One more caution and a red flag for former track champion Jim Kimmel, bunched the field again. Kimmel ended up on his side on the backstretch.

The final seven laps of the 15-lap feature had Bittner and Langenberg swapping the lead, before Langenberg moved out front for good on lap 12.




Nic Kimmel (above) was the first to arrive to his dad's car after it ended up on its side.


Jim Kimmel (17k) sits in his wrecked Hobby Stock after an incident on the backstretch.








Above, Derek Sehi (16s) took seventh in the feature as Cameron Meyer (21) placed eighth.


