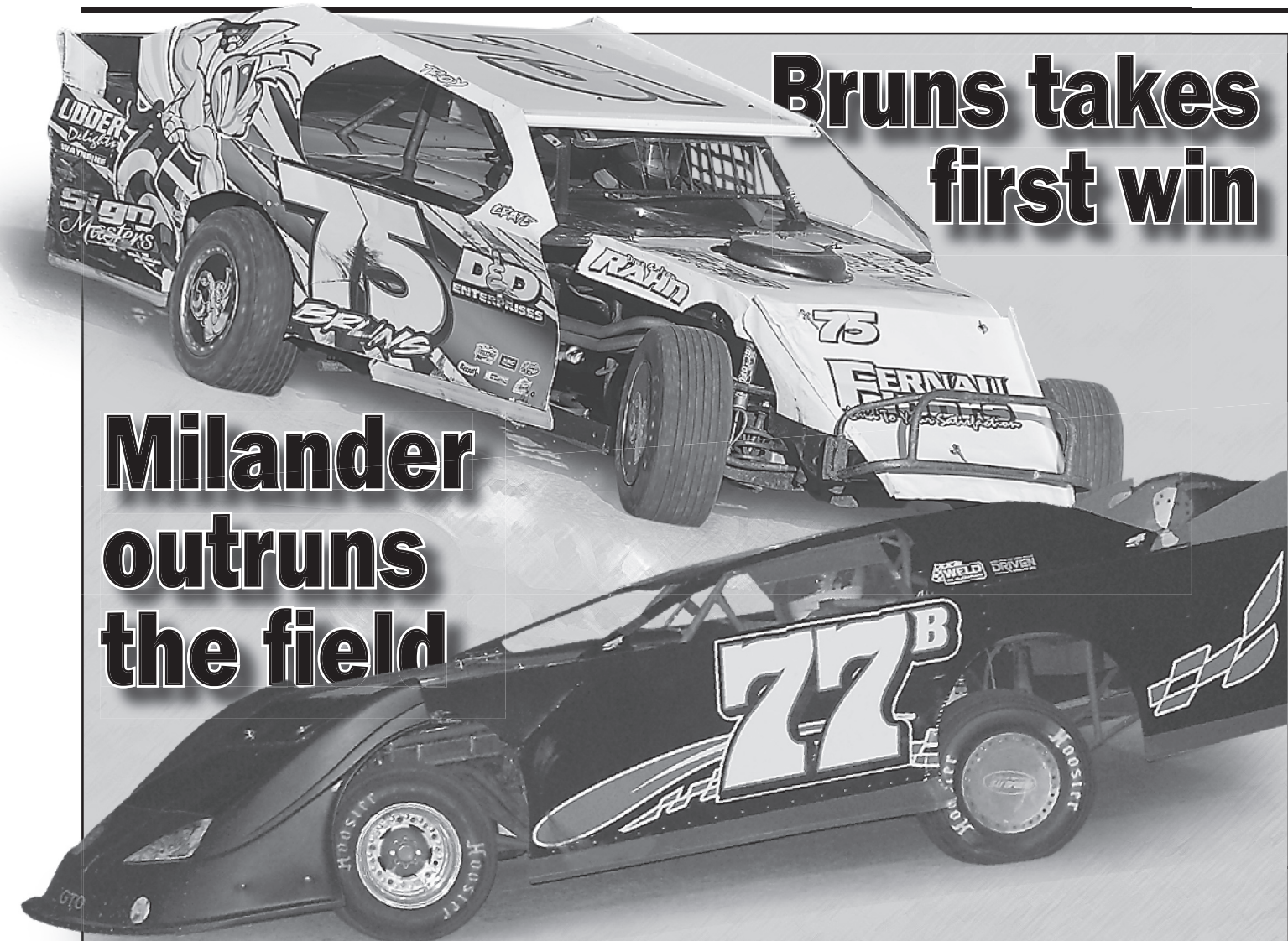

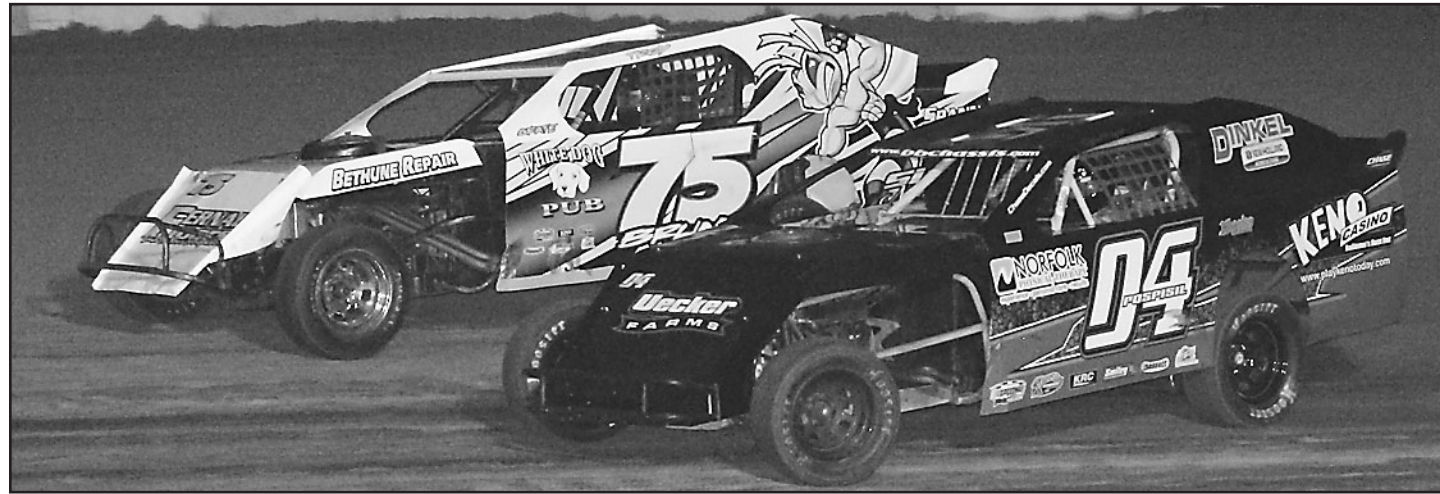

zip back to the inside. Finally on lap 12, Bruns got a good run out of turn four to take the lead for good.

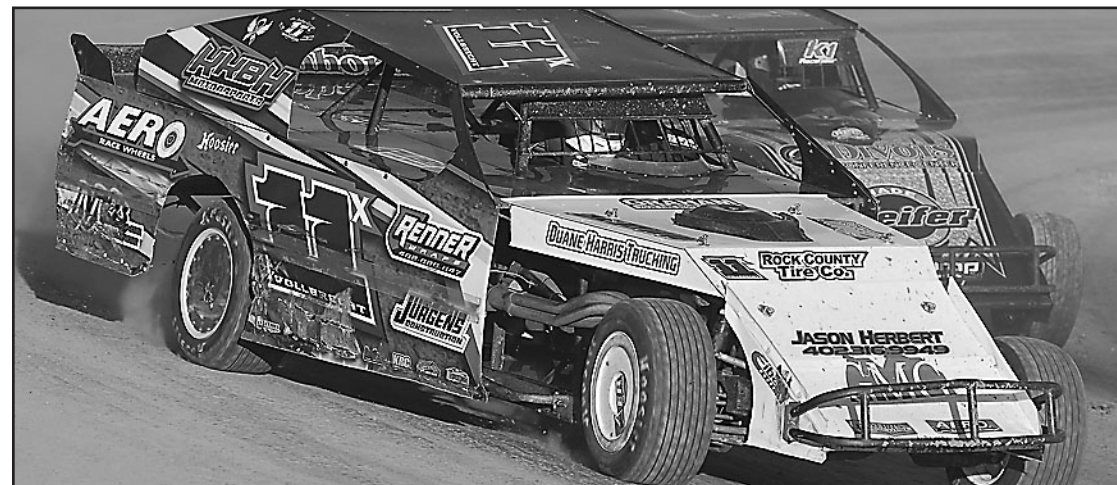
Pospisil, however, did not go away. Pospisil drove deep into the corners and gained on Bruns, but Bruns momentum would spring him back out front on the exits of the turns.

Fourth went to Wyatt Lehman of Norfolk who started the race on the outside of row six. Starting on the outside of the front row, Codie Mielke rounded out the top 5.

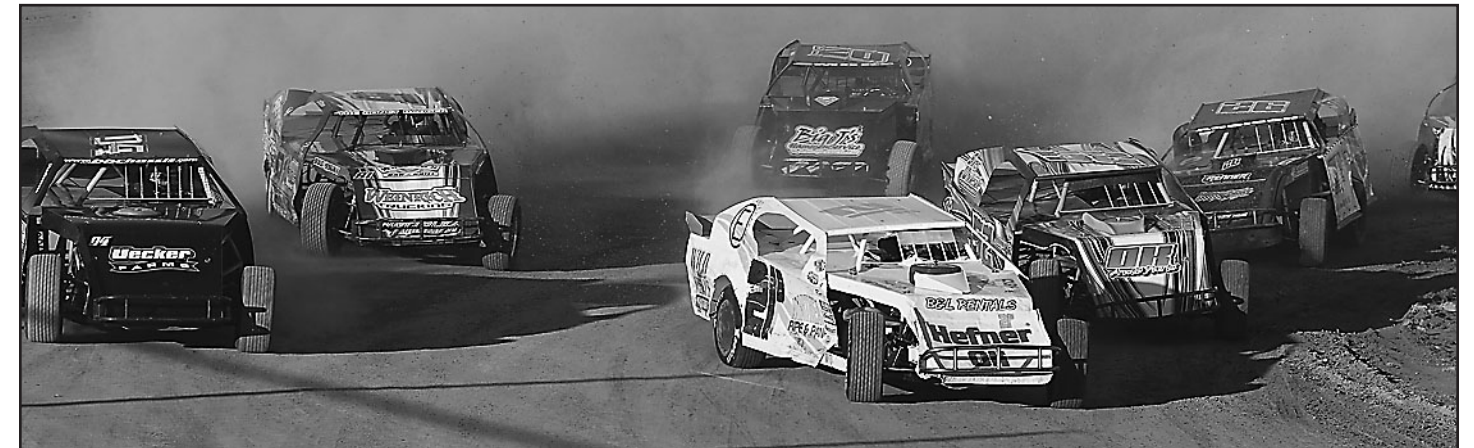

Travis Birkley of Wakefield took fourth place and Doug Tomka rounded out the top 5.

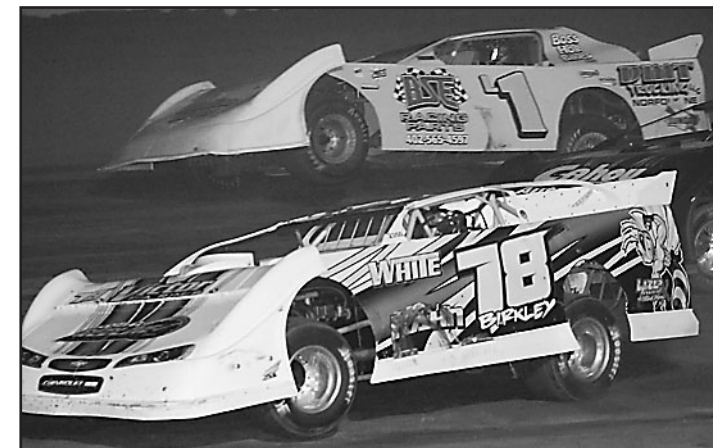
