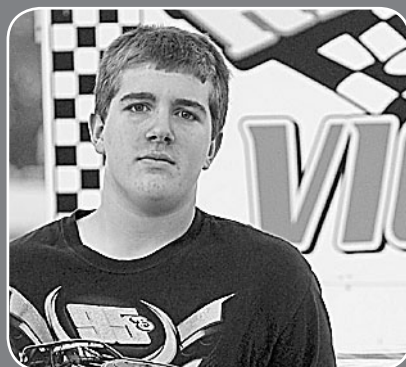

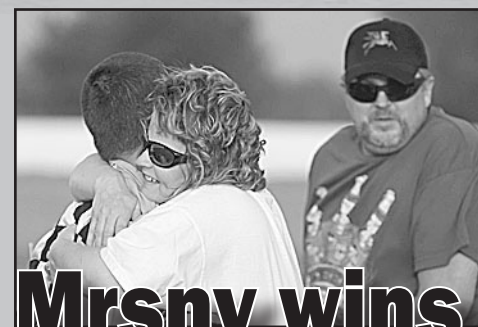

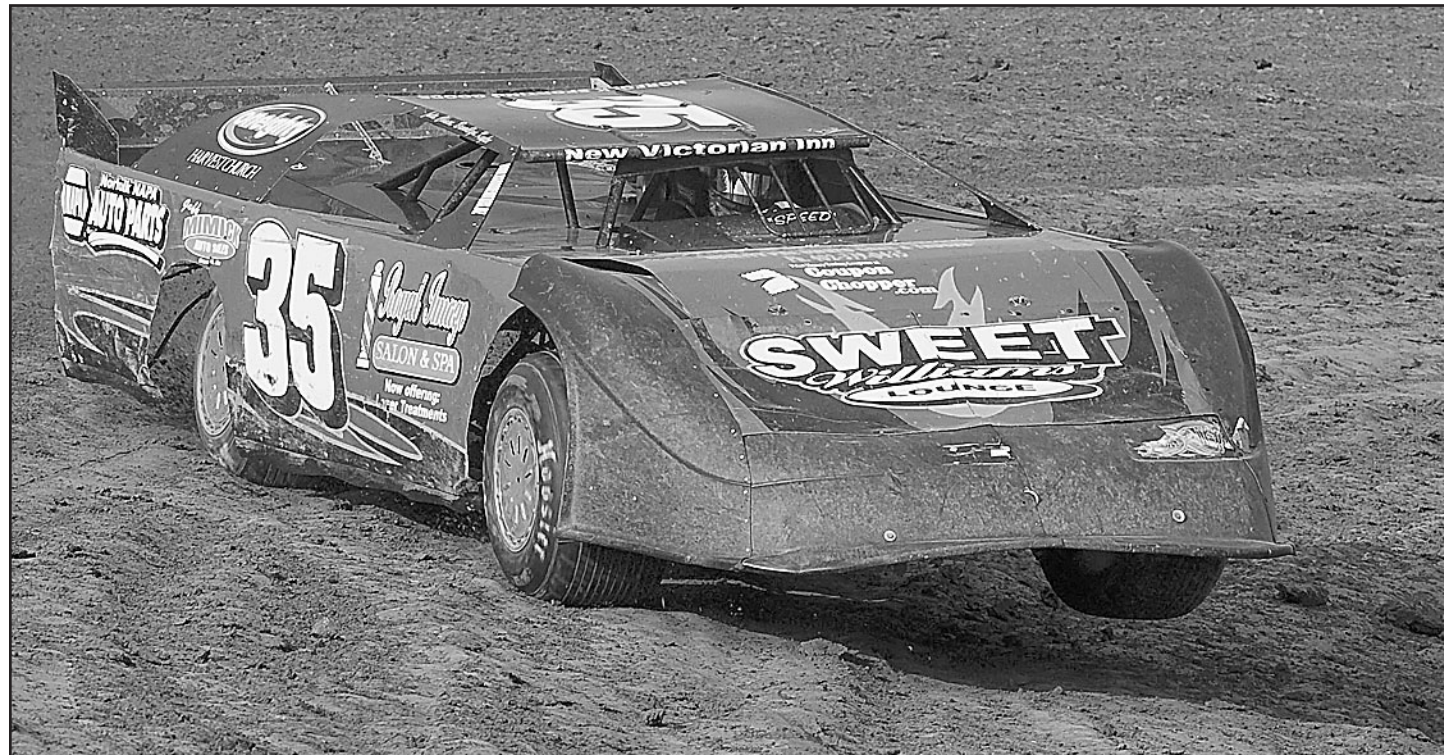

Osborne matches son

It was a scoring nightmare during the Grand National "A" feature Monday, as the main event went green-white-checkers.

Robert Osborne of Norfolk lapped the seventh place car before taking the checkered flags for his second win of the season.

Osborne started on the outside of the third row. He was running third on the second lap and second after the fourth lap.

Travis Birkley of Wakefield led the first lap, before Alex Banks of Norfolk paced the field for the second lap. Chris Johnson of Bloomfield took point on the third lap and led for three laps.

Osborne got by Johnson

and gained moment. The leader caught the back of the field on lap 10, which allowed Johnson to get back to Osborne's bumper.

However, Osborne made it through two cars, but Johnson was held up. Osborne took off and pulled a large lead.

It would be until the 19 lap when he caught up with the next set of slower traffic. Johnson ate into the lead, but it was too great a lead.

Osborne took the win, Johnson took second, Eric Vanosdall of Winside finished third as defending points champion Chad Jensen of Norfolk placed fourth. Cory Haase of Norfolk rounded out the top 5.

Osborne and Mrsny pick up first wins

Chase Osborne of Norfolk, the son of 11-time Grand National champion Robert Osborne, picked up his first win at Riviera Raceway Monday.

He worked his way through the field and broke into the top 3 on lap six of the 12 laps run. A lap later, he passed Sean Smith of Norfolk for the second position before the first caution for debris was thrown.

On the restart, fellow teenager Adam Wagner of Norfolk led the field to the green, but Osborne managed to get around Wagner to lead lap eight.

Another caution for debris bunched the field again. Osborne held onto the lead for the final two laps. Wagner held

off a hard charging Cameron Meyer of Pierce to finish second. Meyer took third. Smith was credited for a fourth place finish, as Grant Hurlbert of Winside rounded out the top 5.

Junior Hornet Cole Wiley of Norfolk has won the first two nights in the new class, but Monday night Wiley did not run the main feature, opening it up for another driver to pick up his first win.

That new winner was Phillip Mrsny of Norfolk. Joey Haase of Norfolk led the first three laps, before Mrsny took over for the win.

Haase hung onto second and new comer Gage Koch of Norfolk placed third.
