Kimmel returns to winner's circle

Going from a week to forget, former Hobby Stock champion Jim Kimmel came to win the next night out.

Starting the season with a new car last week, Kimmel got caught in an incident which took him to the pits on a wrecker.

A week later and back in his ride from the 2013 season, Kimmel went to victory lane. It was the first time since 2011 that he won and only the second time since winning the championship in 2006, where he won five times that season.

Kimmel started on the outside pole and in Kimmel fashion he ran consistent laps and forced everybody else to find a way around him.

Two cautions slowed the 15-lap feature. The first came on lap 11 and the other on lap 13. That set up a two lap shootout between Kimmel and Colby Langenberg of

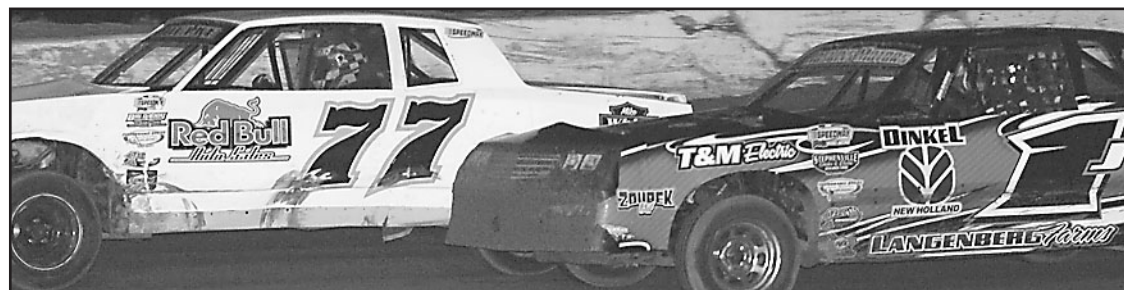
Norfolk.

Kimmel went back to running the middle lane, as Langenberg tried the high side. To take the white flag, Kimmel, Langenberg and Jeremy Hoskinson of Norfolk were three wide down the front stretch.

Langenberg was outside Hoskinson on the inside and Kimmel the middle. As they enter turn one, Hoskinson and Kimmel bumped and Hoskinson spun out, leaving the two other drivers drag racing down the backstretch.

Kimmel got the edge going into turn three to beat Langenberg back to the checkered by a car length. TeJay Mielke was awarded third place after Tom Marksmeier of Norfolk failed post race inspection. Fourth went to Travis Coover of Neligh and Aaron Shearn of Sioux City rounded out the top 5.

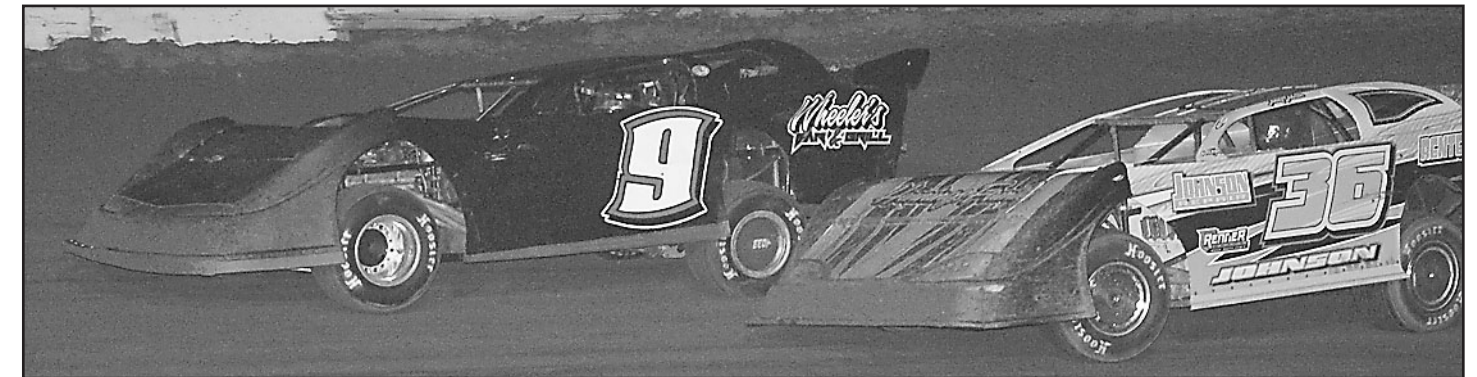
TeJay Mielke (77) and Colby Langenberg (1J) are the only drivers with two top 5s. Langenberg was second and Mielke finished third in the feature.

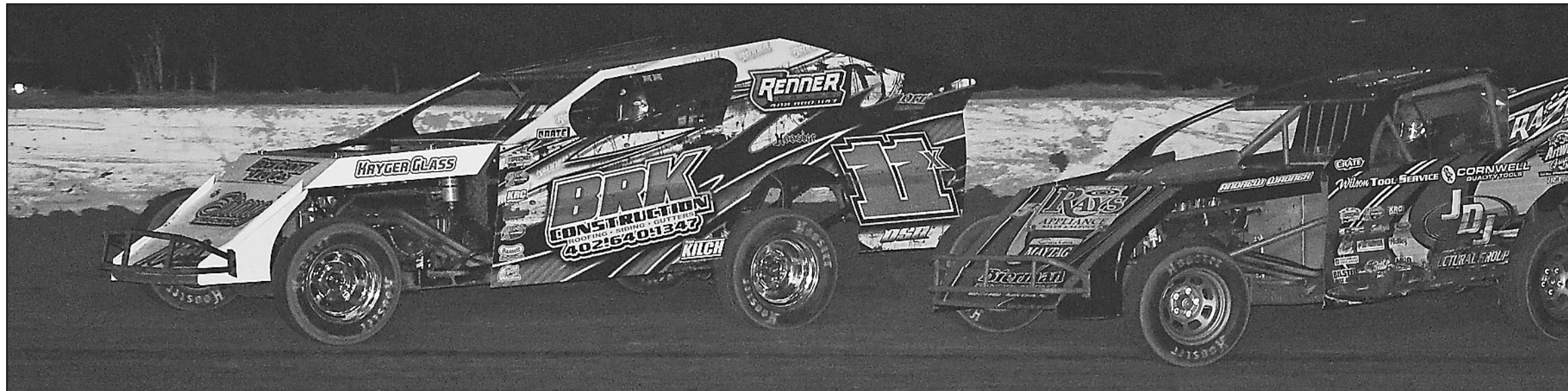


Brad Vogt (11) and David Babcock (0) race in their heat race.

Vollbrecht takes victory

Nelson Vollbrecht of Norfolk did not break into the top three until lap nine and after two cautions Vollbrecht outraced two-time defending track champion Kyle Prauner for his first win of the season.

Neil Bruns of Norfolk paced the field for the first 13 laps where he had a lead as big as a straightaway. But as the track changed, the rest of the field caught him.

Vollbrecht caught a break when Prauner was able to break out front, passing Bruns and Vollbrecht on the front straightaway. However, a caution erased the pass and set up a five-

lap shootout.

On the restart, Vollbrecht quickly got to the outside of Bruns to make the pass for the lead. Prauner followed Vollbrecht pass Bruns.

The two Riviera regulars then battled for the win. Prauner tried to use the inside as Vollbrecht kept the momentum on the high side.

Vollbrecht slowly pulled away as Prauner could not get the grip out of the corners.

Matt Haase of Norfolk finished third, the previous week's winner, Todd Boulware was fourth and Bruns rounded out the top 5.
