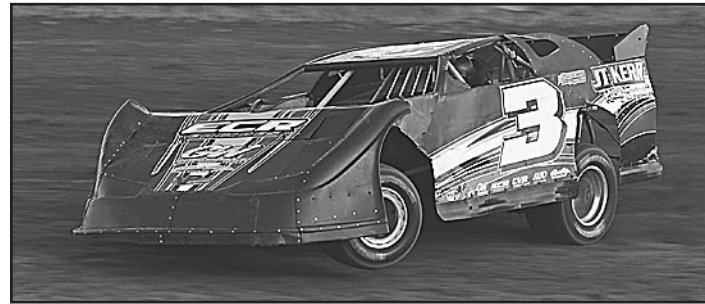
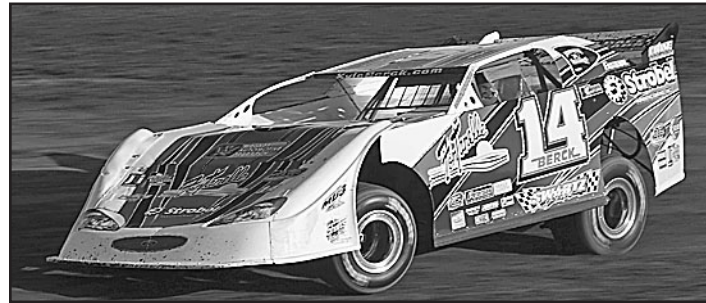


Bill Leighton, Jr. (24) finished sixth.



Mike Collins (3) finished eighth.

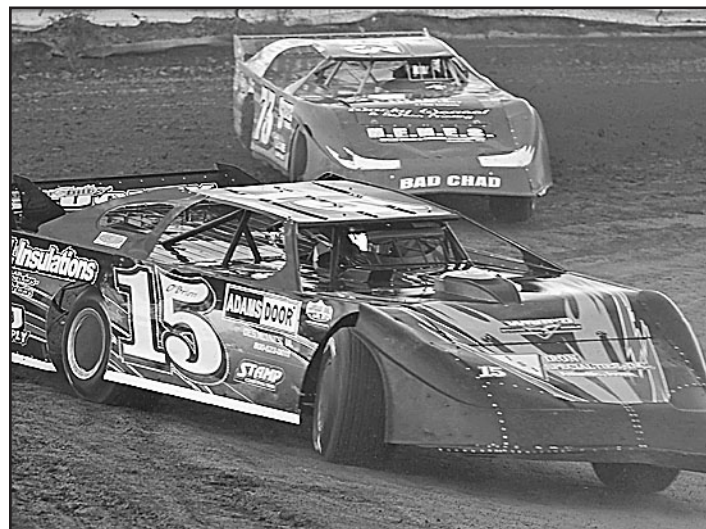
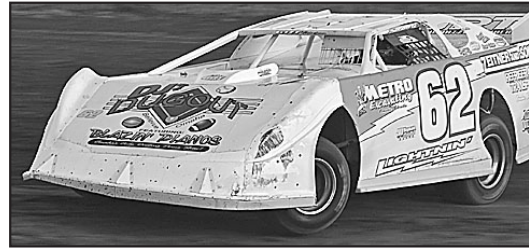


Kyle Berck (14) made the trip to Norfolk only to be the first car out of the feature with mechanical problems.



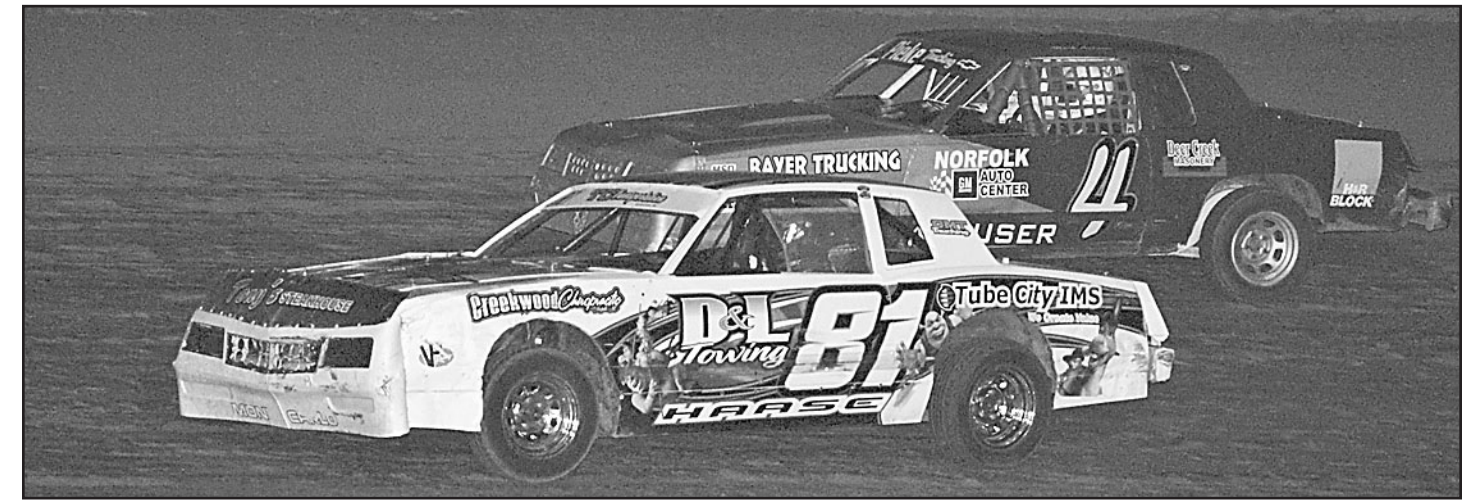
Mike Wiarda (1) finished 12th.

Mark Arduser was second and Buck was third. Fourth went to Tom Marksmeier of Norfolk and rounding out the top 5 was Jim Kimmel of Norfolk.

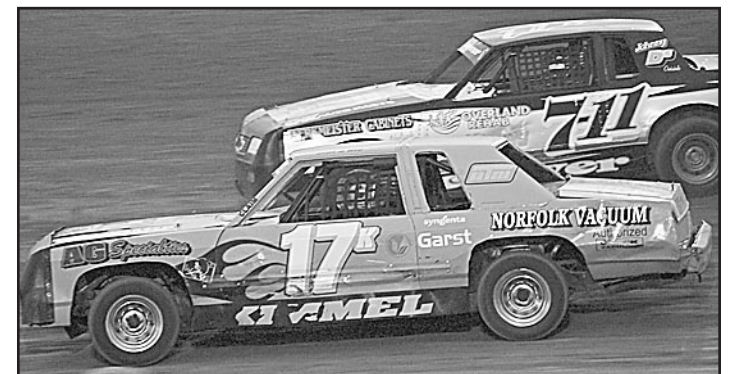

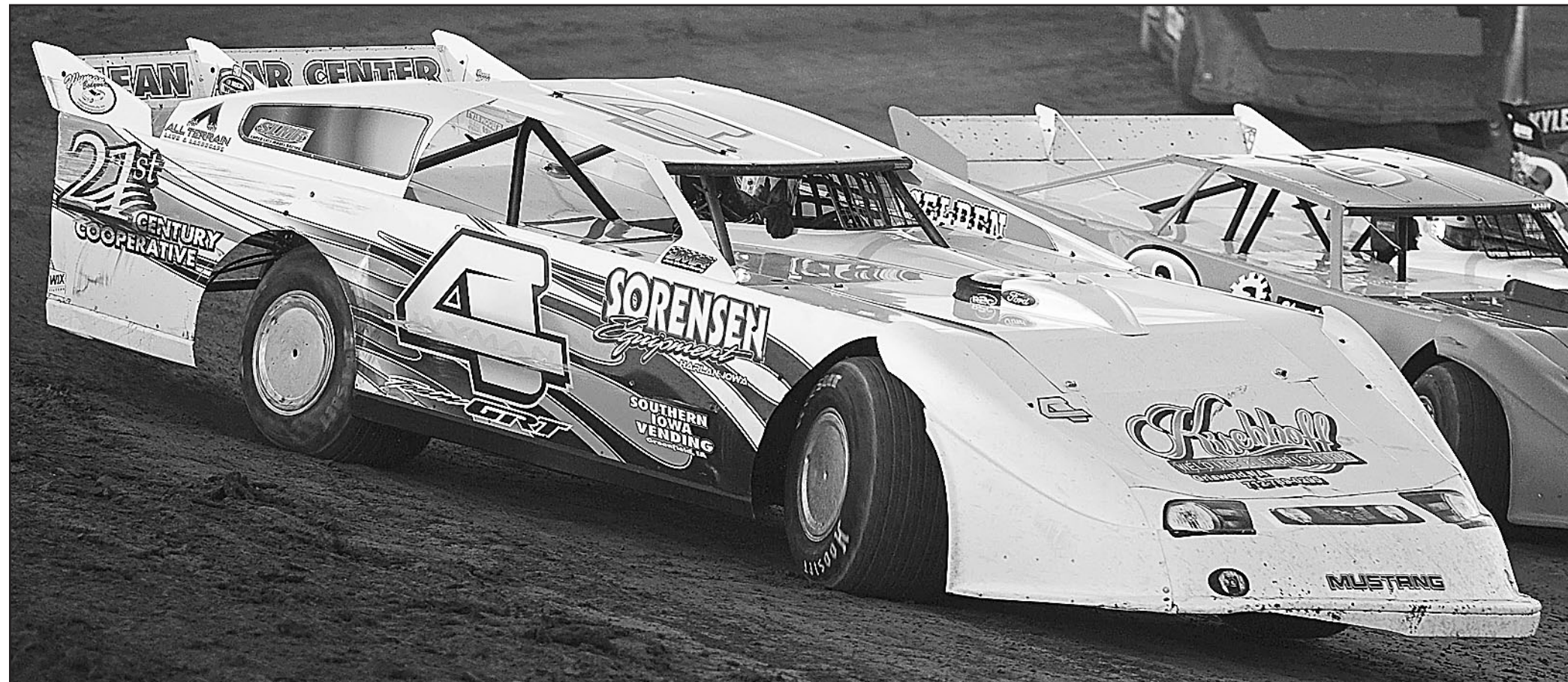

J.C. Wyman led the final 20 laps to win the Super Late Model Racing special last week to collect the \$1,000 prize.

Wyman takes SLMR title at Riviera Raceway

With the Super Late Model Racing series in town, 31 SLMR regulars and Riviera regulars met head-to-head.

The local drivers had to make a few modifications to compete with SLMR cars and two local regulars made it into the top 10 of the 25-car field.

But it was J.C. Wyman of Griswald, IA

taking the win.

Chris Johnson of Bloomfield and Mike Benson of Wakefield started on the front row and Johnson led the first five laps before Wyman made the pass on the former track champion.

The longest racing without a caution came from lap nine to lap 17. Wyman had slipped

away from the field, but as the laps went by Johnson was inching closer and closer.

The final caution came out with eight laps left. Wyman was lead, Johnson run second and Joe Kosiski was third.

On the restart, Kosiski battled with Corey Zeitner of Bellevue for third to allow Wyman and Johnson to open a gap from third place.

It was Wyman's first SLMR win. He followed in his grandfather's footsteps. Back in the 1960s, Jim Wyman won a Riviera 300 race at the track.

The younger Wyman collected a \$1,000 pay day and Johnson's check was \$1,050. The racing series set up the pay out that second place receives \$50 more than first.

Third place went to Kosiski. Zeitner was fourth and Jason O'Brien of Atlantic, IA rounded out the top 5.

Johnson's brother Jim Johnson of Plainview finished 10th after starting 18th.

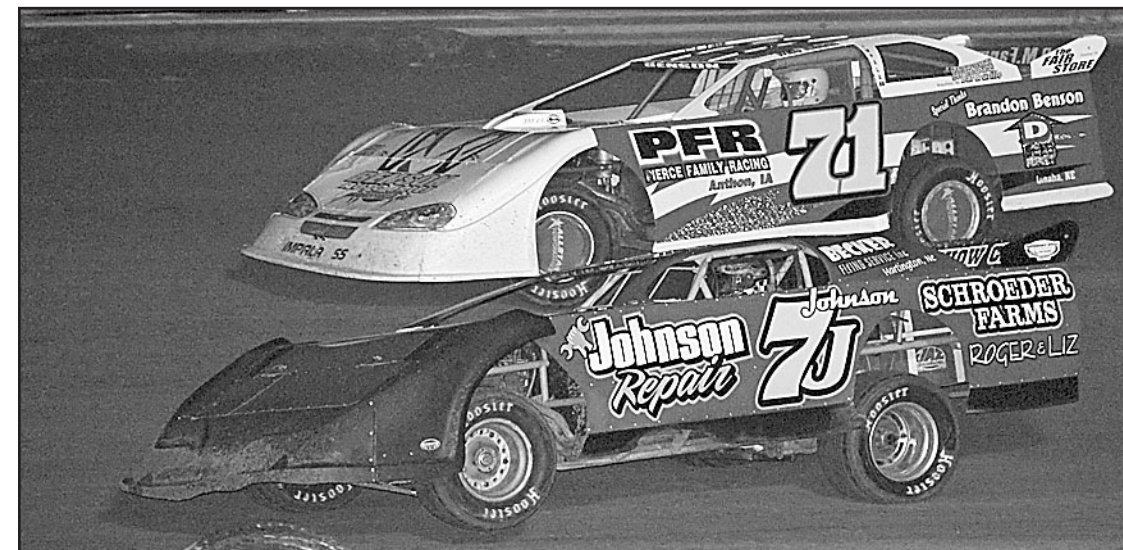
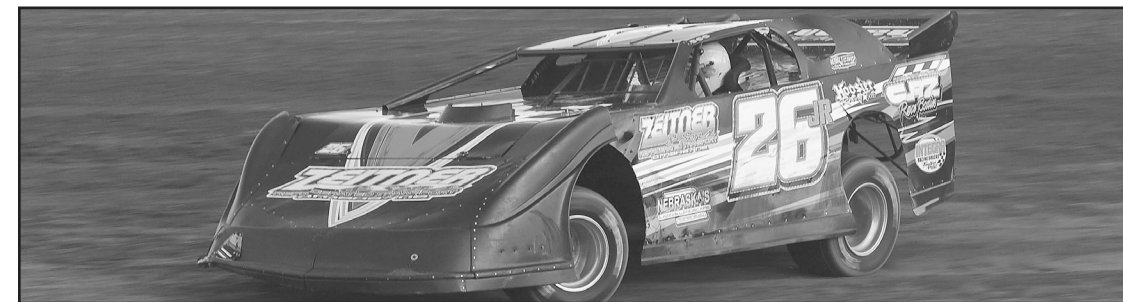
