
> Only one caution slowed the race and that was when Bob Milander of Norfolk was helped around in turns one and two.

> On the restart, Zuhlke was at point, Jay Smith of Norfolk was second and Roth was running third with five laps remaining.




Winning their heats were Matthies and Hansen. It was Matthies fourth win and Hansen's first.



Todd Moore of Norfolk leads Jeff Haase out of turn four during heat races. Haase is subbing for Raymond Haase in the 2x machine.




Curt Zuhlke (0z) gets to the inside of Keith Hansen (04) to grab the lead in the "A" feature.




