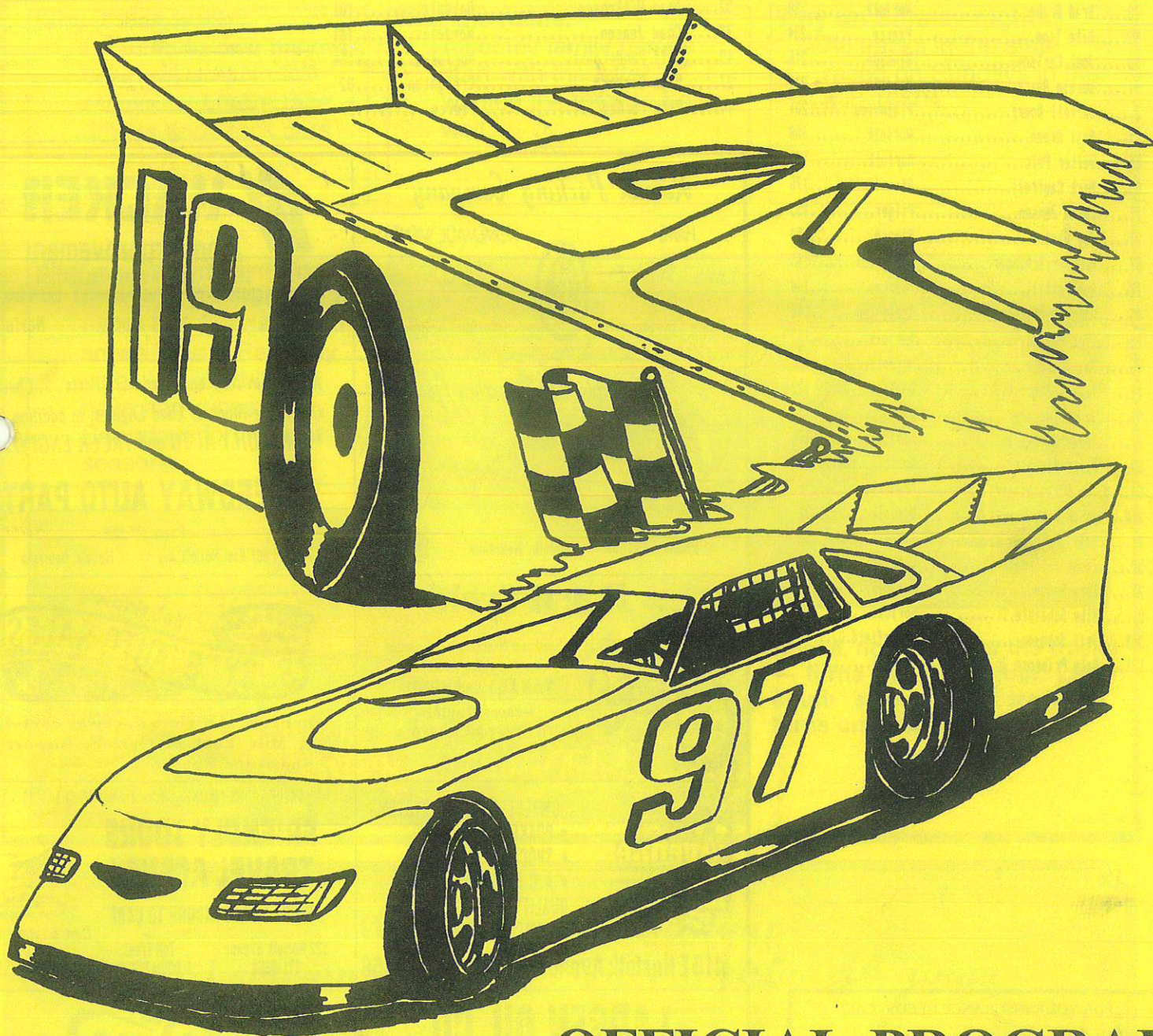

Why the name:

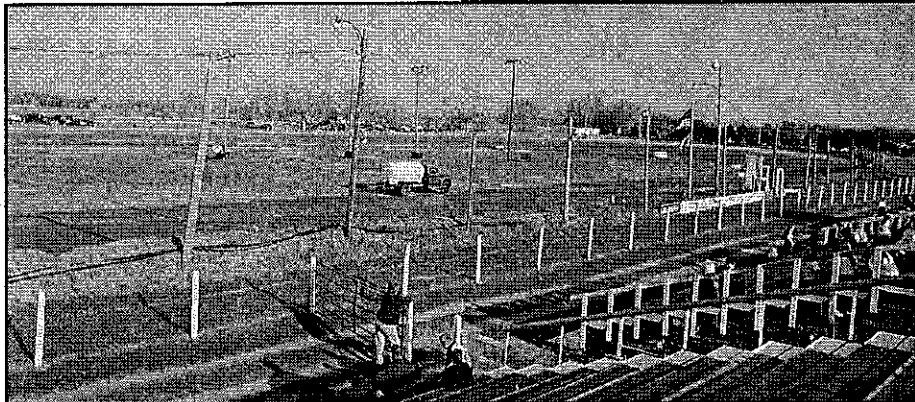
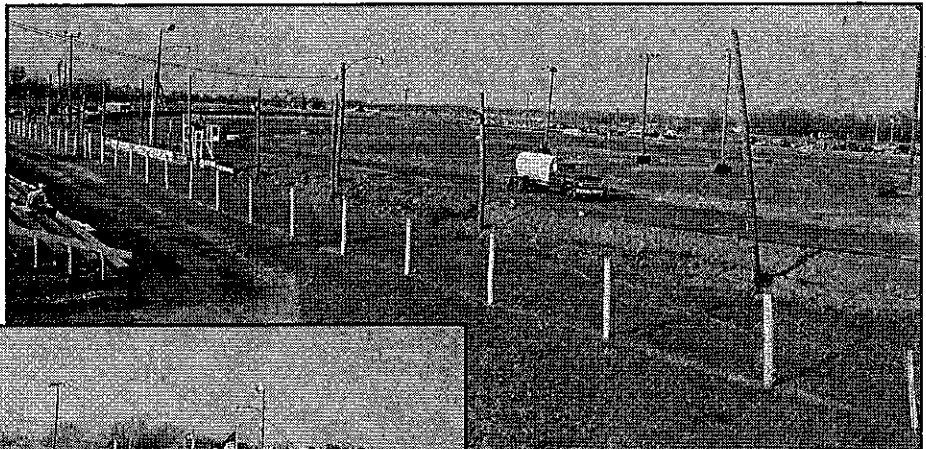
All of my family names start with the letter "R". I wanted the track to be as well.

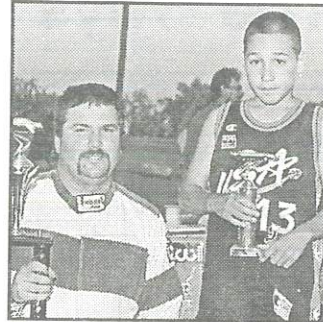

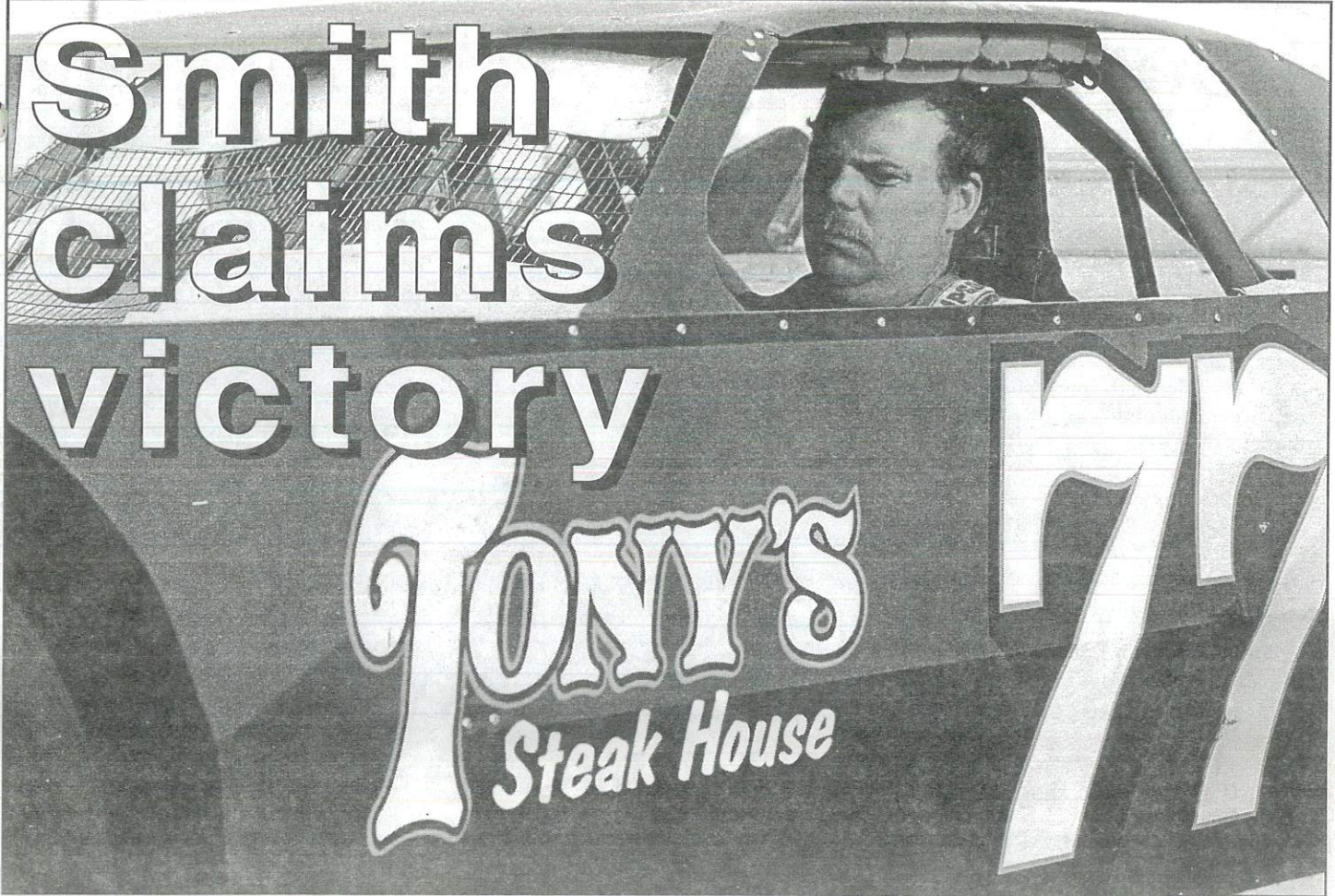

Smith drives to "A" feature win; Hansen leads most laps, again

If the winner was determined by who led the most laps in the race, Norfolk's Keith Hansen of Norfolk would have won his second Grand National "A" feature, last Saturday night at Riviera Raceway.

With another beautiful night of weather and a full crowd, Hansen watched as he led 21 of the 25 laps in the final feature race of the night before he broke. That ended his night in turn four, three laps from the checkered flag.

A week earlier, Curt Zuhlke of Bancroft made a last-lap pass to stop Hansen short of victory lane. Again, he had led 21 of the 25 laps.

Despite Hansen leading a majority of the laps, Jay Smith of Norfolk was the only driver to duel with Hansen and was able to pick up his first win of the season.

Hansen and Smith both started on the front row, with Hansen the polesitter. Hansen led the first two circuits before Smith nosed out to lead the third lap.

Hansen came back on the inside and

took over the top spot on lap four. Hansen would lead the next 18 laps through two of three cautions, the third was for himself.

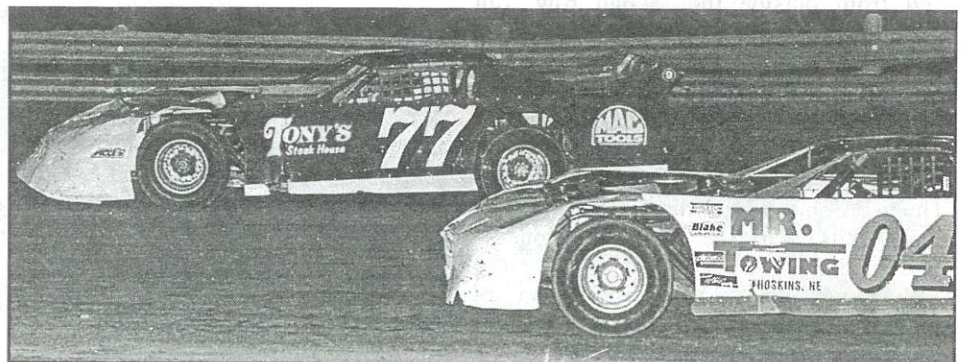
Smith battled with Hansen nearly the entire race, as he was able to make the high groove work in the corners. Smith was able to come out of the corner beside Hansen, but Hansen pulled away down the straightaways.

After Hansen was towed from the track, Smith took over and finished out the race.

Bob Milander of Norfolk finished second, getting by Mike Goldfuss of Sutton on lap eight for third and later second when Hansen broke.

Robert Osborne of Norfolk was third to

Buenning bags "A" feature win

In a caution free Street Stock "A" feature last Saturday night, Shannon Buenning of Norfolk was able to grab his first win of the season despite the hard charging of the previous week's winner Phil Green of Norfolk.

With the win, Buenning made the biggest jump in the season points, jumping from 12th to seventh. Points leader Jim Johnson hauled in the most points, when he had to come through the "B" feature and he then finished well in the "A" feature.

Bill Wells of Norfolk climbed back up to the second spot, as Travis Loecker dropped to third. Dennis Martz of Norfolk jumped into the fourth spot and Jensen fell from third to fifth.

Buenning jumped into the lead from second row starting spot in the "A" feature and led the first six laps.

Green looked to be on his way to back-to-back wins, when he passed Buenning on lap seven, but a lap later he pulled from the track with a problem. Buenning regained the lead on lap eight and then held off Wells for the win.

Wells said it took a lot to catch up to Buenning, but he could not get round in the closing laps.

Before Saturday night's win, Buenning's best endeavor was third back in early May the first "A" feature run.

Johnson started 13th in the 15-car field. By lap nine he moved up to third when Green left the track. By this time Buenning and Wells had pulled away. Johnson was able to close the gap, but ran out of time. He took home his six top five finish in six attempts.

Fourth went to Loecker, his third top five and fifth was James Kleinhessel of Columbus in the David Hille machine.

Finishing fourth in his heat, Johnson was forced to run the "B" feature. He started from outside the second row. Jim Kimmel of Norfolk led the first lap, before Mike Timm took over the point. Johnson followed two laps later and another two laps Johnson made the pass for the lead and then checked out.

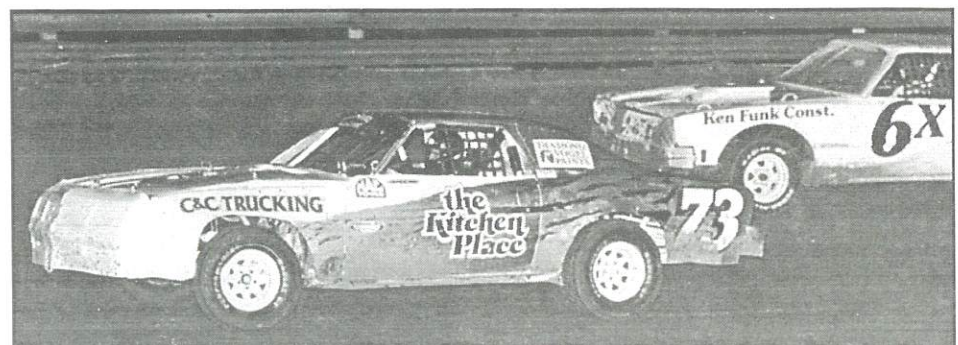
Timm finished second and Kimmel hung on for third. All three advanced.

Qualifying for the "B" feature from the "C" feature was Brian Wagner of Winnetoon and Jason Wilkenson of Oakdale in his second week out. Wagner led from the get go to win the 10-lap event easily.

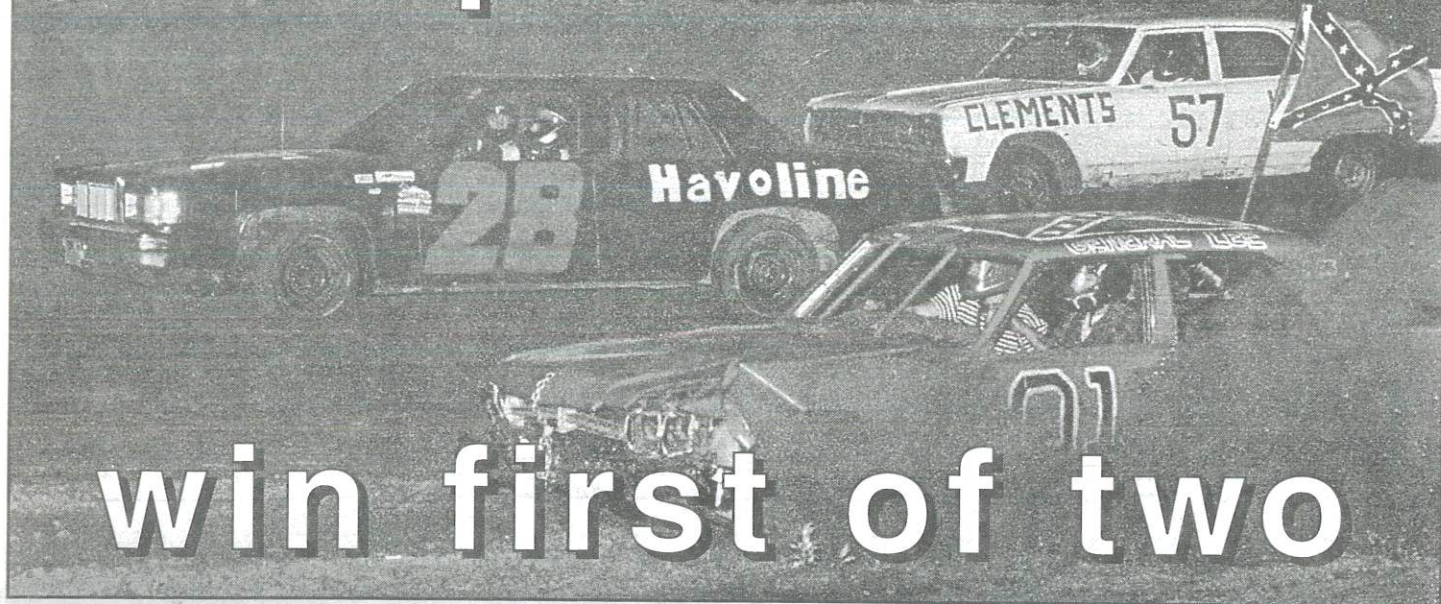


Shannon Buenning (foreground) leads Jason Jensen (71) and Terry Walker (79) out of turn four during heat races.

Cruisers crown two winners

The team of driver Jeremy Gnat and co-pilot Brian Koch, both of Norfolk found their way through the field of 11 Cruisers to claim victory again last Saturday in the second of two races for the division.

Driver Scott Phillips and co-pilot B.J. Throener, both of Norfolk, teamed up and won the first race.

After one circuit in the first race, Phillips-Throener were running second before falling to third. On the next lap, the leader spun in turn two and collected the second place car giving Phillips-Throener the top spot.

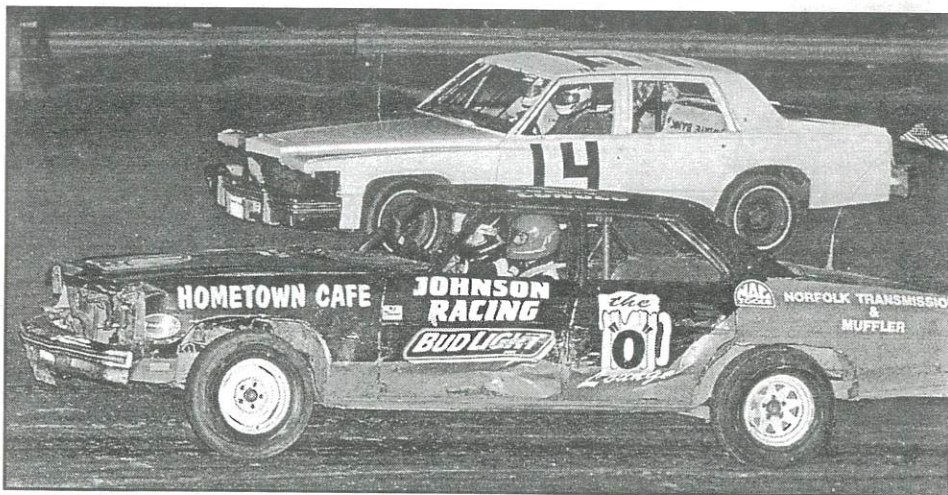
The team of driver Chris Head and co-pilot Tony Scheinost, both of Norfolk chased down Phillips-Throener, but were unsuccessful.

Finishing third was the brother team of driver Bob Johnson and co-pilot Terry Johnson.

The second race was a rat race, starting the second lap four cars plowed into the retaining wall in turn two, including the eventual winners of Gnat-Koch and the team of driver Mike Hardesty and co-pilot Shane Still, both of Blythville, Ark., who finished third.

Following the pile up Gnat-Koch got a good restart and was able to take over the top spot on lap four of 10.

The team of driver Jerry Ketelsen of Norfolk and Mike Jensen of Pilger hung onto second and Hardesty-Still was third.



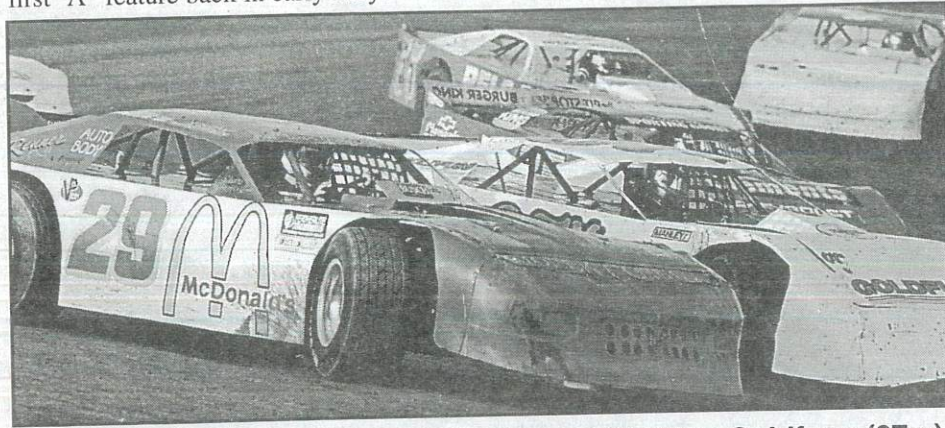

pick up his fifth top five finish of week six. Reggie Roth of Bancroft took home fourth, his best effort since winning the first "A" feature back in early May.

Vic Lovejoy of Meadow Grove rounded out the top five, with his best finish of the season.

Points leader Zuhlke tangled with another car in turn one on lap five. Laps later he pulled from the track — the first time he did not finish in the top four.

The "B" feature was won by Lovejoy. He started from the outside of the front row. He fell back as far as third, but passed Dean Wilkenson of Oakdale on lap six and then passed Chad Jensen of Pilger on the next lap to win. Jeff Haase of Norfolk and Jeff Pendergast of Norfolk both advanced to the "A" from the "B" feature.

Steve Matthies led from the drop of the green flag to win the trophy dash over Smith.

Starting from the fifth spot in his heat race, Zuhlke screamed to the front. After one lap he was second and by the second lap he was first. He picked up his third heat win of the season.

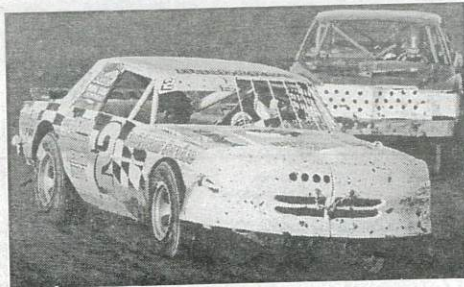
Roth led the final half of his heat race to win his second and Osborne claimed his fifth heat win of the season.

In the points chase, Zuhlke maintains the lead over Osborne, but the margin closed to three points. Raymond Haase of Norfolk stays third. Roth moves up to fourth and Matthies drops to fifth.

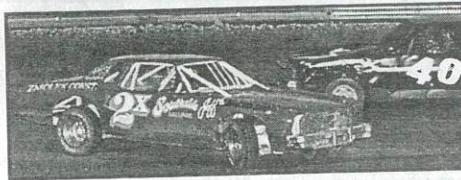

Darrell Doerr (2) leads the way to his third heat race win.

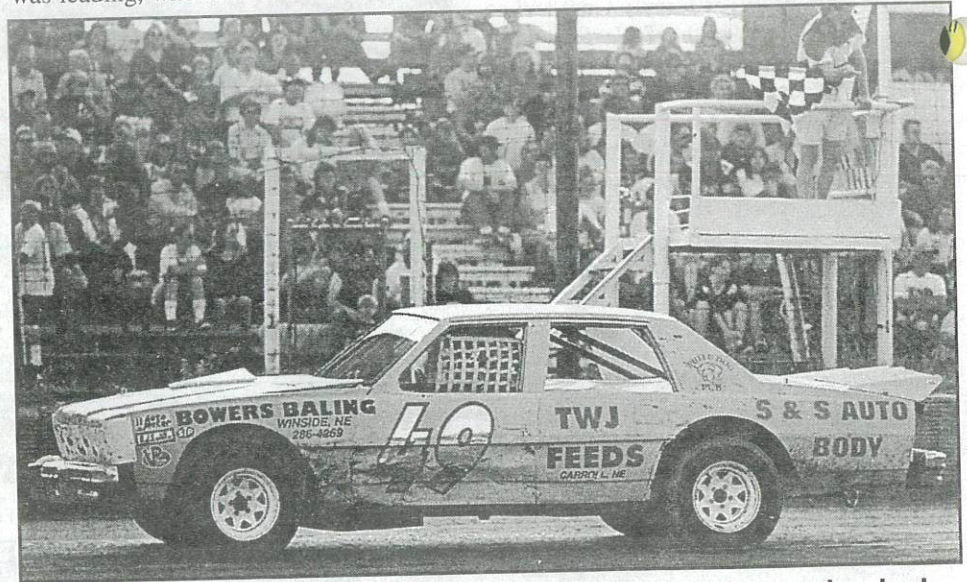


Cory Haase (2x) spins in turn two.

Joel Carlson (49) takes the checkered flag first in the trophy dash.

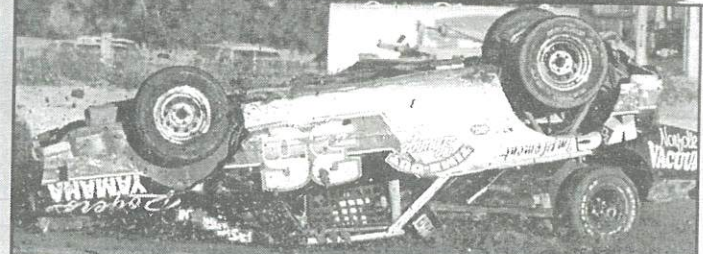
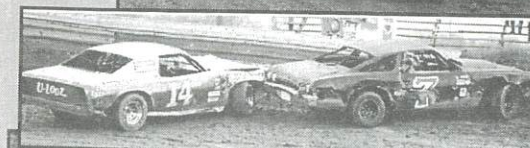
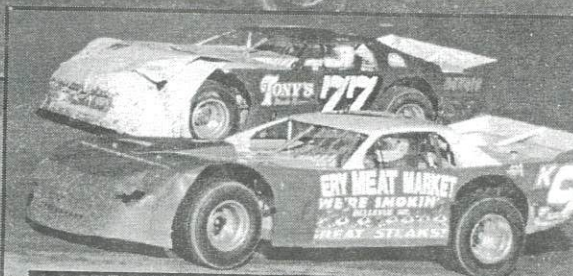
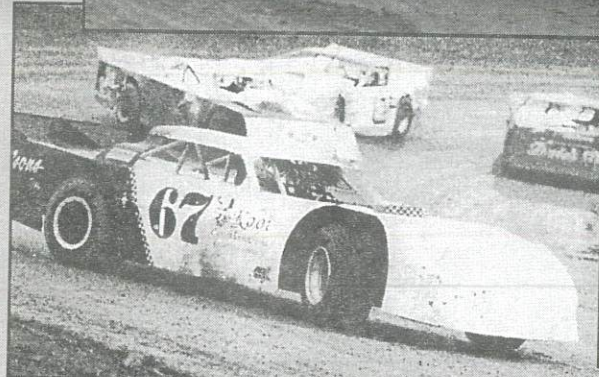
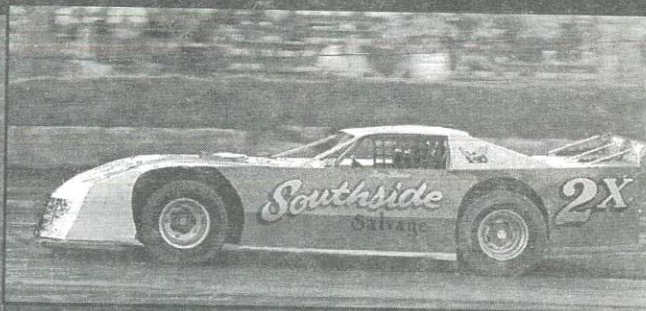
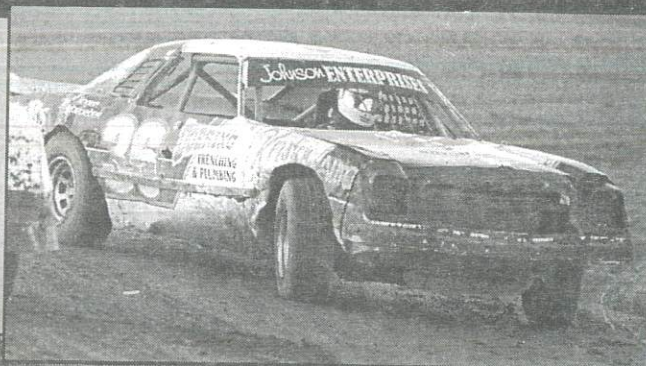

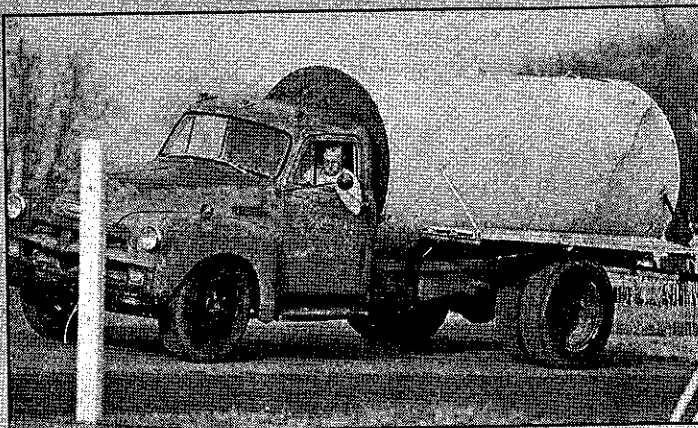


Birthday wishes and announcements

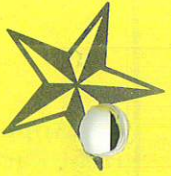
