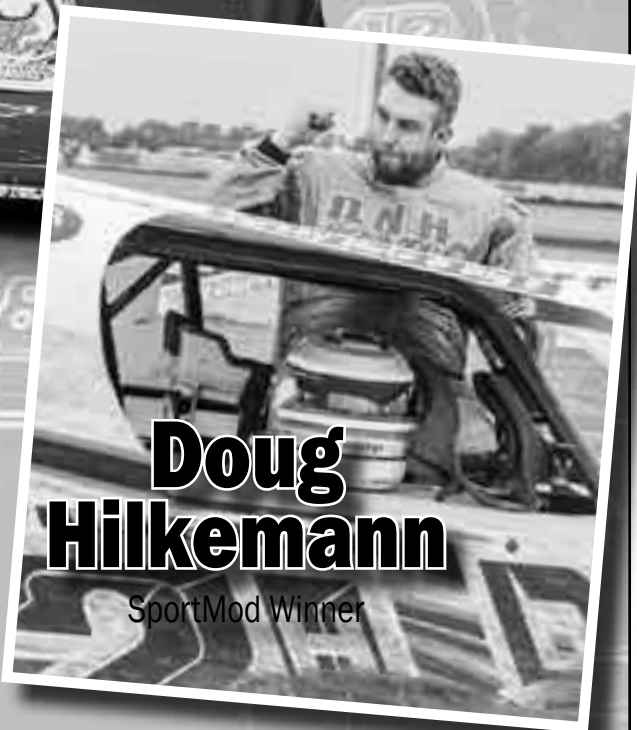

Two straight for Zentner

Winning his second straight feature, Zach Zentner had little trouble again pulling off the win.

The Cedar Rapids driver started on the outside pole and jumped into the early lead with Chase Osborne of Norfolk in tow.

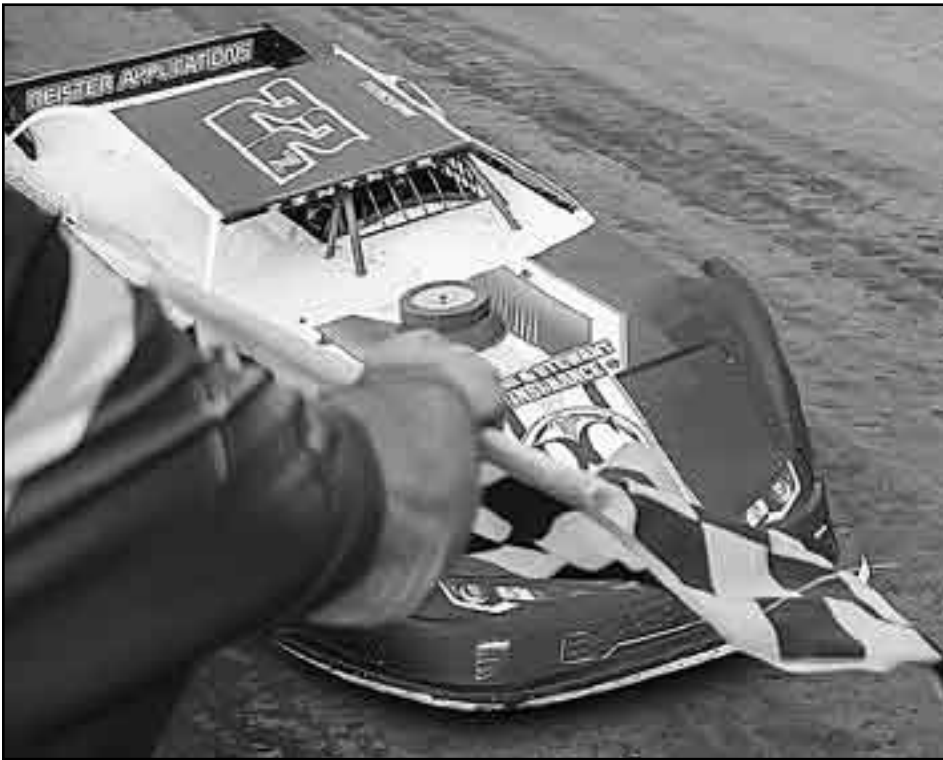
Osborne managed to take advantage of Zentner jumping the cushion early in the race and led two laps.

Zentner regrouped and came back to regain the top position. Two quick cautions set up a long run of 17 laps.

On the final restart, Zentner quickly got away from the field. Osborne was running second until Kyle Prauner of Norfolk hunted him down.

Prauner closed the gap to the leader, however, Zentner won by half a straight-away.

Prauner rolled through second and Osborne was third. Fourth went to defending champion Ben Sukup of Norfolk. Devin Johnson of Bloomfield placed fifth.

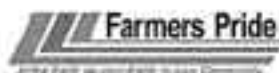

When the caution came out with three laps remaining, the gap was erased, and Cameron was on his brother's bumper for the restart.

At the drop of the green again, Kyle worked the top of the track, and his brother ran the bottom.

With two laps remaining, Cameron pulled alongside and until the end of the race, the brothers ran side-by-side.

Kyle had the advantage on the exits of the turns until the final corner when he pushed too hard and slid up the track.

That gave Cameron the advantage and the victory. Kyle was second, Derek Sehi of Neligh posted his best effort of the season finishing third.

Fourth went to Ryan Harris of Homer and Chuck Sands of Neligh finished fifth.

Mielke victorious

The showdown started with 10 laps remaining and Lance Mielke edged out Tanner Uehling to pick up his second win of the season.

Joe Rosberg led the first five laps before Uehling made the pass for the lead, however, a caution erased the pass.

On the restart, Rosberg started out front, Mielke was on the inside and Uehling was on the outside.

Both cars passed Rosberg. Mielke held the lead down the backstretch only to watch Uehling passing him on the exit of turn four.

The two went side-by-side

with Rosberg for nearly a lap. Uehling and Mielke exchanged the lead a couple of times before Mielke pulled a slight lead over Uehling.

However, Uehling fought back when Mielke struggled through turns one and two.

Uehling made several attempts on the inside to make the pass. But at the checkered flag, Mielke took the win by less than a car length.

Rosberg grabbed his best finish at third place. Fourth went to Mark Arduser of Battle Creek and Jason Wilkinson of Neligh finished fifth.

Doug Hilkemann had what he needed last week to pick up his first feature victory at the track.

The Wynot driver started on the pole and paced the field for several laps before Cameron Meyer of Pierce challenged for the top spot.

It took Meyer a few laps to move into the second spot. Once there, Meyer was able to run down Hilkemann and pull alongside.

Meyer, who managed to lead two laps by just the nose of his car, was in the process of passing Hilkemann when Meyer spun out

Once Gnat secured the second position, he went after Hilkemann. However, the closest he got was a car length away.

It was Hilkemann's first career win at the track and his second top

5 in 12 starts at the track.

Gnat took second just behind Hilkemann. It was Gnat's second runner-up finish this season and his fifth top 5 in eight starts.

Rolling in third was Afrank. It was also his fifth top 5 finish and his second third place finish.

Fourth went to Tim Swartz of Lincoln to tie his best effort of the season. It was his third top 5.

Rounding out the top 5 was Jonathan Jensen of Norfolk. Jensen has only raced the last three nights and has posted two top 5s.
