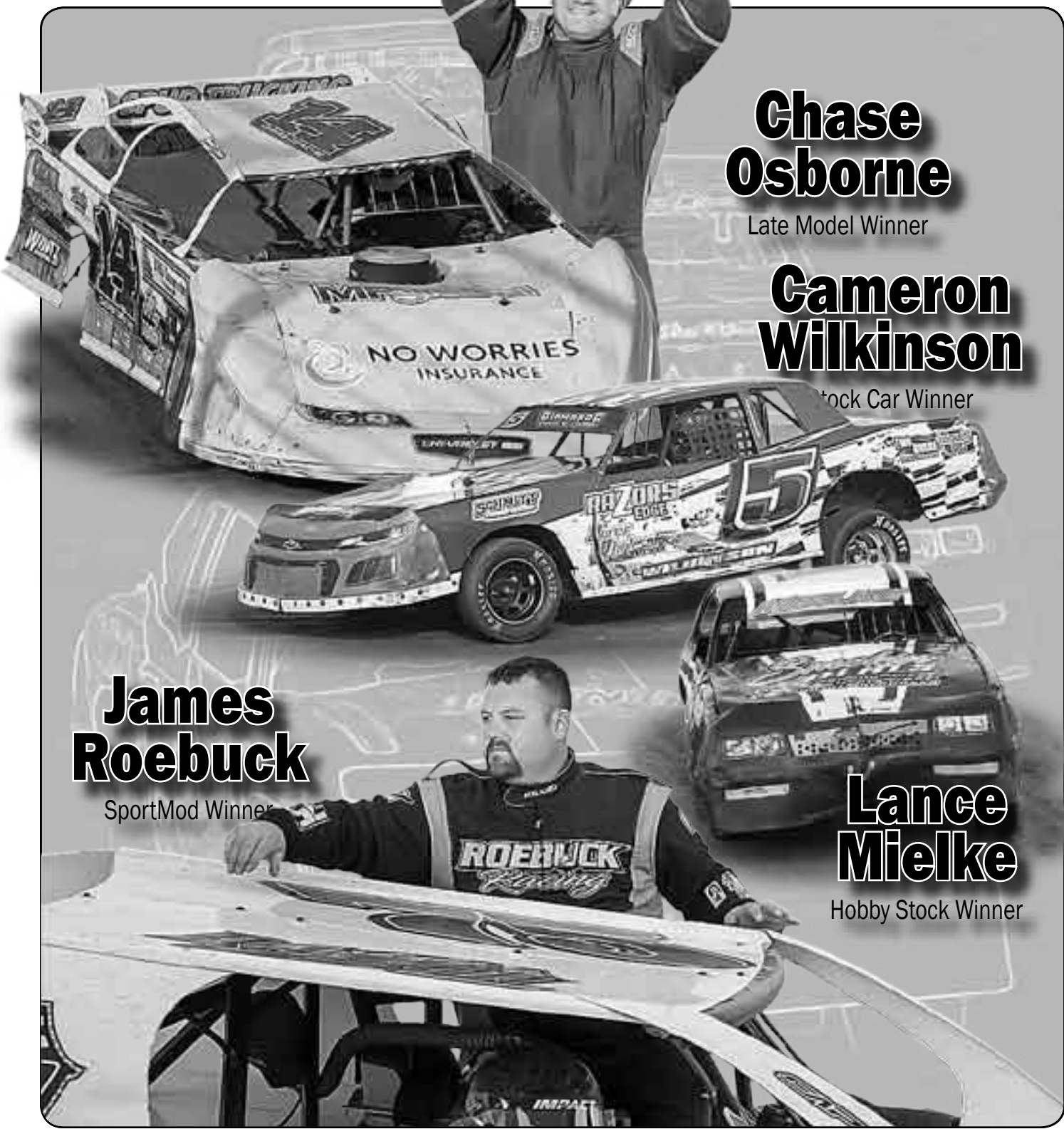

# Roebuck takes second victory

Sticking his car on the high side, James Roebuck powered his way to his second win of the season at the track.

The Genoa driver spent most of the first half of the race doing “slide jobs” on newcomer to the track, Mitch Coble of Columbus.

Three times Roebuck slid in front of Coble and each time Coble did the cross over to regain the spot. The battle was for second place. However, Roebuck had just enough of his nose in front of Coble when a caution came out.

On the restart, Roebuck came alive setting his right rear on the cushion and pulling

away for his seventh career victory at the track.

Coble lead the first three laps before Cameron Meyer of Pierce took over the top spot early in the race. Coble regained the runner-up spot where he finished.

Meyer crossed the line third for his ninth top 5 in the 10 weeks so far. He led 10 laps before Roebuck made the pass.

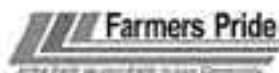
Meyer extended his lead in the points to 10 over Tyler Afrank of Norfolk.

## Wilkinson continues his winning ways

Cameron Wilkinson split the front row at the start of the 20-lap feature and never looked back.

The Neligh driver got a good start and drove between polesitter Derek Sehi of Neligh and Norfolk's Ron Pettitt by turn one.

Sehi led the first lap, but the rest of the race was all Wilkinson. It was his third straight victory and his fourth win of the season.

Wilkinson has five victo-

ries in the Stock Car division since moving up from Hobby Stocks last season. He had 14 victories in the Hobby Stocks for the 2017-2019 seasons.

Chad Bruns of Wakefield got by Sehi to finish second for his fourth top 5 of the season. Sehi placed third for his third top 5.

Tanner Pettitt of Norfolk took home fourth and John Bruegman of Elkhorn claimed the fifth position.

# Mielke grabs third victory of season

Working the high side of the track from the drop of the green, Norfolk's Lance Mielke picked up his third win of the season.

The high side was not the quick way around the track at first, but Mielke got the momentum going and chased down the leader.

Mark Arduser of Battle Creek led the first lap before Shannon Pospisil moved out front.

Pospisil led six laps as Mielke slowly got the high side working.

Mielke led the final eight laps for his third win of the season. Mielke had seven ca-

reer wins in the Sport Compact division before moving up to the Hobby Stock division in 2017. He has five victories in the Hobby Stocks.

Pospisil grabbed his second straight runner-up finish. His fifth top 5.

Dustin Jackson of O'Neill posted his best effort of the season taking third. It also ties his best career effort since moving up to the division in 2018.

Tanner Uehling of Norfolk placed fourth and Stephanie Reynolds of Norfolk rounded out the top 5. It was her best effort since finishing second earlier this season.

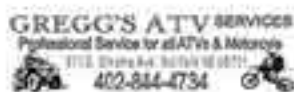
