

Late passes mean wins at Riviera

Johnson, Prauner, Bittner, Lehman, and Mielke each visit Victory Lane

Deciding when to pass is one factor, but deciding how to pass can also make the difference between winning and a second-place finish. That was the case Saturday night at Riviera Raceway as winners in each of the feature races of the four main divisions were determined in the final few laps.

Jim Johnson of Plainview accelerated to a victory following a restart with two laps remaining in the Grand Nationals division by making a move on the outside in turn one to overtake leader Nick Opfer. Johnson's move allowed him to take the lead for the first and only time in the race.

"I knew the bottom wasn't going to be the place to go," Johnson said. "So I decid-

ed to commit to the high side and hope for the best. I had followed Nick for fourteen laps, and I guess I've learned something from 25 years of doing this. It feels good to get my first win here this year."

In the IMCA SportMods Division, Kyle Prauner used a similar game plan, taking the lead from James Kleinheksel with a high side pass midway through the race and holding on for the win.

"We had a decent starting spot in the third row," Prauner said. "I don't like following anybody into corners, so I go where they're not. James is a pretty tough runner, so it was pretty exciting to get my seventh win this season, and 70th overall. This is a new car, and we've been experimenting. This was a different setup than we've ever used before, but we've been able to get things right."

Tiffany Bittner gradually moved up from near the back of the 16 car pack to third with 7 laps remaining, then took over second place by passing Brett Harrill on the inside with three laps to go in the IMCA Hobby Stock Division. Bittner held off Jason Wilkinson to take the checkered flag.

In the IMCA Sport Compacts Division, Wyatt Lehman took the lead from Luke Jackson as the pair entered the final turn with three laps left. Unfortunately, Jackson spun into the wall attempting to hold position on the inside. Meanwhile, Ramsey Meyer out-dueled Shannon Pospisil for second place.

Lance Mielke led all the way to win the Junior Hornet Division race. Behind him, Colby Kaspar came out on top in a race-long battle among multiple drivers for second place.
