



## Jensen victorious again

Norfolk Grand National driver Chad Jensen took advantage of a caution to win his second feature of the season last week.

Jensen tussled with Doug Tomka of Stanton through the mid part of the race which allowed race leader Chase Osborne of Norfolk to pull out to a half-straight away lead. But a caution was thrown and Jensen restarted on the bumper of Osborne with seven laps remaining.

Osborne, who led the first 18 laps, got a good restart, but struggled exiting turn two and Jensen drove to the inside to make the pass.

Jensen quickly pulled away from the field, as Osborne and Jim Johnson of Plainview battled for second.

Jensen picked up the win and Johnson made a last lap pass for second. Osborne was third as Tomka finished fourth. Robert Osborne of Norfolk rounded out the top 5.

Pospisil kept Anderson pinched to the bottom and had the momentum to drag race to the checkered flag.
