However, a caution erased the gap and that gave Prauner another chance. For the final 11 laps, Bruns and Prauner battled for the win.


Bruns held the advan-

Jochum inherited the lead, but only had it for one lap before Arduser's problem brought out the caution.

On the restart, TeJay Mielke of Norfolk dashed out front. Mielke paced the field for seven laps before mechanical problems ended his night for the second straight week – both

times while leading.

Once again, Jochum inherited the lead and on the final restart, the field bunched for a three-lap shootout. Jochum was leading, two-time feature winner Tiffany Bittner of Norfolk second and Jeremy Hoskinson of Norfolk third.


Hoskinson went straight to the front and took the white flag first, but Jochum fought back on the inside. The two touched exiting turn four, Jochum came out ahead for the win and Hoskinson took second. The next two laps had five cau-

tions, but Johnson found himself going backwards instead of forward.

Finally, on the fifth restart, Johnson gathered his momentum and went straight to the front in two laps using the high side.

Johnson was stretching his half straightaway lead when the final caution came out on lap 10.

On the restart, Johnson pulled away again and left the battle for second between Haase and Doug Tomka of Stanton. Tomka took the position for three laps.
