Vollbrecht takes win

Nelson Vollbrecht of Stanton was a man on a mission. The Mission – get to the front as quick as you can and put as much distance as you can.

By lap eight of the 18-lap feature, Vollbrecht was pacing the field and trying to put distance on the rest of the field.

However, three cautions kept the field bunched. On each restart, Vollbrecht got back in a groove and ran consistent laps, making it tough for the cars behind him to pass.

Kyle Prauner of Norfolk was able to get alongside Vollbrecht, but on each exit Vollbrecht had the grip he needed and pulled away.

Vollbrecht won his second feature of the season, as Prauner was second. Todd Boulware of Jefferson was third. Fourth went to David Johnson of Norfolk, who led two laps.

Rounding out the top 5 was Matt Haase of Norfolk, who struggled early in the race.
