# Johnson wins second of season

David Johnson powered his way to the front of the field and posted his second win of the season.

The Columbus driver worked his way to the front and battled with Jacob Kubik of Stuart for several laps before securing the top spot. Kubik led the first eight laps, as Johnson led the final 10.

A caution with five laps left gave the rest of a field a glimmer of hope. However, Johnson went back to work and pulled away for his second win of the

season. Newcomer Keegan Nordquist of Beresford, SD could only watch Johnson get smaller after the final restart.

Nordquist edged out Cameron Meyer of Pierce for the second position. Meyer tied his worse finish in four nights at third. Meyer is the only driver in all classes to have finished in the top 5 each night.

Another newcomer Devon McMartin of Canton, SD finished fourth, as Kubik rounded out the top 5.

# Johnson, Vollbrecht battle for victory

It came down to a two-lap shootout in the Late Model feature last week with Jim Johnson picking up the victory.

The Plainview driver battled with Stanton's Nelson Vollbrecht for most of the second half of the race. Vollbrecht using the lower line as Johnson used the cushion at the top.

Johnson started on the outside of the second row and was running second after the first lap (however the car was disqualified, giving credit to Johnson for leading the lap).

Johnson pulled away from the field, as Vollbrecht, who started behind Johnson, had to work through the field.

Several cautions later, Vollbrecht started using the lower line and was able to pull alongside Johnson. Johnson using every bit of the track, clipped the back wall several times.

It was after the final caution, Vollbrecht turned up the pressure and for most of the last lap the two were side-by-side.

Johnson held his momentum off turn three and won by a car length. Vollbrecht was second.

Eric Vanosdall of Hoskins was credited with third. Chase Osborne of Norfolk finished fourth and Kyle Prauner of Norfolk rounded out the top 5.

# Wilkinson claims second victory of season

A green-white-checked finish in the Hobby Stock gave Jason Wilkinson an easier win than if the feature had finished in regulation laps.

The Neligh driver took the white flag the first time as Lance Mielke of Norfolk and Ryan Fajman of Albion was knocking on his back bumper.

Fajman had pulled alongside Wilkinson on the backstretch and as they entered turn

three the yellow came out.

On the restart, Wilkinson had a better restart than the other two and cruised to win his second feature of the season.

Fajman did not have a good restart but recovered to pass Mielke out of four on the final lap to take second by a few feet.

Fourth went to Mark Arduser of Battle Creek. He battled with Travis

Landauer of Albion to the lead early in the race. Landauer led four laps before Arduser ran him down and made the pass for the top spot.

Arduser led five laps of the 15-lap feature.

Rounding out the top 5 was Nate DeSive of O'Neill.

Hoskinson managed to hold off Iverson which allowed Taylor to rejoin the battle. That gave Hoskinson time to get away and finish second.

Iverson kept Taylor at bay to finish third and Taylor rolled through fourth.
