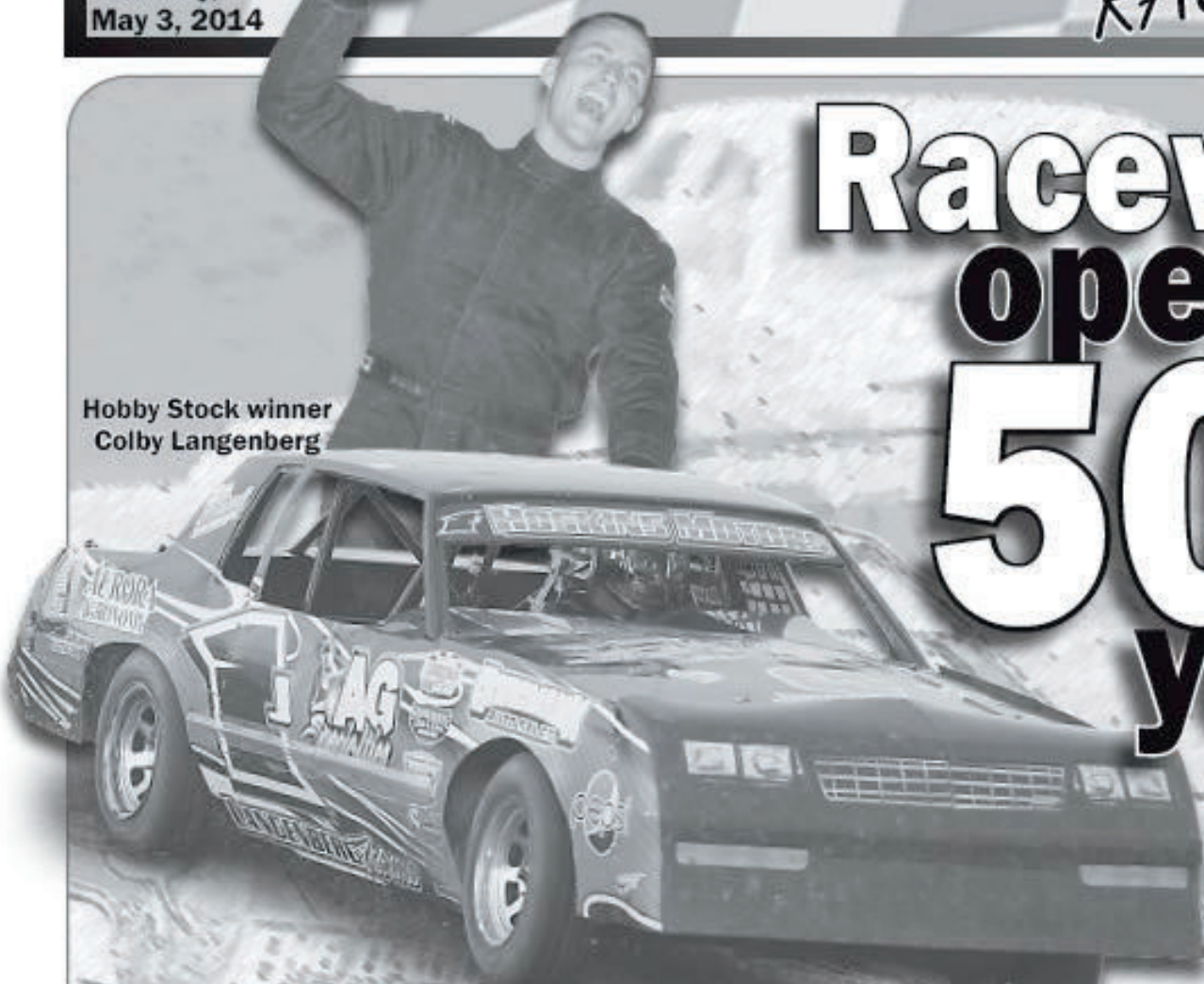

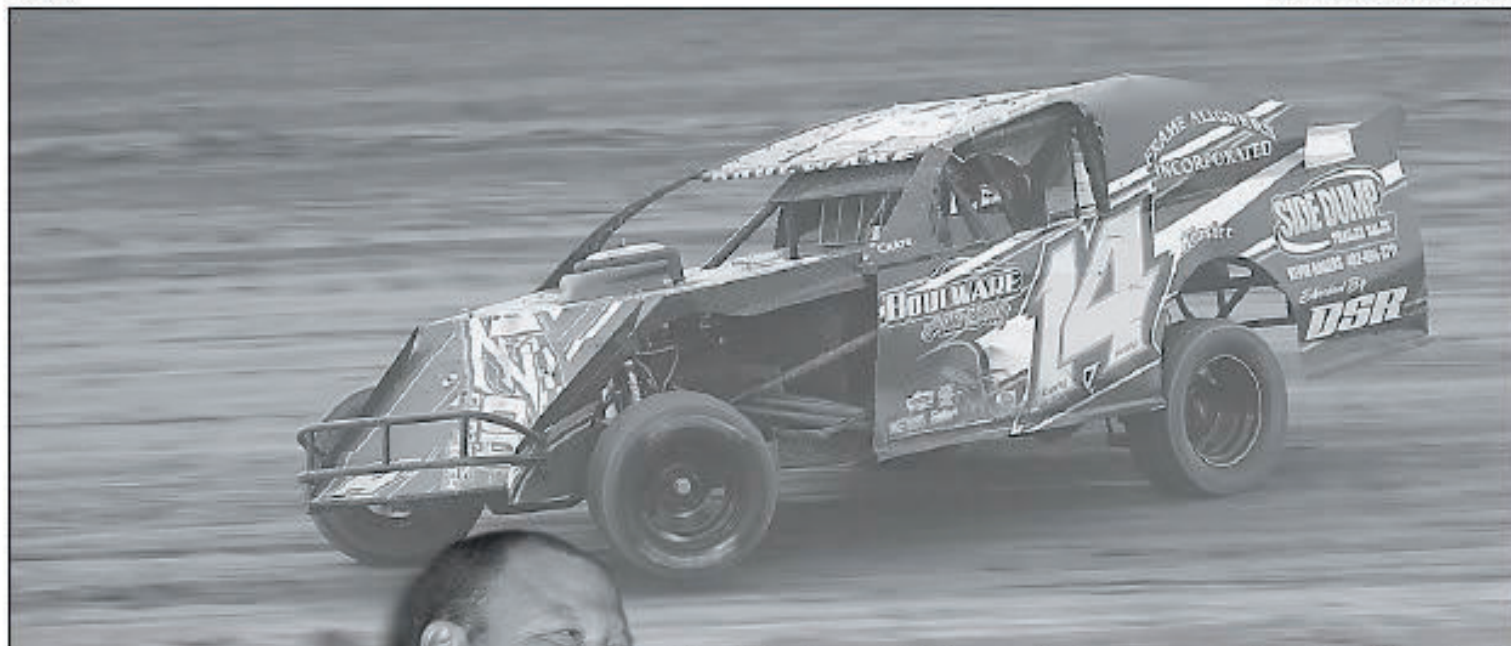

Boulware wins from pole

Jefferson's Todd Boulware may have started on the pole for the SportMod feature, but he had to battle with Karl Brewer of Vermillion before he took his first win of the season.

Brewer took the lead from the drop of the green flag, as Boulware settled in behind.

Brewer chose to run a higher line, leaving the bottom lane open for Boulware. Brewer had a couple bobbles exiting the turns and Boulware

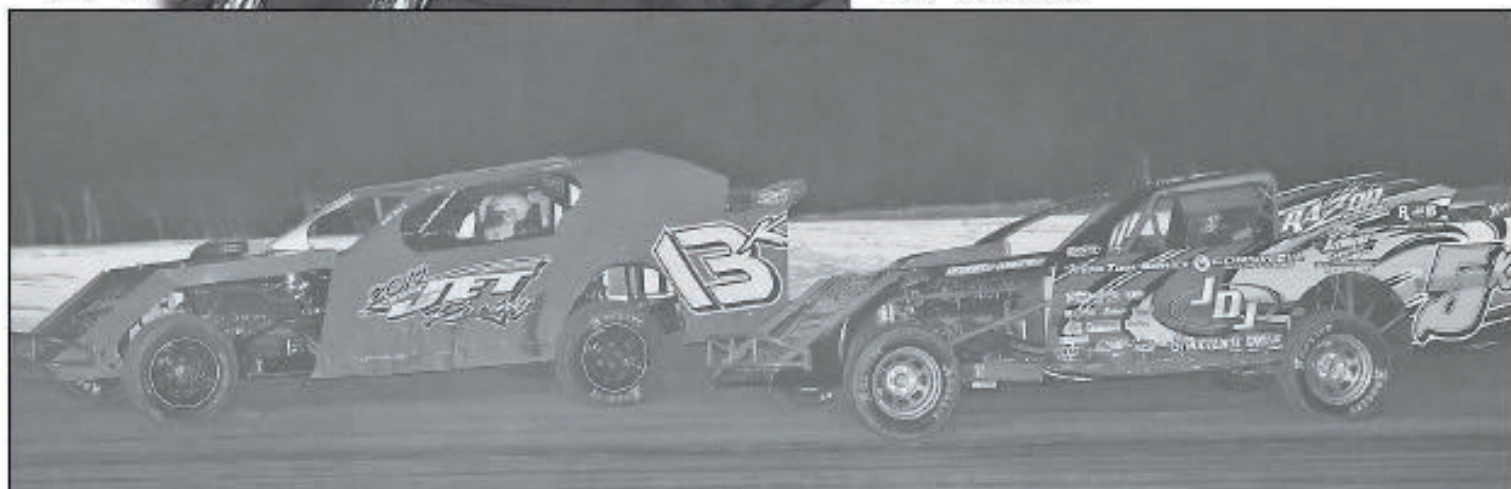
stuck his nose to the inside.

On lap six, Boulware got a run out of turn four and made the pass for the lead. He quickly opened up a half straightaway lead.

Defending two-time track champion Kyle Prauner of Norfolk made a bid for second on lap nine and completed the pass on lap 10.

Once in second, Prauner was unable to close in on Boulware even when the leader caught the back of the field.

Boulware won, Prauner was second as Brewer crossed the line third. Fourth went to Nelson Vollbrecht of Norfolk and Eric Haase of Norfolk rounded out the top 5.

Pospisil tops the field

It was a tough time for tires last week with the first two cautions for cars losing tires.

Former track champion Shannon Pospisil of Norfolk slipped past the first incident to win the first feature of the season.

Lance Mielke of Norfolk lost his tire before the first lap was completed. Mielke came to a stop in turn four and collected defending points champion Ramsey Meyer of Pierce.

Meyer was able to continue for a few laps before he started overheating and pulled off the track, ending his night.

Pospisil started on the inside of the fifth row and by lap four was battling for third with Wy-

att Lehman of Norfolk.

A caution and two laps later he was side-by-side with Drew Johnson for second.

The final caution came out after the completion of the seventh lap, with Codie Mielke leading, Pospisil second and Johnson third.

On the restart, Pospisil drove to the inside of Codie Mielke going into turn one. A lap later he was leading and pulling away.

Codie Mielke took second as Lehman finished third. Fourth went to Dustin Jackson of O'Neill and Brooke Fluckiger of Columbus rounded out the top 5.

Langenberg starts in victory circle

In closest battle of the night, Hobby Stock drivers Tiffany Bittner and Colby Langenberg, both of Norfolk, battled side-by-side for several laps with Langenberg leading the final four laps for the win.

Bittner started on the pole and led the first nine laps. Cautions kept the field tight and erased several big leads by Bittner.

It was after the fourth caution that Bittner and Langenberg ran side-by-side. Bittner had the better line on the inside, as Langenberg had a tougher time

on the high side.

One more caution and a red flag for former track champion Jim Kimmel, bunched the field again. Kimmel ended up on his side on the backstretch.

The final seven laps of the 15-lap feature had Bittner and Langenberg swapping the lead, before Langenberg moved out front for good on lap 12.

Langenberg won. Bittner was second as TeJay Mielke of Norfolk was third. Fourth went to Jeremy Hoskinson of Norfolk and rounding out the top 5 was Tracy Buck of Neligh.

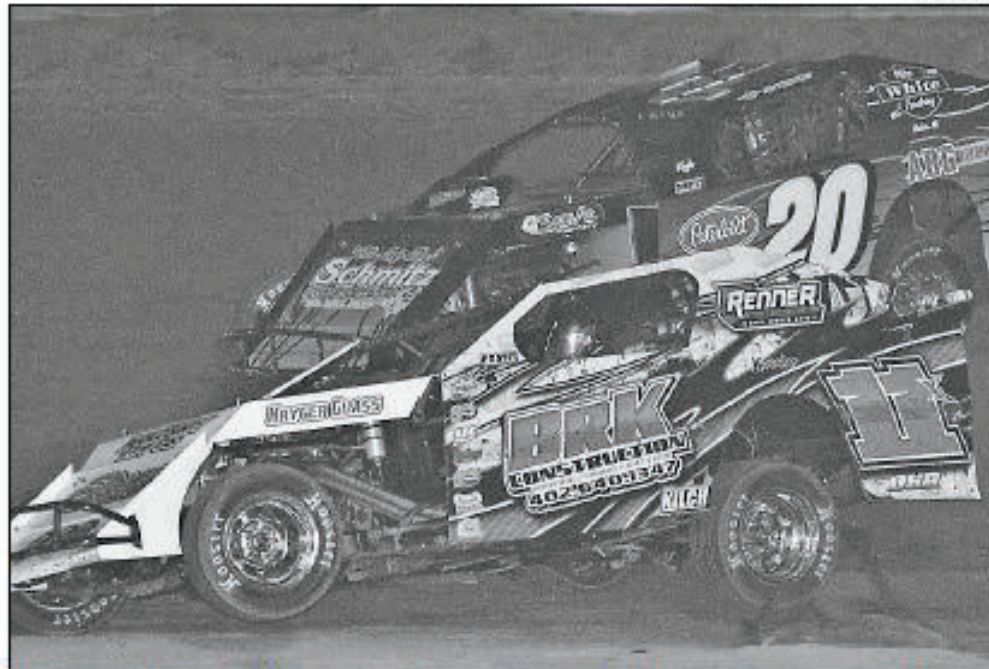

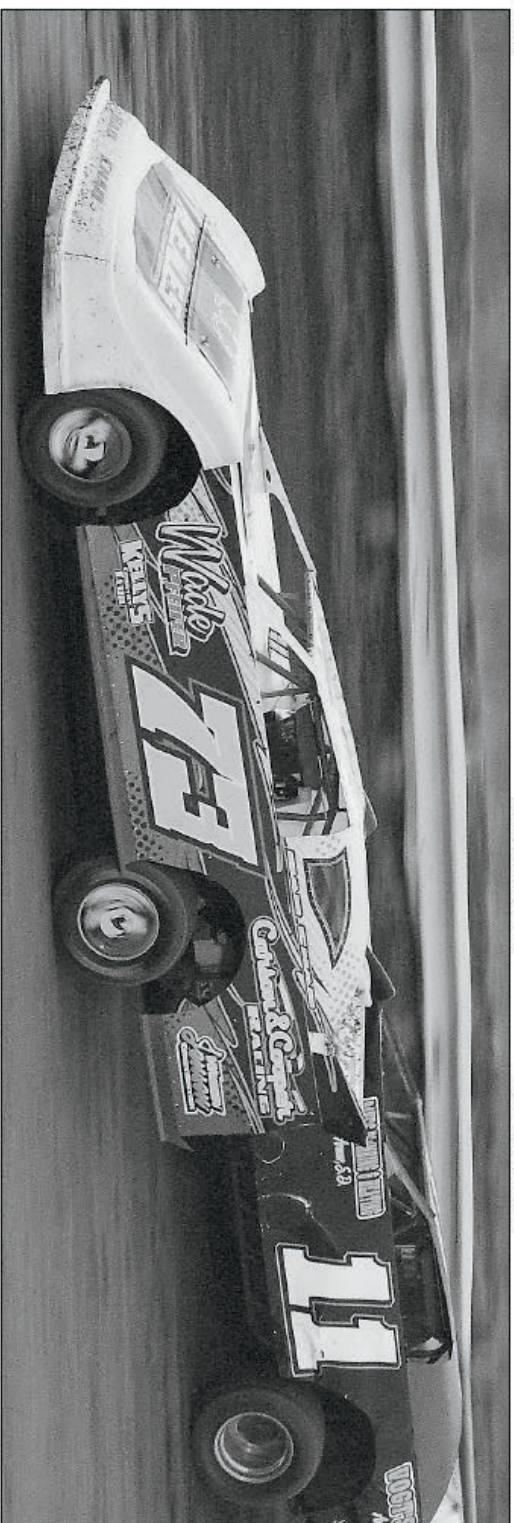

Jensen captures season-opening victory

Norfolk Grand National driver Chad Jensen led from the drop of the green flag to lead all 25 laps to pick up the opening-night win. Three cautions slowed the 15-car field, but Jensen pulled away each time. Eric Vanosdall of Wamside slipped into second on the fourth lap and never could get a look

to pass Jensen. Eventually, Plainview's Jim Johnson used the final restart to pass Vanosdall for the runner-up position. Johnson was able to run deeper into the corners to make the pass. Johnson went after Jensen but it would be only on the final two laps that Johnson cut the lead down.

On the final lap Johnson run hard into the corners and managed to close the gap to one-car length but could not get off the corners to make the pass. Jensen won. Johnson was second. Vanosdall placed third and Ben Sukup of Norfolk captured fourth place. Travis Birkley of Wakefield rounded out the top 5.

Travis Birkley (78) competes with Kyle Coover (10). Birkley took a top 5 finish place fifth in the feature.



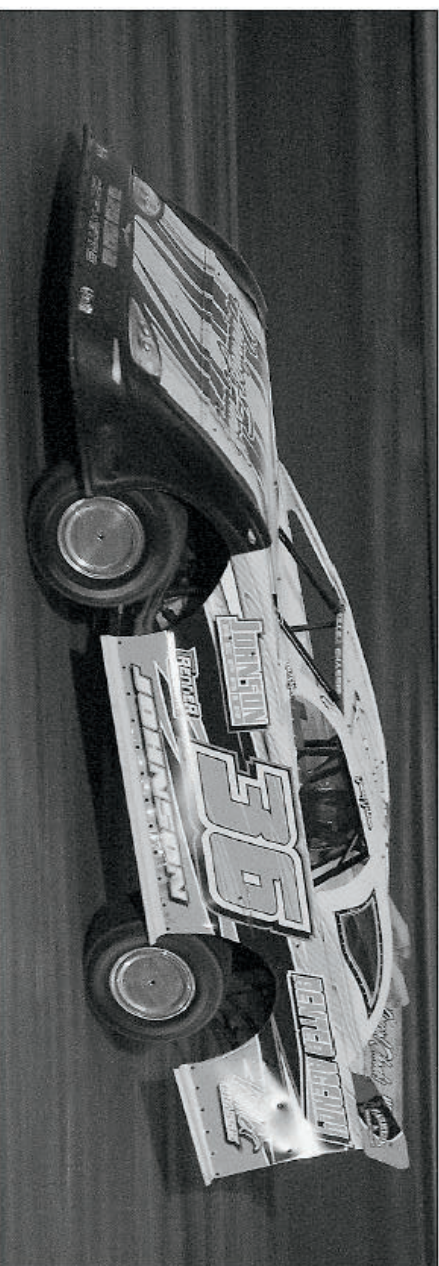
Ben Sukup (07X) squeezes by George Murdock (3m) during their heat race. Sukup captured fourth in the feature.
