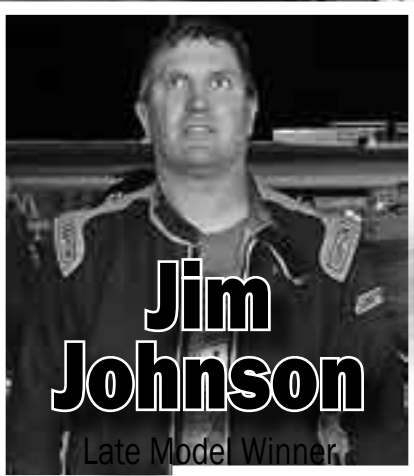

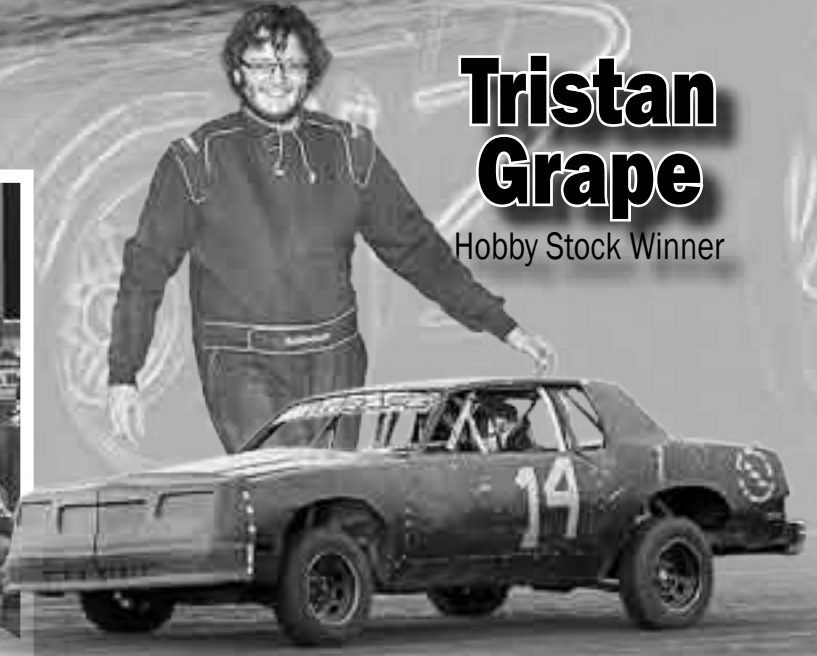

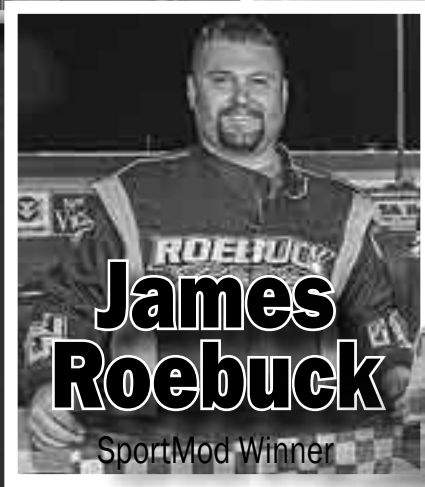

Johnson earns third victory

When Jim Johnson pulled off the track two weeks ago, he thought he finished second.

However, the Plainview driver collected his third win of the season when Travis Birkley of Wakefield was disqualified for the night.

Junior Coover of Norfolk led the first part of the feature, before Birkley got by as Johnson slipped passed his nephew, Devin Johnson of Bloomfield for third.

On the final caution of the night with 10 laps remaining, Jim Johnson was all over Birkley's bumper but was not able to make the pass.

Birkley crossed the line first by a car length. However, the post-race disqualification gave Johnson his third victory of the season and his fourth top 5.

Nelson Vollbrecht of Stanton jumped passed Devin Johnson for third (eventually second with the disqualification) with four laps remaining to cross the line and take his third top 5 of the season.

Chase Osborne of Norfolk got by Devin Johnson in the closing laps to finish third. Devin Johnson earned fourth for his third top 5. Rounding out the top 5 was Eric Vanosdall of Hoskins.

Brauner's second win

Seven cautions in the first 11 laps did not hinder Austin Brauner to pick up his second feature win of the season two weeks ago.

The Platte Center driver started on the outside of the third row and was running third after three laps. He got to second by lap four and passed Hans Houfek of Emerson for the lead on lap seven.

As the field sorted itself out behind him, Brauner pulled away to win by a straightaway. It was the defending champion's third top 5 of the season.

TeJay Mielke of Norfolk

took home second passing Houfek with three laps remaining. It was Mielke's second top 5 of the season.

Houfek crossed the line third for his second top 5 so far this season. Fred DeSive of O'Neill raced in the top 5 for most of the race. He finished fourth for his first top 5 this season.

Rounding out the top 5 was Kyle Wilkinson of Neligh. It was his fifth top 5.

Jeremy Hoskinson and Tanner Pettitt, both of Norfolk, each won their heat race. It was Hoskinson's third heat race victory and Pettitt's first.

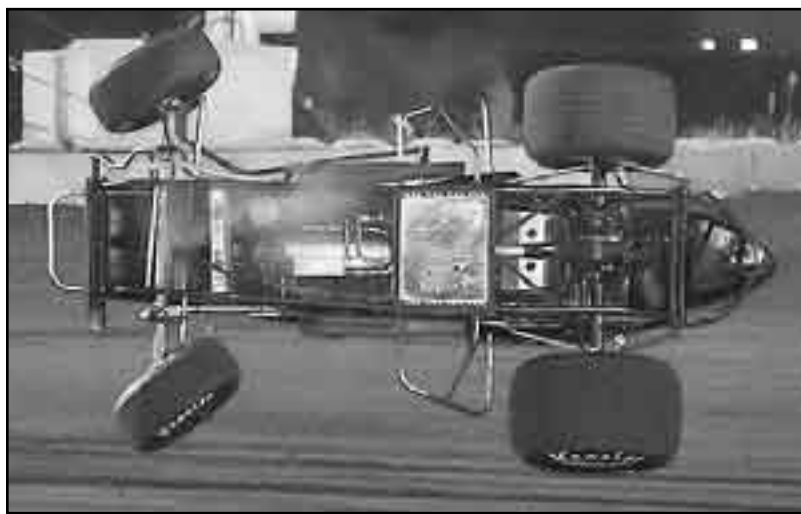

Grape takes first win

Tristan Grape was on a tear last few weeks at multiple tracks as he had no trouble capturing his first feature victory at the track.

The Columbus driver started on the outside pole position and left the rest of the field to battle for second.

The final nine laps went uninterrupted and he pulled away to win in only his fifth visit to the track in the last four years. His best finish going into the night was seventh last season.

Jason Wilkinson continued his top 2 finishes with only his second runner-up finish. Wilkinson got to second with six laps remaining but did not have enough to time to run down Grape.

Wyatt Lehman of Norfolk took home third. He got the position with seven laps re-

maining. It was his third top 5 of the season.

Nate DeSive of O'Neill cruised in fourth for his fifth top 5 of the season.

Rounding out the top 5 was Travis Coover of Neligh. He ran in the top 3 for numerous laps but faded in the final laps. It was his third top 5 this season.

Nate Buck of Neligh won the B feature with Shannon Pospisil of Norfolk, Jeremy Shutt of Atkinson and Trent Johnson of Bloomfield also transferring to the main event.

Buck had the beat finish of the four in the A feature with a 11th place finish.
