The offspring of a champion led seven laps in the Hobby Stock feature and raced to finish out the race in second, as Colby Langenberg of Norfolk won his third feature of the season.

Gage Koch, son of track champion Brian Koch, clicked off the laps without flinching and held off some of the nation's top drivers to do it.

Koch, who is in his first year in a rear-wheel drive car, built

up nearly a straightaway lead when the first caution came out.

It was on the second restart when Langenberg made the pass on Koch using the high side.

Langenberg led the final eight laps for the win.

Koch held off a late charge by Tiffany Bittner of Norfolk to take second Bittner was third. Jeremy Hoskinson placed fourth and Travis Coover of Neligh was fifth.

Glosser paced the field for the next eight laps, but a caution came out to bunch the field.

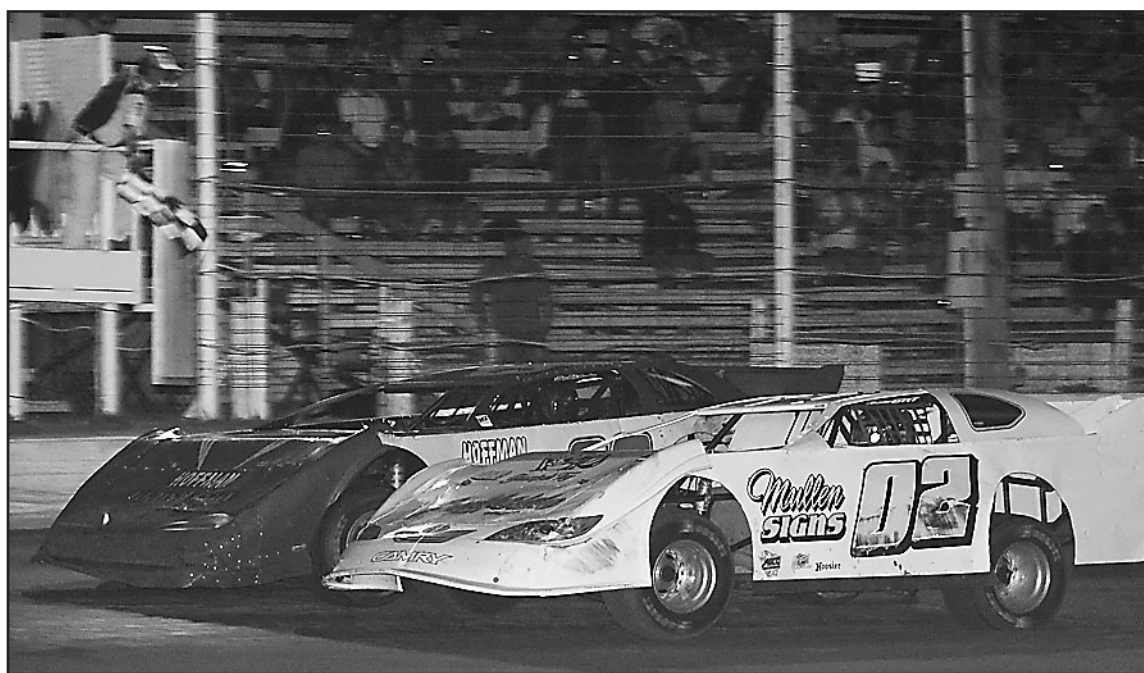
On the restart, Babcock got the high side to start working and as the white flag dropped Babcock and Glosser were side-by-side.

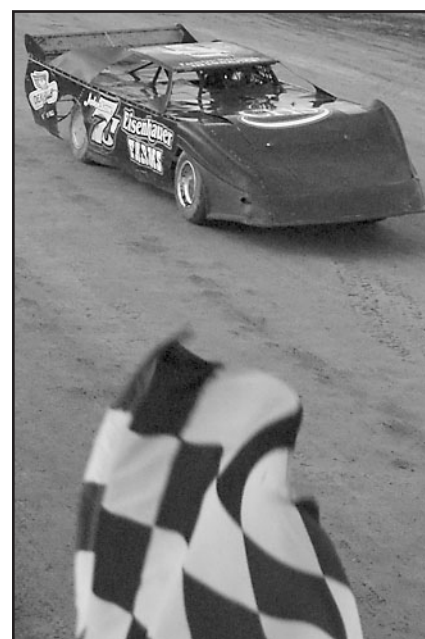
Dean Wilkinson of Oakdale stayed mid pack for most of the race and passed Nick Opfer of Hartington in the final laps to round out the top 5.



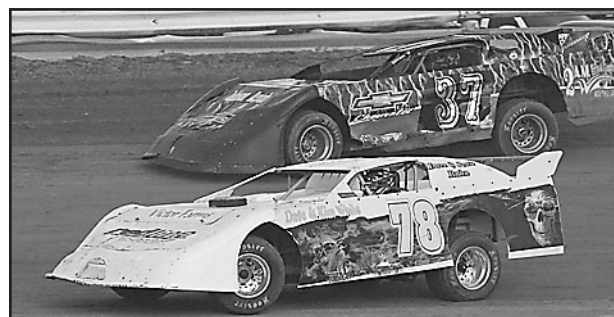
Mike Babcock (83) just noses out Rusty Glosser (02) for the feature win.



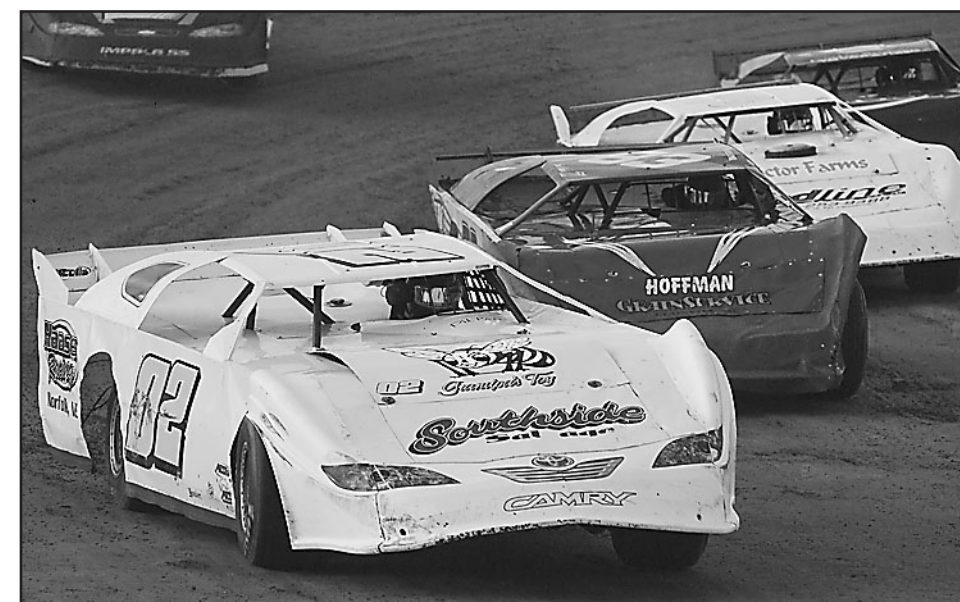
