

Wells wins for first time

It was a tight battle between Joel Carlson of Winside and Bill Wells of Norfolk during the Street Stock "A" feature last Saturday night, with Wells winning his first "A" feature of the season.

Wells was the only driver in the top seven of the standings not to win a race this season, but after eight top fives, including three seconds, Wells rolled into victory lane.

Wells and Carlson started in the fourth row and moved through the field quickly.

Terry Walker of Norfolk led the first two laps of 15 before Carlson took over on lap three. Walker slipped up on the fourth lap allowing Wells to take over second and Mike Timm of Pierce into third.

Carlson held a comfortable lead over Wells, but the first and final caution flag flew with seven laps remaining, tightening up the field.

Following the restart Carlson and Wells put on a show for the fans, as Carlson took the high line around and Wells took the low way around.

Wells would get the advantage in the turns, but Carlson's momentum out of the turns would even the score down the straightaways, sending the cars side-by-side into the turns.

Slowly, the high groove started to go away, which allowed Wells to pull away. Carlson then had to contend with four-time

winner Darrell Doerr of Plainview.


Doerr, like Wells, worked the low line and was able to race side-by-side and at the finish line Doerr nipped Carlson by very little

Roth's fifth win moves him into points lead over Osborne

Grand National "A" feature Saturday night, Reggie Roth of Bancroft has moved into first place in the Grand National points standings at Riviera Raceway taking the spot from Robert Osborne of Norfolk.

Roth led the points the first week after winning the opening night's "A" feature, but throughout the year, he has fallen to as low as sixth in the standings. Osborne, on the other hand, has led the standings 12 weeks out of the 17-week season, so far.

Following "A" feature wins three and four back on July 19 and 26, Roth moved into second, trailing Osborne by two points.

Roth now has a lead of nine points over

Leading the final 16 of the 25 laps in the Osborne. Zuhlke, who has led the points three times, is in third.

The points have been competitive throughout the year, as 12 of the 17 weeks the points spread between first and second was less than 17 points.

son, matching Zuhlke's five wins in the Grand National division.

Travis Dickes of Madison controlled the field for the first nine circuits. Roth started on the outside of row four and was running fourth after six laps.

On lap seven, Roth passed previous week's winner Vic Lovejoy of Meadow Grove for third. A lap later, Roth got by Jay Smith of Norfolk for second.


Zuhlke made the top three on lap nine, passing Smith for the spot.

Roth then made a move on Dickes, opening a hole for himself and Zuhlke the get through to lead lap 10.

The two drivers would go nose to tail Roth picked up his fifth win of the sea- for 11 laps before Scott Phillips of Norfolk went low in turn two and caught his left front tire on one of the large white tires, spinning his car out.


The impact jerked Phillips steering wheel dislocating and breaking his wrist. The race was red flagged to allow crews to get Phillips to the hospital...

Reggie Roth (60) and Curt Zuhlke (0z) hooked up and went straight to the front together. Roth and Zuhlke gained valuable points in the standings.






Travis Loecker, who is running second in the points, took home his second trophy of the year. Doerr was the closes competition in the race.

Phillips said he made changes to his car after winning the "B" feature. The changes made his car tight, but through the race he said the car loosened up.

He was looking to get by Keith Hansen of Norfolk and Dean Wilkenson of Oakdale, when he said he went to low into turn two, catching the tire.

"If I would have hit the (large) tire with the nose of the car, the car would have been damaged instead my wrist," said Phillips.


Phillips injuries required surgery, where two screws were used to repair the wrist. Phillips said he will be out for eight weeks. Phillips will replace himself to finish out the season. He is currently 10th in the points standings.






