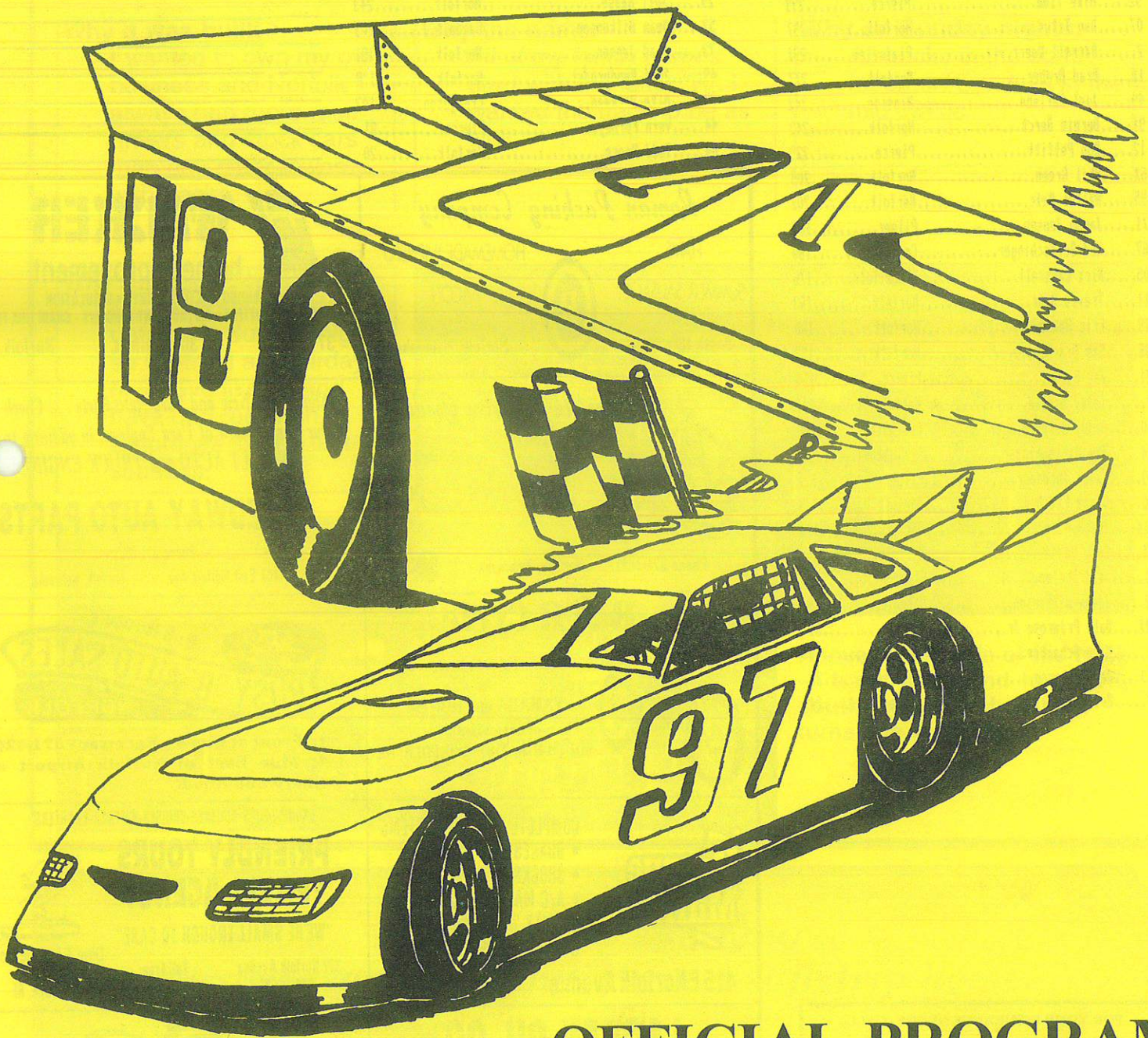

Why the name:

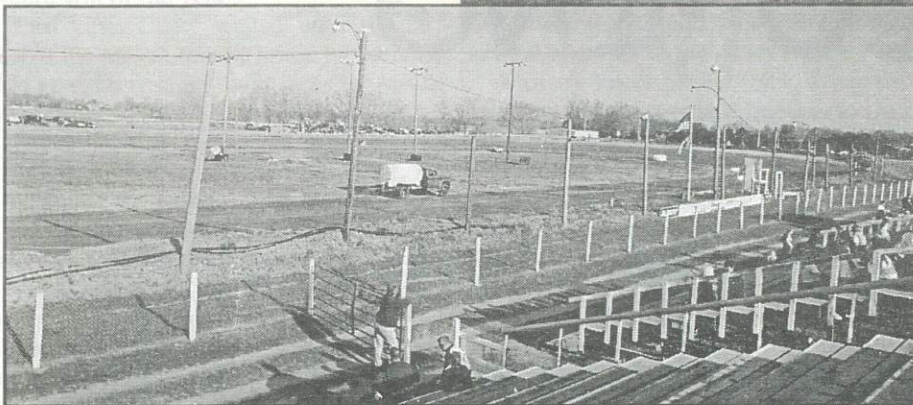
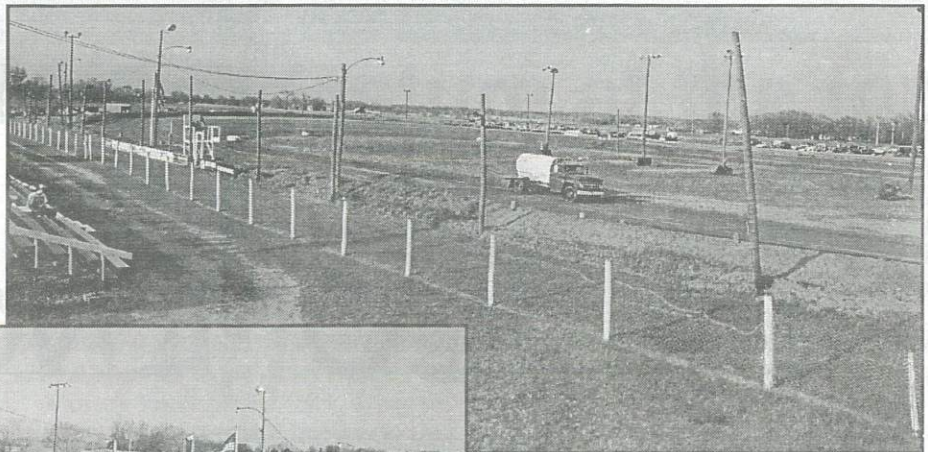
All of my family names start with the letter "R". I wanted the track to be as well.

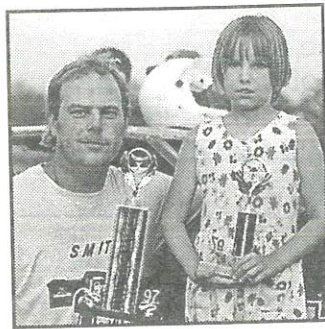

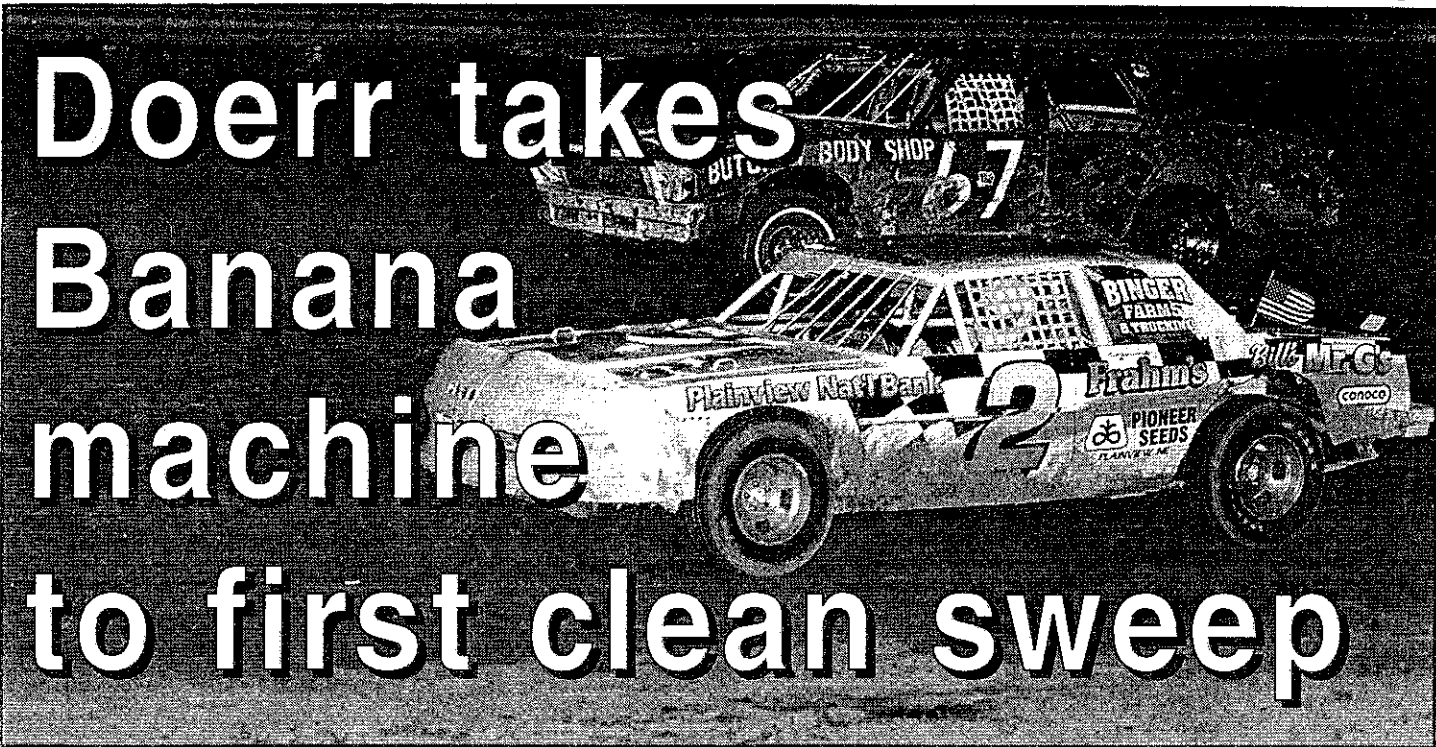

Doerr takes Banana machine to first clean sweep

Doerr finishes first feature at the top

After struggling for the first six weeks, Plainview's Darrell Doerr was able to complete his first feature race of the season, last Saturday night at Riviera Raceway. In doing so, he also picked up his first "A" feature win of the year.

Last year, Doerr waited until the last race of the season to take home top honors. This year, he won all three races he was in to sweep the Street Stock division.

Doerr started the night winning his fourth heat race of the season. Next, he took home the trophy dash win and finished the night holding off Ron Pettitt of Pierce to win the main event.

Doerr started on the outside of row two in the "A" feature and followed Ned Bartschinger of Creighton through one and two at the drop of the green flag. By turn three and four, Doerr went low and grab the lead.

He was able to put a little distance between himself and second place, as Bartschinger, Pettitt and points-leader Jim Johnson of Bloomfield battled for the second spot for the first half of the 15-lap event.

After the seven circuits, Travis Suhr of Norfolk brought out the second of four cautions, lining up Johnson and Pettitt at the rear of Doerr's No. 2 machine.

After the restart, Doerr managed to hang on to the top spot, despite his car sliding high a few times.

Doerr said his car worked on the bottom

for the first seven laps, but he started having trouble. He then started easing into the throttle coming off the corners to help from spinning the rear tires and heating them up.

On lap 11, Johnson's tires started heating up and he began drifting back. Pettitt took over the second position and made several attempts to get under Doerr.

Moving lower on the track, Doerr said he started taking Pettitt's line away. Doerr took his fifth career win. Pettitt finished second.

David Hille of Norfolk took advantage of Johnson's trouble and moved into third. The 11-year-veteran said his smaller motor avoid him from spinning the tires out of the corners and his tires worked on the bottom

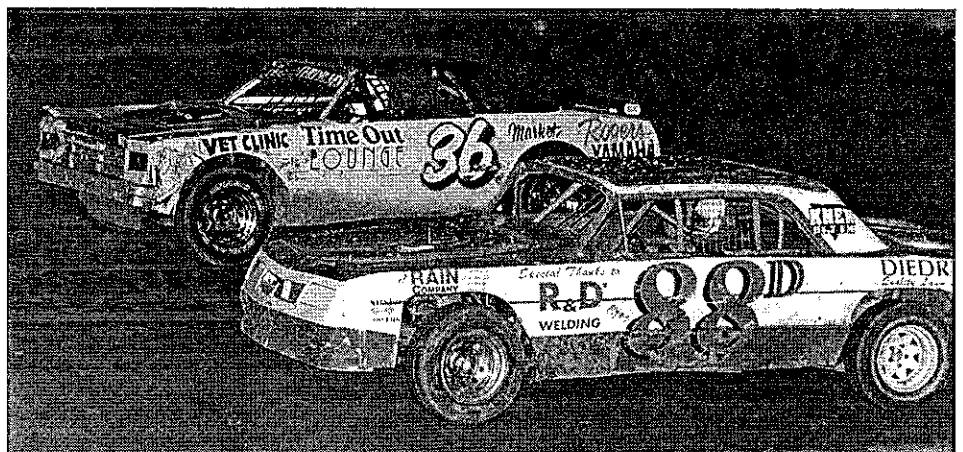
side. He took home his best finish of the season.

Travis Loecker of Bloomfield also slipped past Johnson in the final three laps to take fourth and Johnson claimed his seventh top five finish of the year.

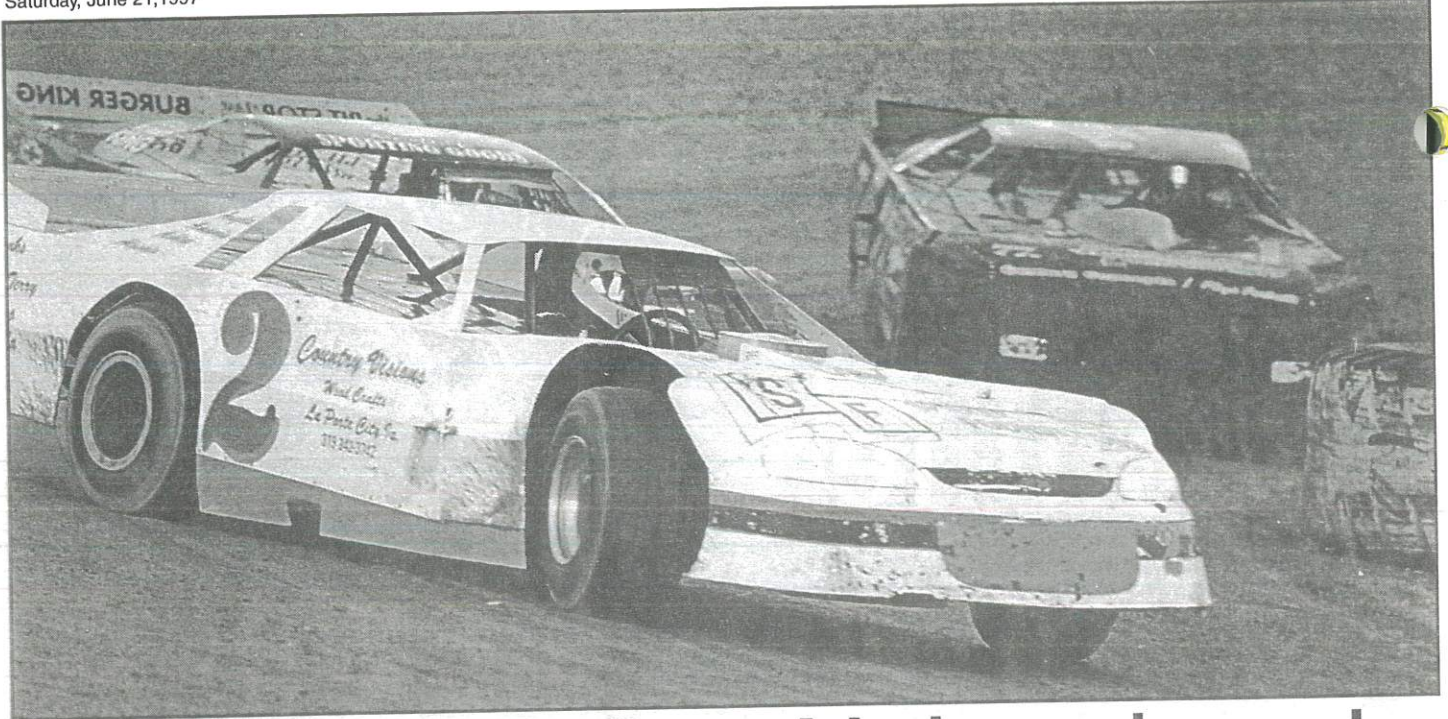
Mike Timm of Norfolk motor his way to seventh in the "A" feature after having to come through the "C" feature to do it.

Timm won the "C" feature and finished third in the "B" feature to qualify for the final race. Terry Walker of Norfolk and Jim Kimmel of Norfolk also made it to the "A" feature finishing one and two, respectively, in the "B" feature.

Lovejoy has first Nebraska win

It was the night for number twos, last Saturday, as the No. 2 machines of Grand National driver Vic Lovejoy of Meadow Grove and Street Stock driver Darrell Doerr of Plainview each claimed "A" feature victories, respectively.

Having spent part of his racing career in Iowa, where he has several feature wins in Late Models and Pro Stock divisions, Lovejoy took home his first Nebraska vic-

tory.

The 10-year veteran started on the outside of the second row, the same place Street Stock "A" feature winner Darrell Doerr.

Jeff Haase of Norfolk used his pole position to grab the lead with Keith Hansen of Norfolk in tow. Hansen started drifting high, allowing Mike Goldfuss of Sutton and Lovejoy to slip into the second and

third spots.

Haase then dropped from the lead and pulled to the infield giving Goldfuss the point on lap five. By lap eight, Lovejoy got around Goldfuss for the lead.

For the next six laps Goldfuss and Bob Milander of Norfolk fought side by side for the second spot allowing Lovejoy to put distance between the first and second spots. Finally, Milander controlled the second spot, but then Jay Smith of Norfolk got by Goldfuss and started warring with Milander.

Lovejoy continued to pull away and started coming up on lapped traffic. He was concerned about the slower cars, but said he just tried to keep the same rhythm.

Milander and Smith were able to gain a little ground, when Smith settled back and run behind Milander.

Lovejoy led the final 18 laps to pick up the win. Milander continues to be the best man and not the groom, with his third consecutive runner-up position. Smith coming off a win the week before finished third on the bumper of Milander.

Fourth and fifth went to Curt Zuhlke of Bancroft and Robert Osborne of Norfolk, respectively.

The two continue to battle for the points lead, as well. Zuhlke led going into the night by three points, however, Osborne regains the lead by two points.

Raymond Haase of Norfolk preserves the third spot, as Milander and Smith jump

Head, Anderson Cruiser winners

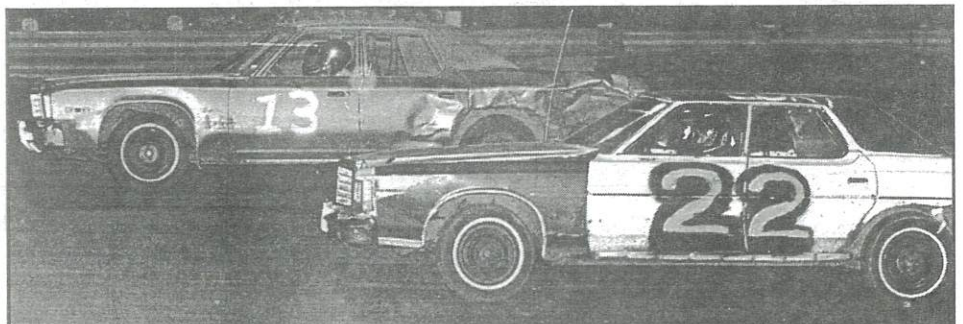


Jensens win second race

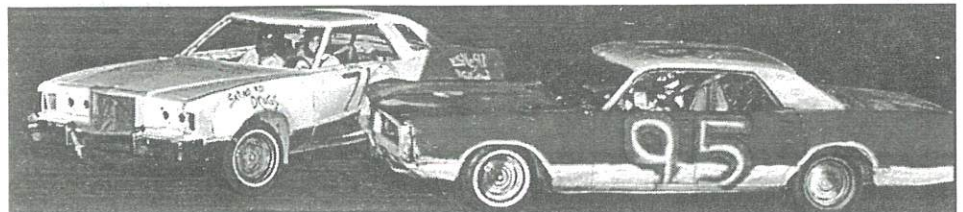
Street Stock driver Patrick Jensen of Stanton and nephew Josh Jensen of Pilger climbed into a Cruiser car last Saturday and took advantage of a slip up by the team of Shaun Kidman and Brian Winword, both of Norfolk and won the second of two Cruiser races.

Kidman-Winword led the first six laps of 10, before looping it in turn two. The Jensens were able to avoid the trouble and lead the final four laps to win. Kidman-Winword hung on for second and third went to Cory Hille and Rick Brandt, both of Hadar.

In the first race, Chris Head and Mike Anderson, both of Norfolk, led the final eight laps to win. Darren Nathan of Norfolk and Troy Prewett of Hadar finished second with one of the winners of last week taking third. They were Scott Phillips and B.J. Throener.

Also making to the "B" feature from the "C" feature was Brad Brabec of Norfolk. He finished second.

In the trophy dash, Doerr pulled off a

two-car pass in the final lap to take his first hardware back to the shop.

Shannon Buenning of Norfolk led the first five laps of the six, when he went high in corner two. Both second place Loecker and third place Doerr slipped past Buenning. Down the back stretch Doerr

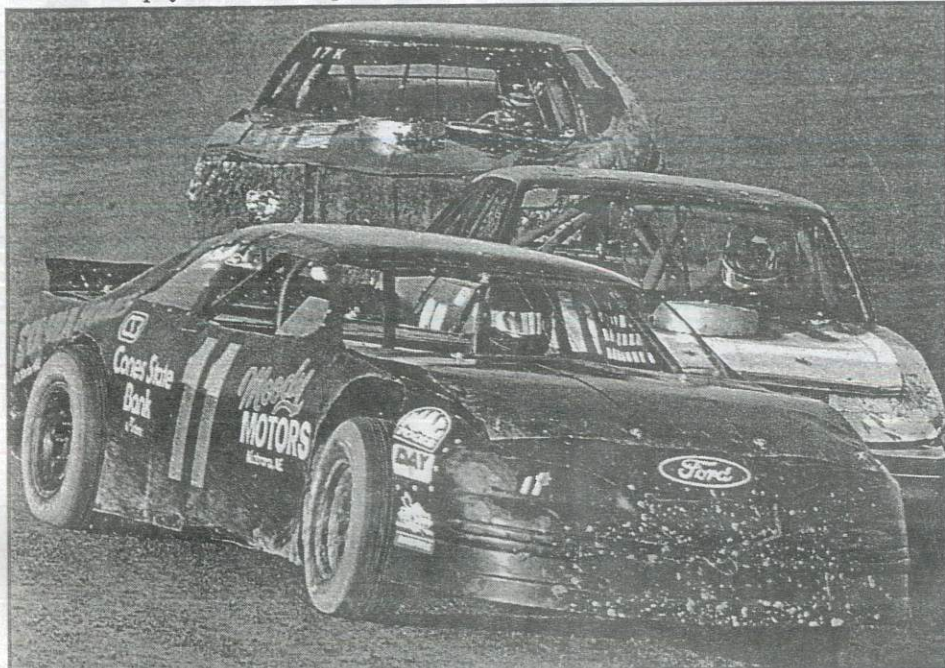
was able to make a good run going into turn three.

Diving low Doerr was able to get the bit he need off four and passed Loecker for the win. Doerr said he did not know if would hold on the low side, but he got what he needed for the win.

In the heat races, Doerr won his fourth of the year, Patrick Jensen of Stanton won his third heat, while Pettitt and Wells won their second each.

Johnson continues to lead the points race. The margin from first to second was cut to 120 points. Loecker regains second, as Bill Wells of Norfolk falls to third. Kimmel jumps from sixth to fourth, as Dennis Martz had an off night and falls from fourth to sixth. Rounding out the top five was Jensen, who maintains the position from the week before.

Ron Pettitt makes one of the biggest jumps. He is now 18th, six spots higher.

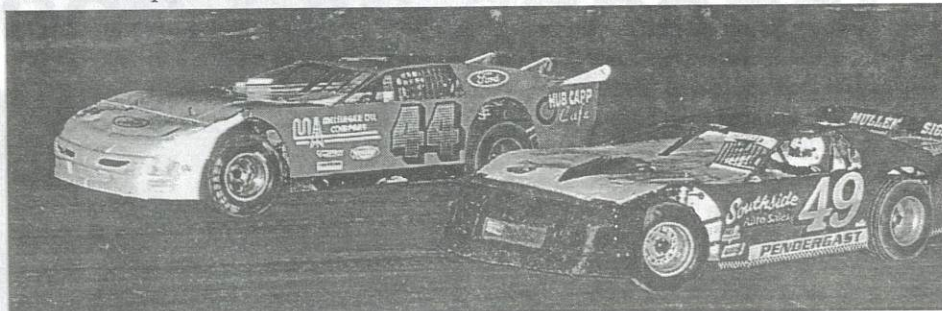
to fourth and fifth, respectively, two positions higher. Both passed Reggie Roth of Bancroft and Steve Matthies of Norfolk, who fell two positions each.

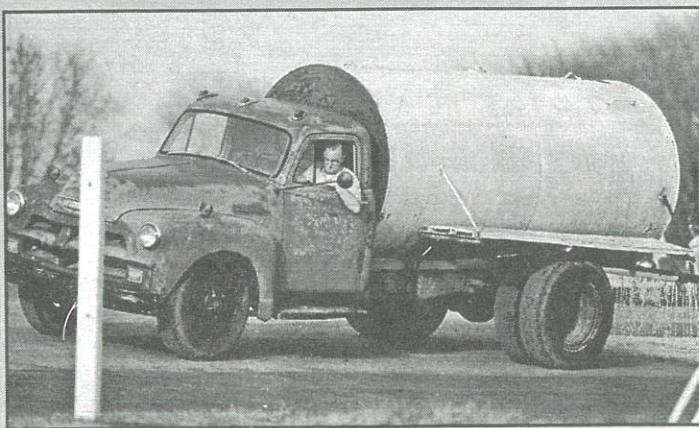


Birthday wishes and announcements
