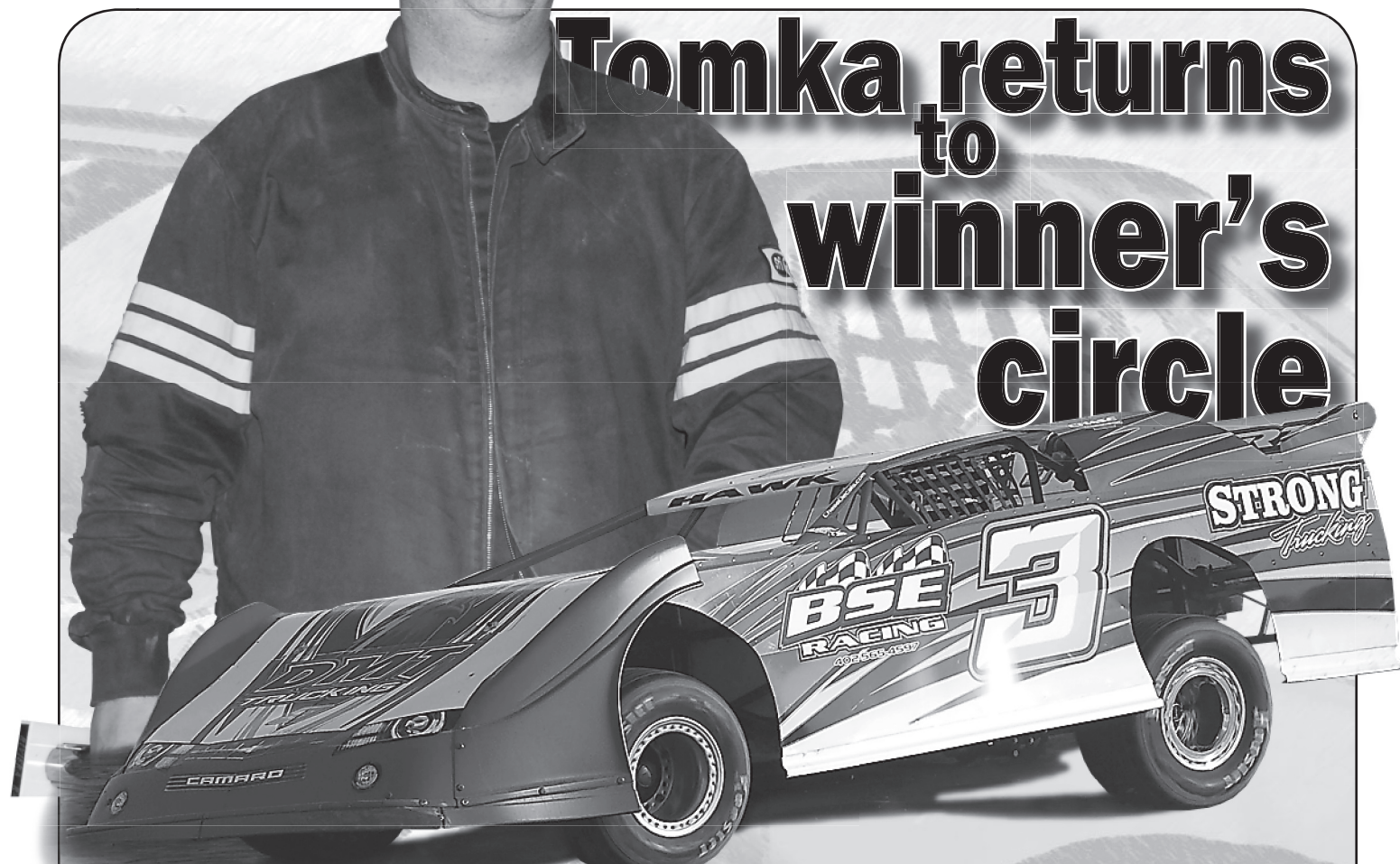

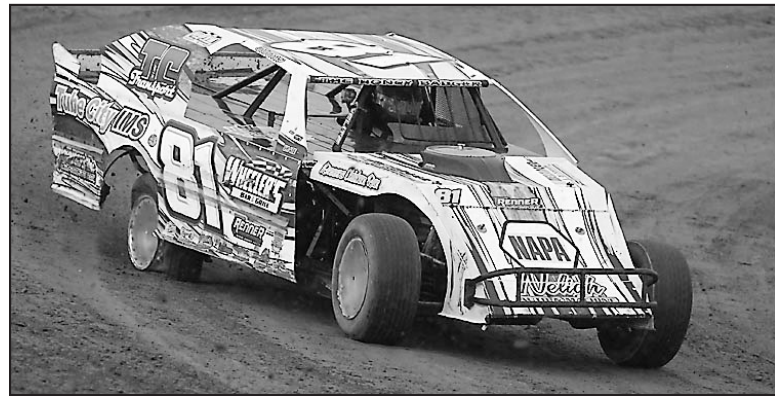

Bruns struggled a little on the high side and with two laps remaining Todd Boulware of Jefferson, who was also running the high side managed to get along side of Bruns to take the white flag second. Bruns was third and Kyle Prauner of Norfolk finished fourth.

Eric Haase of Norfolk rounded out the top 5.

Arneson for several laps.

A caution gave the nodded to Meyer and on the restart he took off and won by a straightaway.

Second went to Uehling, as Wyatt Lehman of Norfolk placed third. Shannon Pospisil of Norfolk was fourth and Columbus' Brook Fluckiger rounded out the top 5.
