It was Langenberg's second win of the season. Wilkinson finished second and Travis Coover of Neligh placing third.

## Meyer, Koch continues to win classes

It was a scary moment for Pierce Sport Compact driver Cameron Meyer, as Adam Wagner of Norfolk showed up in the claim area with \$1,500 to claim his car.

Meyer, who has won five times at the track and is slowly pulling away for the track title, is also in the hunt for a national title. He is currently third in the nation.

Denying the claim, erases the points he has earned for the season and he would be suspended from IMCA points racing for 30

days.

However, during the claiming process, officials discovered the Wagner's car was illegal and Wagner was disqualified which meant the claim was voided.

Meyer led the final six laps, after passing Jordan Uehling of Norfolk for the win. Uehling was second and Jayme Bargholz of Wakefield was third.

Norfolk youngster Gage Koch continues to lead the pack in the Junior Hornets.

Tori Wendell of O'Neill paced the field for the first two circuits before Koch caught passed her. It was Koch's sixth win of the season. Wendell was second and K.C. Wilkinson of Neligh was third.
