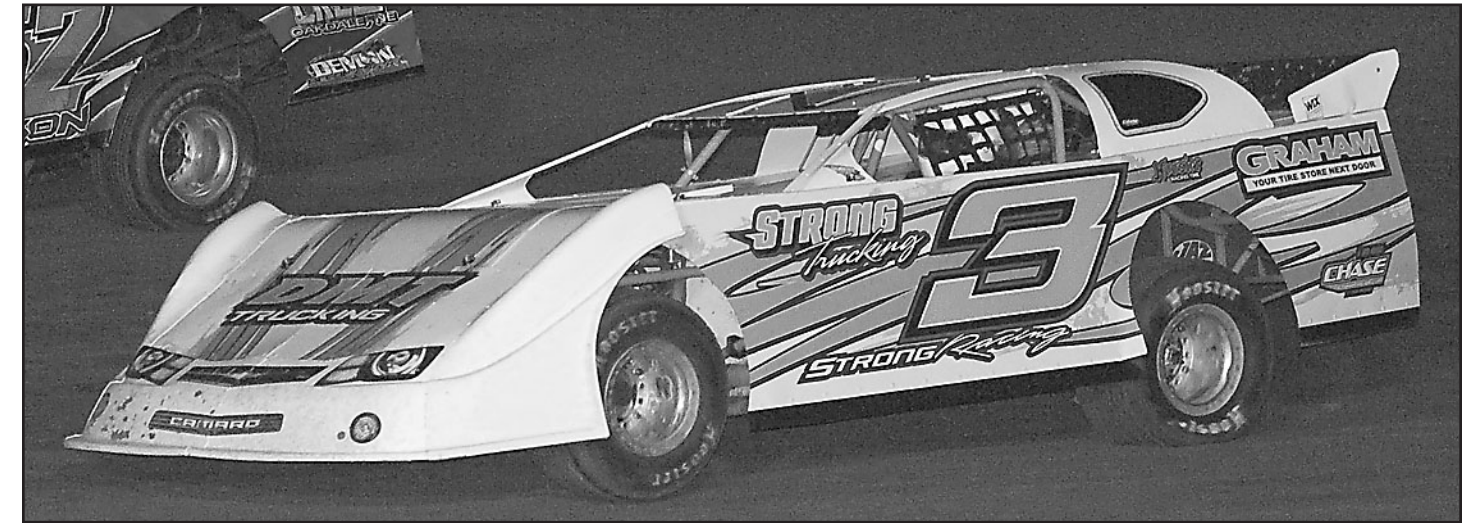
Hansen did finish second and Schuetz was third. Fourth went to Bob Dvorak of Stuart and Jeff Carlson of Wayne was fifth.



Gregg Schuetz (63) works to get around Rick Pendergast (49) during the feature. Schuetz finished third.



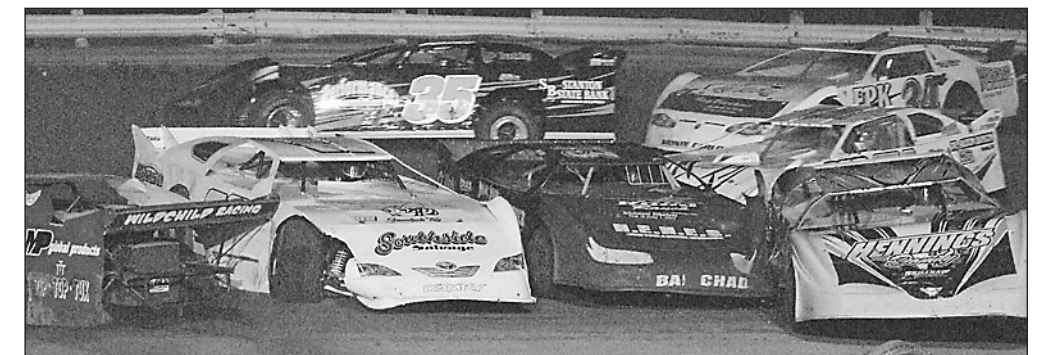
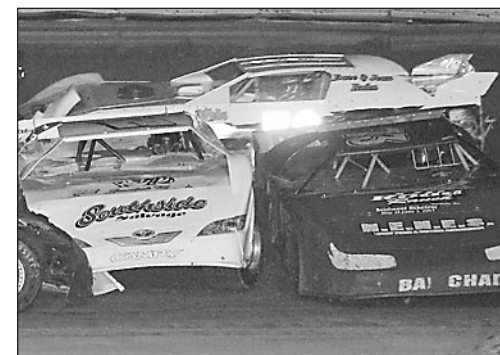

### Prauner takes third win

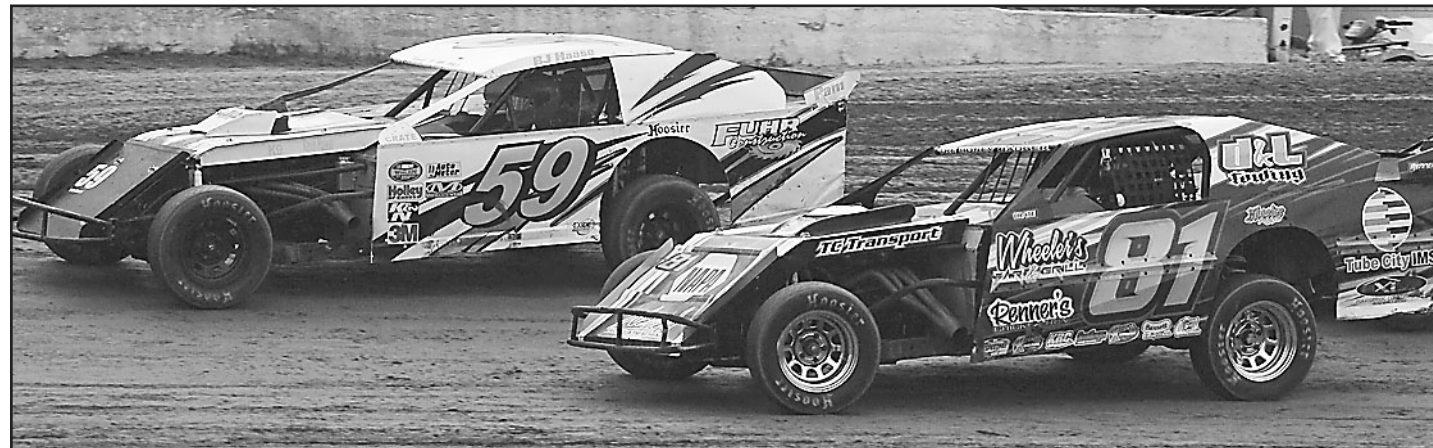

Boulware led the first four laps, before Kleinheksel took over to lead the next eight laps.

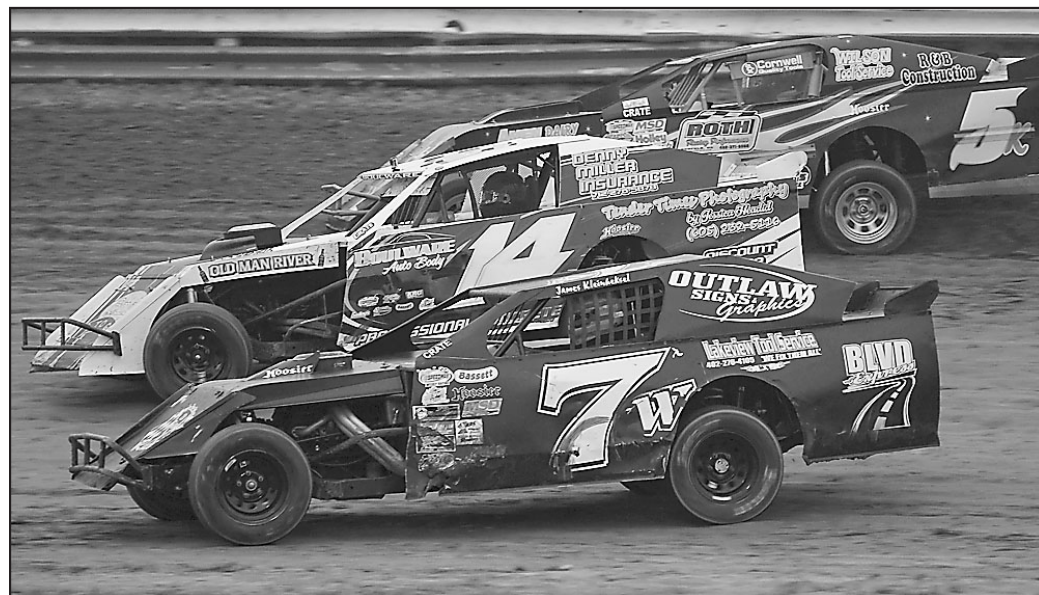
Prauner took over the top spot when Kleinheksel pushed in the second turn. Prauner got the run on the backstretch to shoot out front.

Above, BJ Haase (59) races against nephew, Matt Haase (81), in their heat race. BJ Haase finished fifth in the feature.

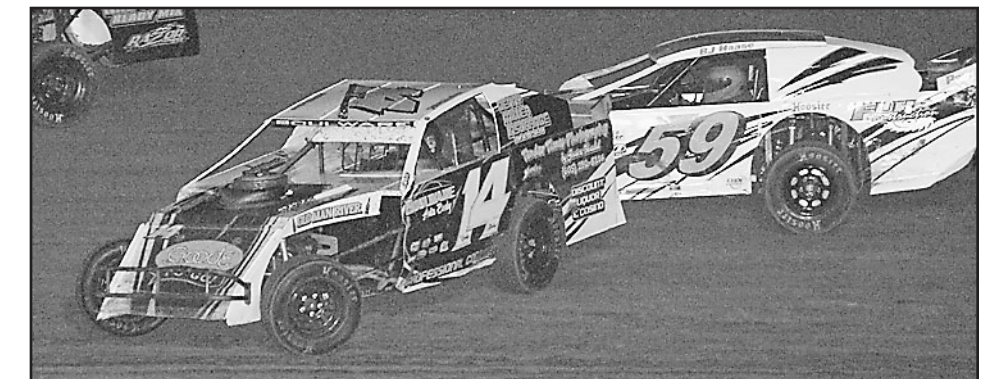
