Johnson grabs win, closes gap in points

It is not too often you see Norfolk's Robert Osborne take the lead and see him surrender it to another driver.

Last week, Jim Johnson of Plainview had his car hooked up and flying to pick up his second win of the season.

Nate Behmer of Hoskins led the first 10 laps when Osborne took over the top spot following a caution period.

A lap later Johnson was hunting down Osborne. On lap 16, Johnson made a look inside just as they caught lapped traffic. Johnson tried to out brake Osborne and the lapped car as they went three wide into turn three.

Johnson knew it was not going to work and let Osborne have the corner.

Osborne took advantage and opened up a half straight-away lead by the time Johnson gathered things back up.

Again Johnson went back to work, this time Osborne moved the low side and opened up the high side for

Johnson. Four laps later Johnson took over the lead.

But lapped traffic again hampered Johnson. This time he was able to maintain the lead despite Osborne getting alongside.

Johnson won, Osborne followed at second. Chase Osborne of Norfolk made a late pass on Chad Jensen of Norfolk to take his best finish at third. Jensen was fourth.

Travis Birkley of Wakefield, who brought out a caution, recovered to round out the top 5.

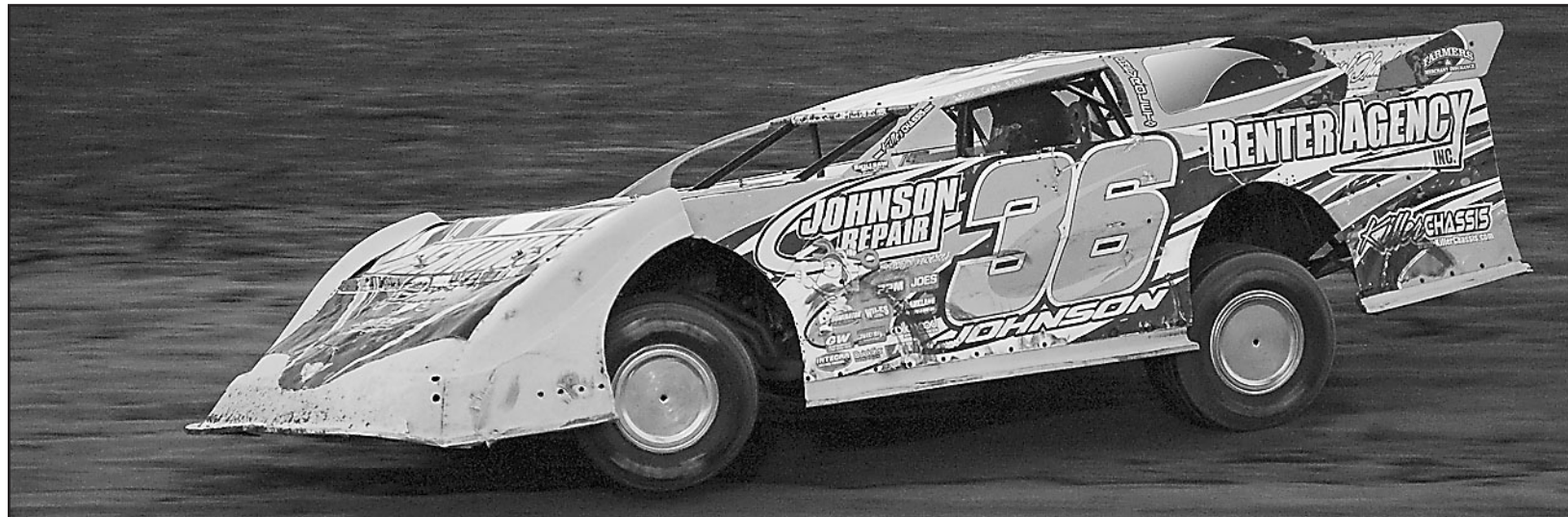
Johnson's victory closed the gap back to a one point advantage for Osborne in the title hunt.

Johnson is the defending champion and could be the first repeat champion (other than Osborne) in more than a decade.

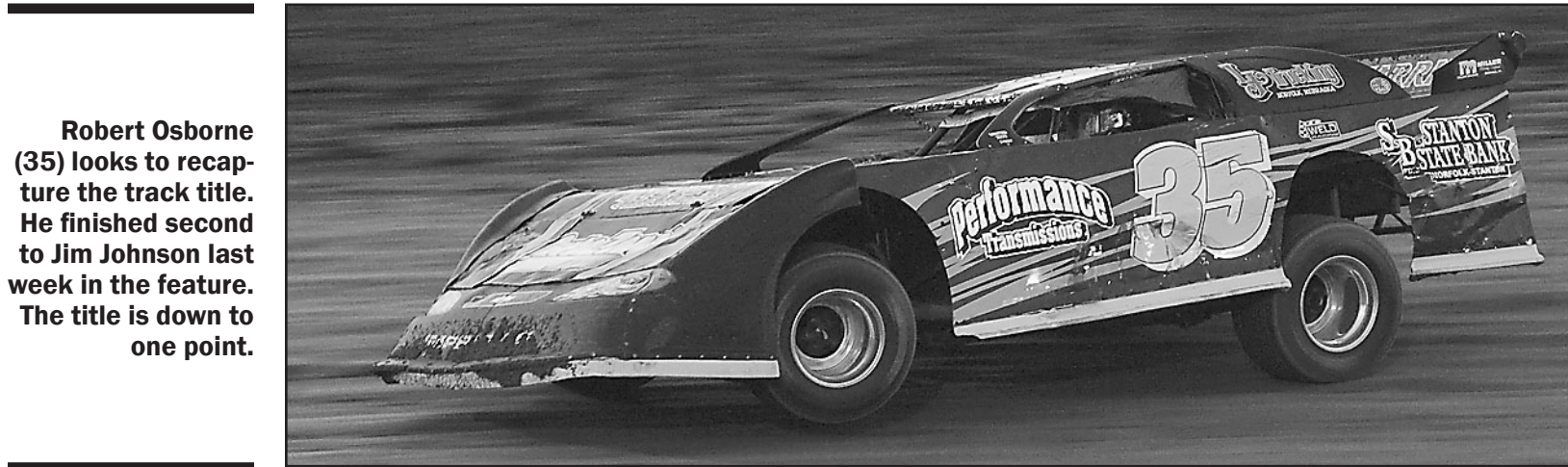
Last season it came down to the final laps to determine the title winner. With tonight and championship night left, every position will count.



Jim Johnson greets his kids after his feature win last week.



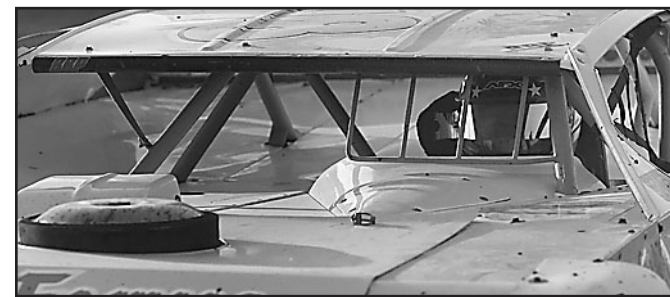
Jim Johnson (36) won the feature to keep the points race close. It was Johnson's second win.
