Sukup victorious, takes title lead

Ben Sukup picked up all the points he could last week, and it paid off.

The Norfolk driver has a one-point lead going into tonight's championship feature over Chase Osborne of Norfolk.

Sukup was down one point to Osborne going into last week after a disqualification the previous week.

He gained one point after the heat races and another three points in the feature to have the advantage going into the championship.

Last season, Sukup lost the championship by two points when the season finale rained out.

Last week, Sukup led the final 17 laps for the victory. He broke into the top three on lap three after starting outside the fourth row.

He moved into second by lap 5. He gained the lead on lap nine.

While Sukup was out front, Osborne worked his way through the field.

Osborne was seventh after 16 laps, gained two more spots by lap 21 and finished fourth.

Robert Osborne of Norfolk finished second behind Sukup after leading six laps. Cory Dumpert of York took third.

Matt Haase placed fifth, he led two laps early in the feature.



Ben Sukup (07) scored his third victory of the season and takes a one point lead in the standings.

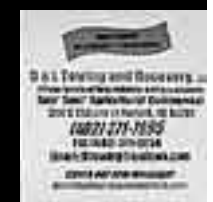
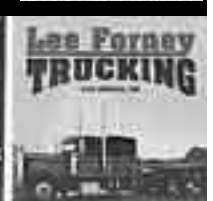
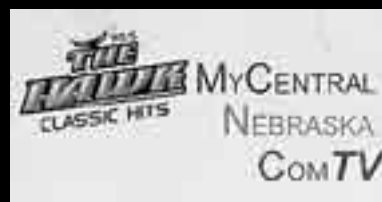
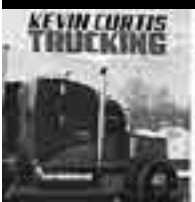
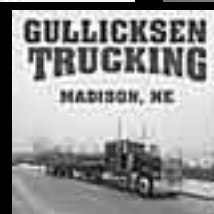
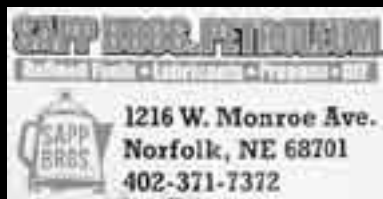

Prauner wins third feature of season

Kyle Prauner led the final eight laps to pick up his third feature victory of the season.

The Norfolk driver started on the third row outside and broke into the top three on lap five of the 18-lap feature.

After the first of two cautions, Prauner was challenging Wes Hochstein of Randolph for the lead. Hochstein led nine laps before Prauner slipped by on the high side.

After the final caution was thrown with five laps remaining, Prauner pulled away as the runner-up position heated up.

It was his third win and his eighth top 5.

Cameron Meyer of Pierce, Colby Langenberg of Norfolk and Hochstein battled for the second spot in the closing laps.

Langenberg, who brought out the first caution and was

sent to the rear of the field, found several openings and made it three wide with four laps remaining.

With three laps left, Meyer secured the second spot. It was his fourth top 5 of the season.

Langenberg came back to press Hochstein for third. Langenberg, who has a good handle on the champion title, brushed the wall to take the white flag trying to get alongside Hochstein.

Hochstein edged out Langenberg at the checkered flag by inches.

Hochstein was third for his fifth top 5. Langenberg was fourth to complete every race this season in the top 5.

Joey Haase of Norfolk placed fifth a car length behind Langenberg.

Kyle Prauner (5K) led eight laps to win his third feature of the season.

Bruns second win

Chad Bruns wisely switched paths halfway through the feature to pick up his second win of the season.

The Wakefield driver tried several times to get under the leader, Fred DeSive of O'Neill, in the corners but without making contact, Bruns could not get the space he needed.

Switching to the top, Bruns slowly gained on the leader. But it was not until Cameron Wilkinson of Neligh started battling with DeSive, that Bruns made big gains and eventually the lead.

A late caution set up a two-

lap shootout. Bruns slipped away from the field as six cars battled for second. He took the win by two car lengths.

Austin Brauner of Platte Center crossed the line second. After the final restart, Brauner of was three wide for awhile before pulling an advantage over third. It was his fifth top 5.

DeSive must only lead the final lap in the race, Nate DeSive led the field for two laps to pick up his first victory of the season.

O'Neill driver used the final lap to climb his way to the top. He was third by lap eight and fourth by lap 10. The final laps he spent on getting alongside Nate DeSive, who had led 13 laps before the drop of the green flag.

DeSive got alongside, he moved out front for the win and his fourth top 5 of the season.

DeSive crossed the line second for his fourth top 5.

DeSive went to Stephanie Reyn-

olds of Norfolk. She passed Parker Vollbrecht for the spot with five laps remaining. It was her best finish this season and her second top 5.

Lance Mielke finished fourth for his sixth top 5. Rounding out the top 5 was points leader Jason Wilkinson of Neligh. Wilkinson found himself trailing the field with eight laps left.

Wilkinson made up most of the positions on the final two laps to set up a close battle in the title hunt.
