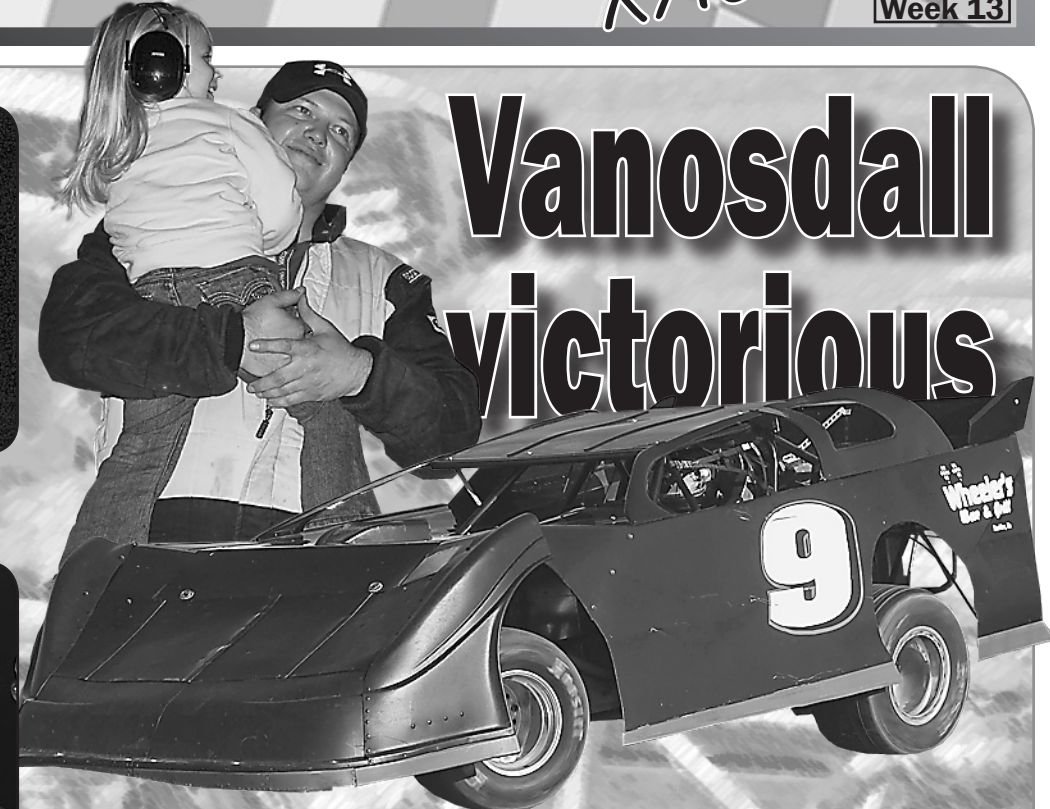

Prauner continues winning

Norfolk's Kyle Prauner did not quite have the hole shot he had the week before at start of the feature, but the result was the same – another victory.

The only caution came out for Kyle's dad Jerry Prauner, who hit the wall and broke the rear end out the car.

Kyle had just taken the lead, so on the restart Neligh's Derek Sehi resumed the lead where he had been for the first nine laps.

On the restart, Prauner jumped passed Sehi in turn one

and led the final nine laps.

Jefferson's Todd Boulware battled for several laps with Matt Haase of Norfolk, before getting by Haase and Sehi in three laps.

Prauner had opened up a little more than a straightaway lead.

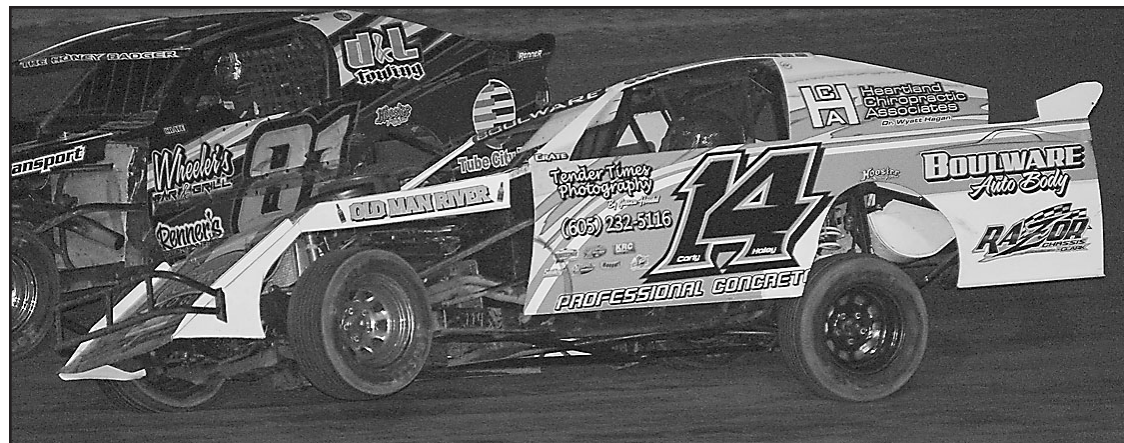
Boulware finished second, Sehi held off Haase for third. Haase was fourth and Nelson Vollbrecht of Norfolk rounded out the top 5.

Arneson doubles win count

With two laps remaining, Norfolk's Bristol Arneson ran down Cameron Wilkinson of Neligh to win his second feature of the season.

Wilkinson had opened up a half-straightaway lead when Arneson moved into the second position with laps two laps left in the six-lap feature.

A lap-and-a-half later he was passing Wilkinson for the

lead on the backstretch of the white flag lap.

Arneson has finished second two times this season and both times it has been by less than a car length.

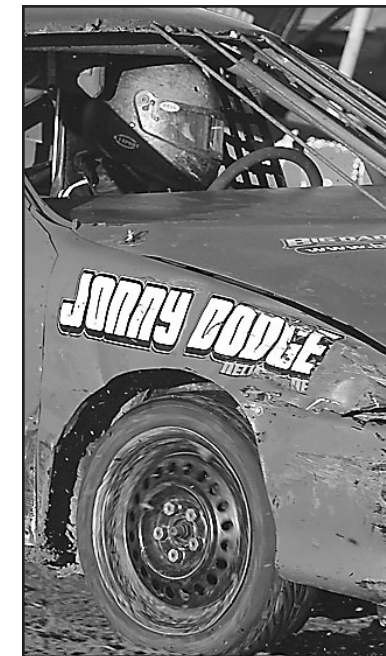
This time he pulled off the win by two-car lengths.
