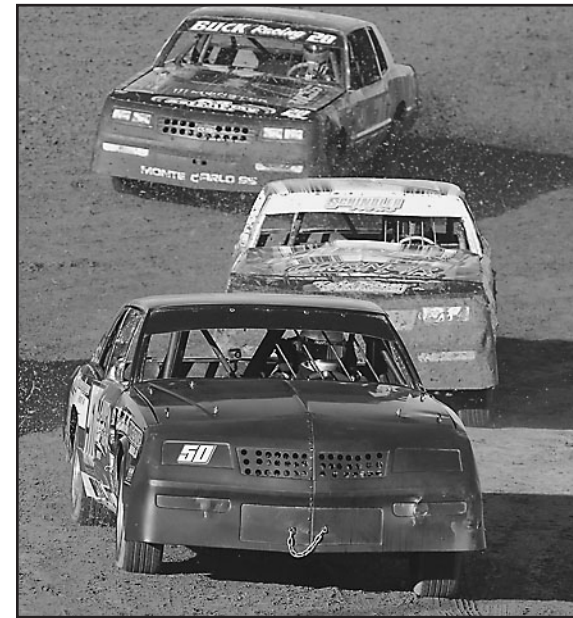

Koch holds off field for first track victory

Next up was three-time winner TeJay Mielke of Norfolk. In the closing laps, Mielke was

able to get alongside out of the turn four, but each time Koch came back.

The two cars were side-by-side to take the white flag with Koch having the advantage.

Koch gave Mielke room on the bottom but just enough. Mielke needed just a little more room on the exit but had to back off the throttle to catch his car from getting into Koch.

That gave Koch a clean run through three and four for the win. Mielke finished second.

Jim Kimmel and Jeremy Hoskinson, both of Norfolk finished third and fourth respectively.

Rounding out the top 5 was Tiffany Bittner of Norfolk.

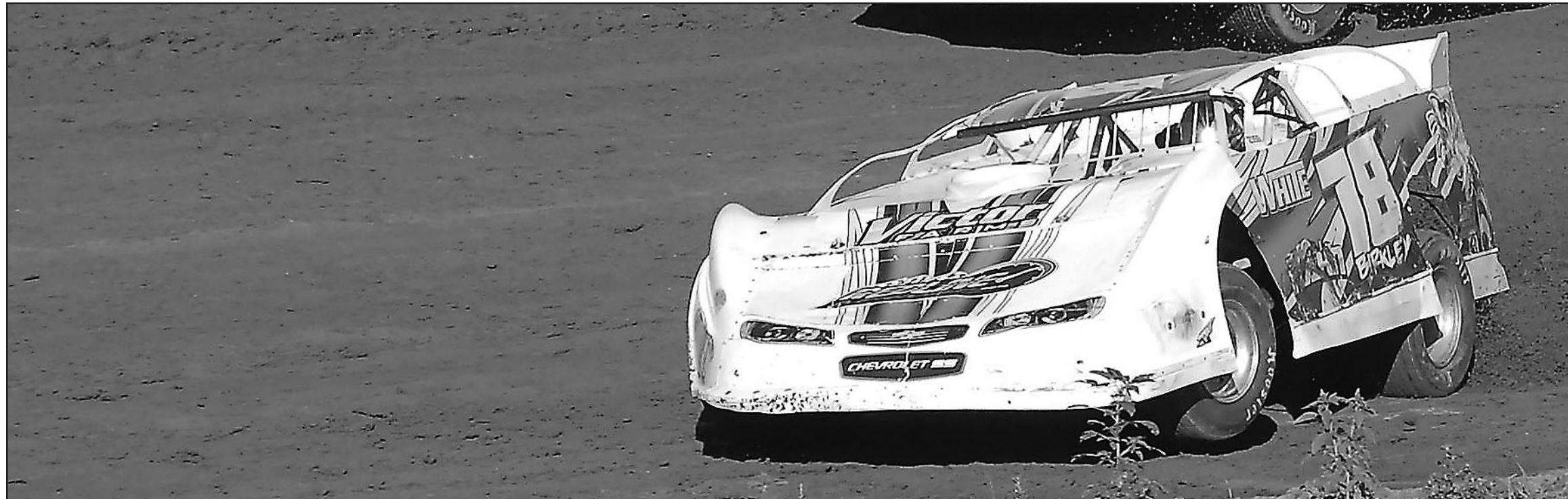

field and led the final eight laps for the win.

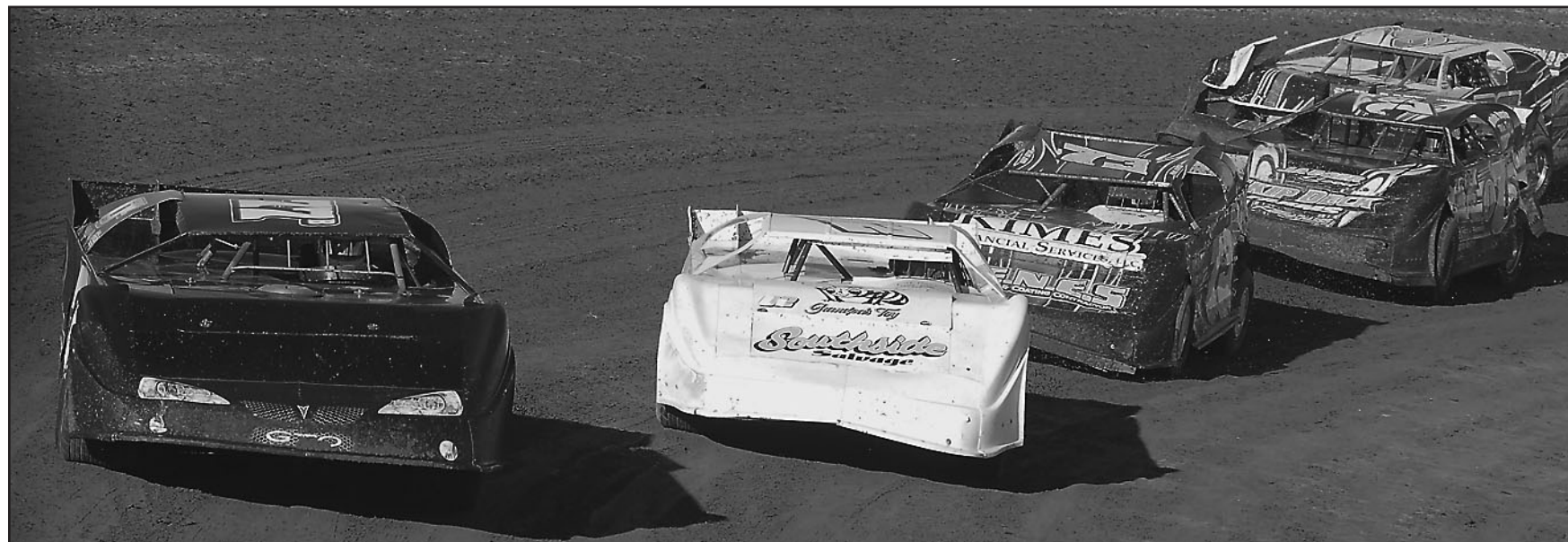
Milander and Vogt battled for several more laps exchanging the runner-up position a couple times before Milander made the pass with three laps remaining.
