Another Osborne in victory lane

Chase Osborne has watched his dad win races all his life. On July 2, it was his turn.

Osborne started racing in 2008 in the Sport Compact division where he won couple times. In 2012, he ran his first full season in the Grand Nationals division and has improved each year.

He got his first top 5 last season with a third place finish. So far this season, he has had two third place finishes before the last night of racing when he picked up his first win.

Bob Milander of Pierce led 20 laps in the July 2 main feature and looked to be on his way to his third-straight win when he spun into the infield with four laps re-

maining.

Osborne saw the spin and knew he just had to finish the final four laps. However, a caution was thrown, erasing a straightaway lead over Nick Opfer of Hartington.

With a lapped vehicle between Osborne and Opfer on the restart, the young Norfolk driver went back to work only to have the caution come out with less than a quarter lap to the checkered flag.

Again Osborne had to hold off the field for the two-lap dash to the finish which he did for his first career feature win.

Osborne's dad, Robert Osborne tangled with another driver on lap

11 and was sent to the rear of the 15-car field.

In the final 14 laps, the older Osborne passed 13 cars including two on the final restart to follow his son through the checkered flag for second.

Opfer finished third as he moved into the position on lap 11 passing Chris Johnson of Bloomfield. Doug Tomka of Stanton challenged Opfer several times, but Opfer was able to hold off Tomka on the inside, only to have Osborne pass on the outside. Tomka finished fourth and Ben Sukup of Norfolk rounded out the top 5.
