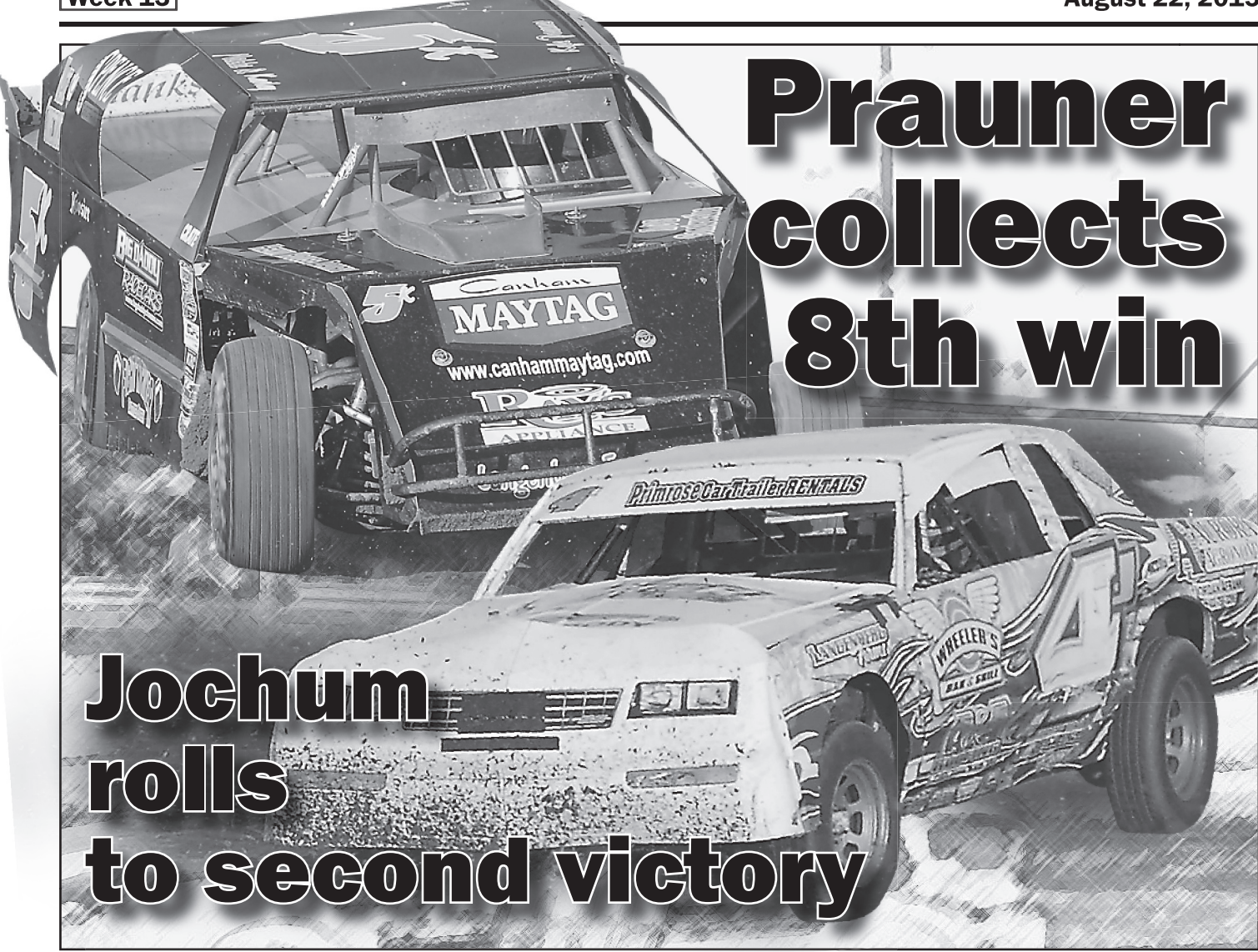

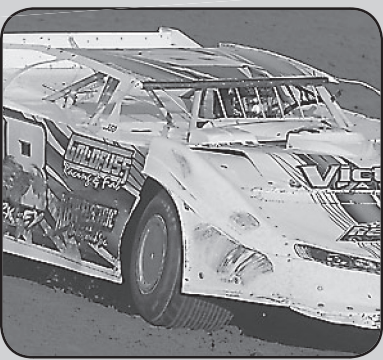

# Birkley scores second victory

However, the race got interesting when slow traffic allowed the second place car of Jim Johnson of Plainview to close the gap.

But like Birkley, Johnson had to pick his way through the same slower cars. When John-

son cleared the cars with two laps remaining, he was able to close the gap fast.

Johnson trailed by four-car lengths taking the white flag and got to Birkley's bumper in turn four and came up two car-lengths at the checkered flag.

It was Birkley's second win and fifth top 5. Johnson matched his highest finish at second. It was his fourth top 5.

Pierce's Bob Milander rolled through third for his fifth top 5. Fourth went to Chad Jensen of Norfolk for his fifth top 5.

Rounding out the top 5 was Brad Vogt of Pierce.

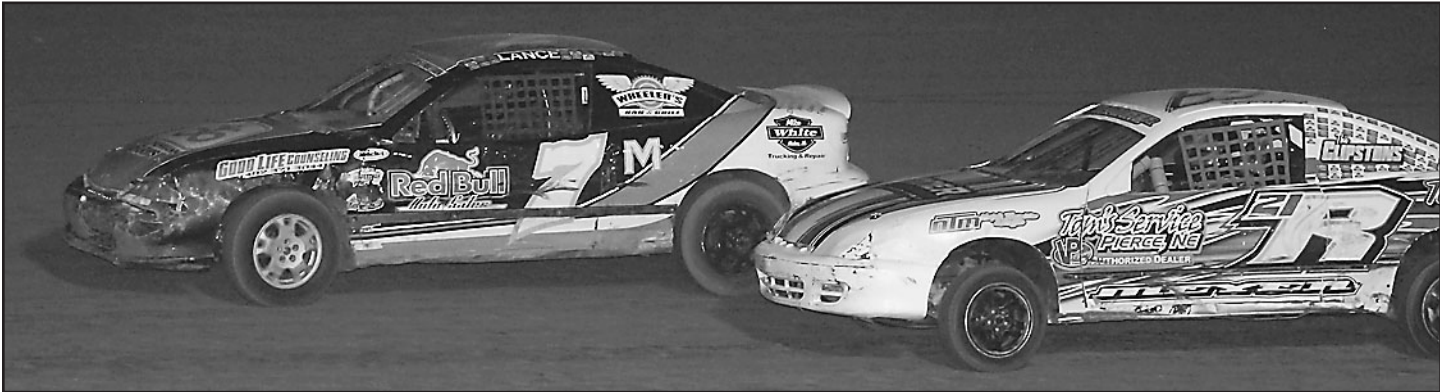

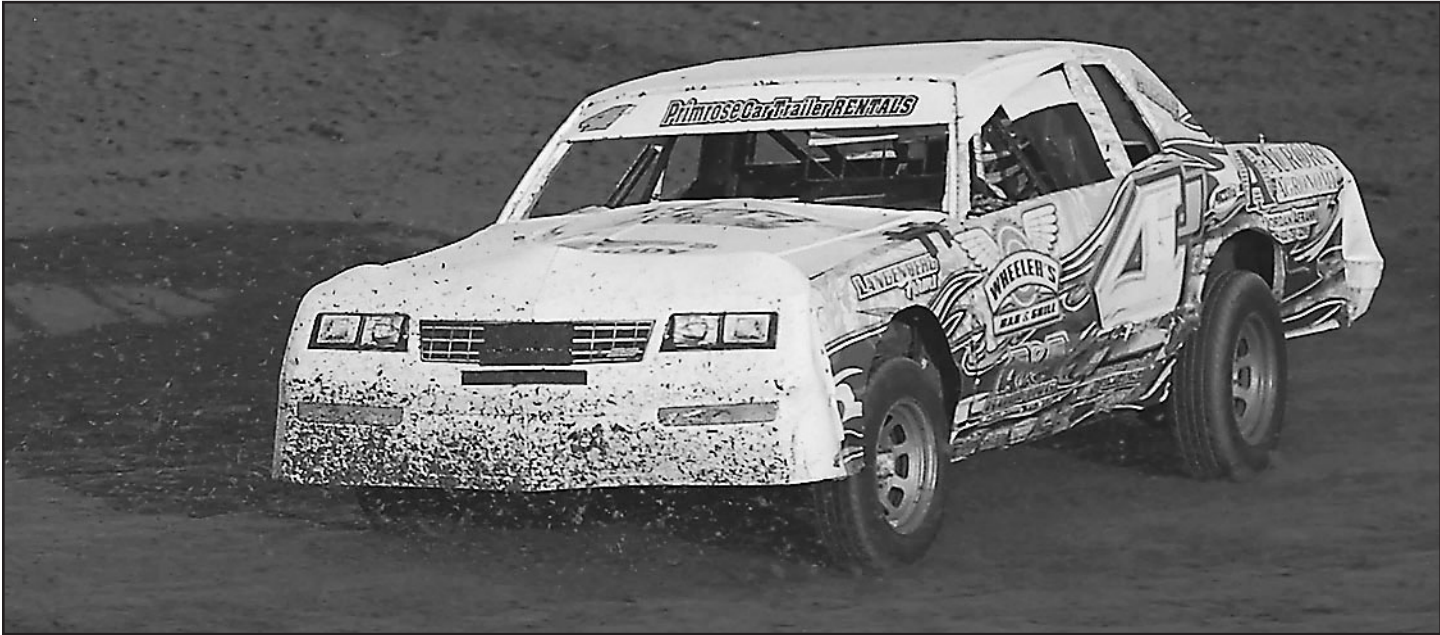

# Prauner grabs his eighth victory

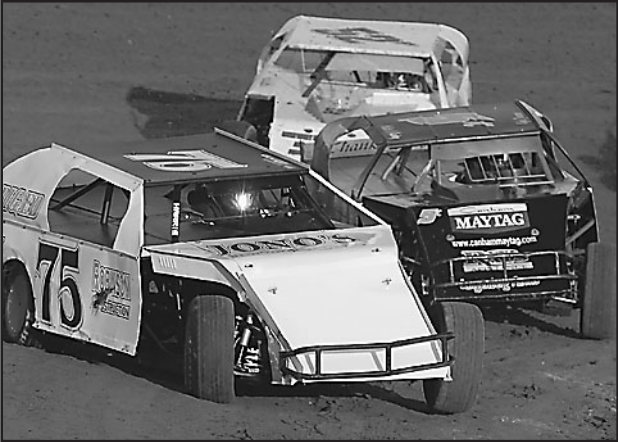
