Wilkinson's fifth

Neligh's Jason Wilkinson led only one lap last week and picked up his fifth win, when he passed Jeremy Hoskinson of Norfolk on the final lap.

Alex Korus of Genoa led the opening lap before former Hobby Stock champion Jim Kimmel of Norfolk led the next seven laps.

Hoskinson worked the low side and made little ground, but when he moved to the high side, he went from third to first in a couple laps.

Hoskinson led for six laps

using the high side, forcing Wilkinson to use the low side, which was not as fast.

On the final restart, Hoskinson still had the advantage on the high side, but on the final lap, he lost grip in the rear tires.

Wilkinson made the pass and went to the high side to finish the lap first. Hoskinson was second and Kimmel was third. Fourth went to Mark Arduser of Battle Creek and Colby Langenberg of Norfolk rounded out the top five.

Pospisil finds victory lane for the fourth time

Shannon Pospisil must have felt like Moses parting the sea last week.

However, the Norfolk driver did not drive through the field, he hugged the low side and in

one lap he went from seventh to first.

Pospisil won by more than a straightaway, as the second place finisher, Ramsey Meyer of Pierce hand his hands full trying to pass Kandie Smidt of Norfolk.

Meyer used the high side, as Smidt had the low line working to her advantage. For six laps, Smidt kept Meyer busy and by the time he cleared her, Pospisil was gone.

Jayne Bargholz of Pender watched the two battle side-by-side waiting for a hole to open up.

Once Meyer cleared Smidt, Bargholz managed to get to the inside of her and make the pass quickly.

Bargholz placed third.

Newcomer to the track, Brooke Fluckiger of Columbus brought home a fourth place finish when Smidt's car spun sideways into Wyatt Lehman's car

Fluckiger got by as the two straightened their cars out.

Lehman finished fifth and Smidt limped back to the line for sixth.
