Birkley makes it two straight wins



Travis Birkley (78) captured back-to-back feature wins Saturday night.

It was following the final restart on lap nine that Travis Birkley of Wakefield zipped to the front of the field to win his second straight feature.

Chase Osborne led the first eight laps, but on the last restart, he broke loose out of turn two and both Mike Benson of Wakefield and Birkley made the pass for the lead.

Benson and Birkley went into turn three side-by-side and it was Birkley getting the run off of turn four to take the lead.

Birkley slowly moved away from the field and by lap 15, he had a straightaway lead. That was the same lap Robert Osborne of Norfolk got by Benson for second.

With no more cautions, Osborne was only able to close the gap to a half straightaway.

Birkley won, Osborne second and Chad Jensen of Norfolk third. Jim Johnson of Plainview was fourth and Benson rounded out the top 5.

Uehling's first feature victory

Norfolk Junior Hornet driver Tanner Uehling had all the luck on his side last Saturday, as he was still running fifth with two laps remaining.

Two laps later he was winning his first feature.

Colton Kemp led the first four laps with Colby Kaspar of Norfolk making the pass for the lead on lap five. It looked as if he had picked up his second straight win, but a caution came out with less than a half lap left in the feature.

Uehling's first break came when he edged Tori Wendell of O'Neill at the line at white flag.

However, on the exit of turn two Uehling had to avoid the collision with Kemp and Norfolk's Bristol Arneson who were running second and third.

Arneson ended up in the wall and Kemp pulled from the track, so when race official went back to the last completed lap, Uehling was just a nose in front of Wendell for position.

That lined up Kaspar first,

Uehling second and Wendell third.

On the restart, Kaspar went into turn one too hard and pushed up the track and opened the door for Uehling.

Uehling dove low to make the pass and went on to lead the final two laps for the win. Wendell stayed close to his bumper to finish second. Suede Remsing of Norfolk finished third and Cameron Wilkinson of Neligh captured fourth. Rounding out the top 5 was Kemp.
