In the Junior Hornet division, Bristol Arneson of Norfolk will have to wait another

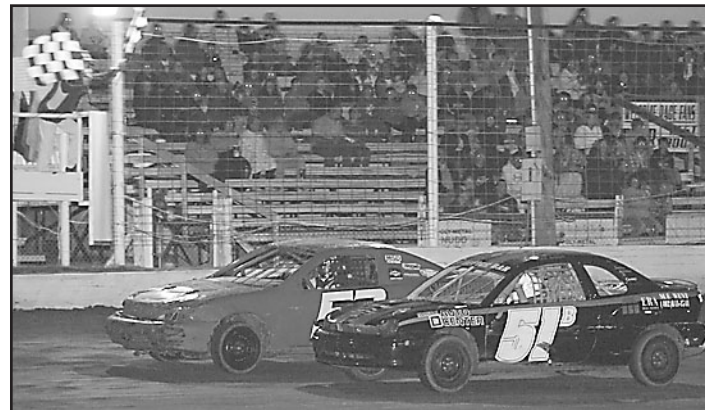
week to see if he can win a feature.

Michael Ronnfeldt (94) and Jordan Uehling (58) each led a lap in the feature. Uehling finished third.

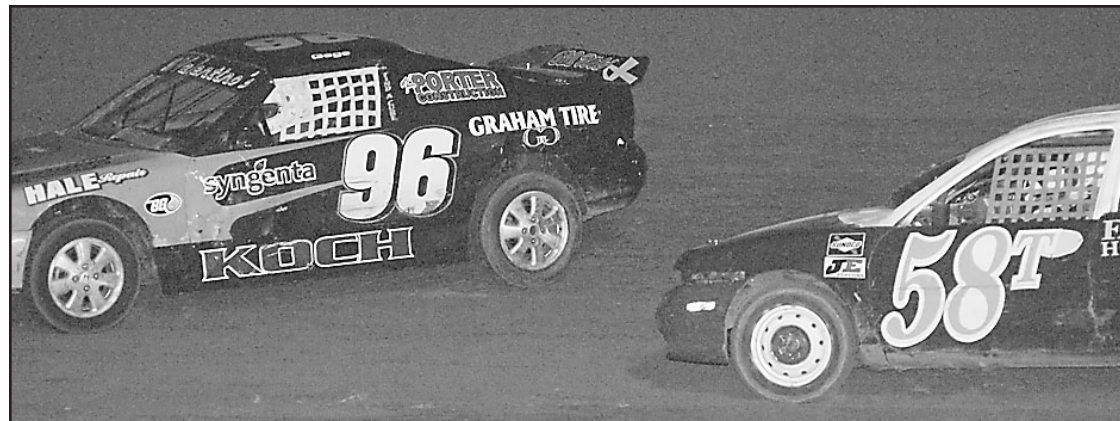

Hobby Stock driver Jason Wilkinson of Neligh led the final seven laps for his ninth win of the season.

Neligh's Tracy Buck took off from the pole position for the lead, as Larry Remsing and Kevin Haase, both of Norfolk, battled side-by-side for second for four laps.

Wilkinson moved past both Remsing and Haase on the fifth lap. By lap nine he was pacing the field.

Jeremy Hoskinson of Norfolk was the second car to cross the finish line, but was penalized four spots when he tangled with Remsing earlier in the race.

Remsing ended up on the infield and finished 13th.

Buck was credited with second as Kevin Haase placed third. Jim Kimmel of Norfolk was fourth and Colby Langenberg picked up another top 5.

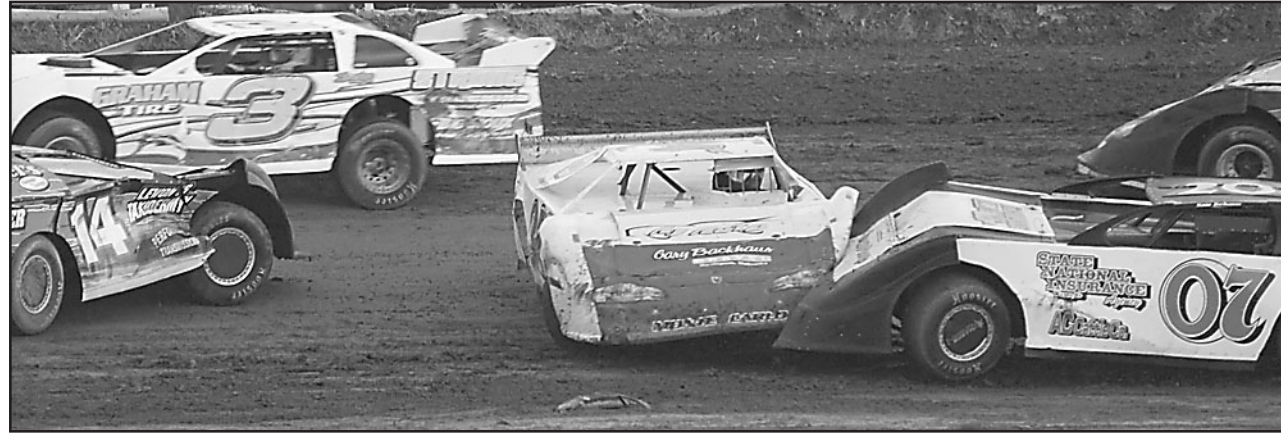

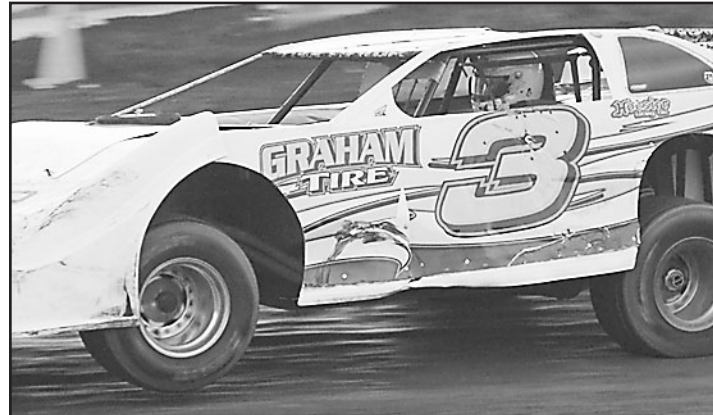

Birkley outlasts field to claim his first win of the season

Travis Birkley of Wakefield led the entire 25 laps in the Grand National division, but not without attacks from Jim Johnson of Plainview.

As Johnson's car drifted back, Norfolk's Tad Pospisil took over the second spot but could only pace Birkley for several laps before a caution came out. Pospisil was driving for Chad Jensen.

On the restart after the third caution, Johnson got a second wind and regained the second position and went back after Birkley.

Johnson was involved in a first lap incident that loosened his front nose piece, which he lost battling with Birkley for the lead on lap 20.

Without the nose piece, Johnson was still fast and was able to get to Birkley's bumper, but struggled to make the pass.

On the final caution came out with two laps remain. On the restart, Birkley pulled away, as Robert Osborne of Norfolk contested for the second position.

Birkley won by one car length, as Johnson was second and Osborne third. Fourth went to Tad Pospisil of Norfolk, who was driving for Chad Jensen.
