Sehi took second his second straight win. Haase was second and Brabec took third.

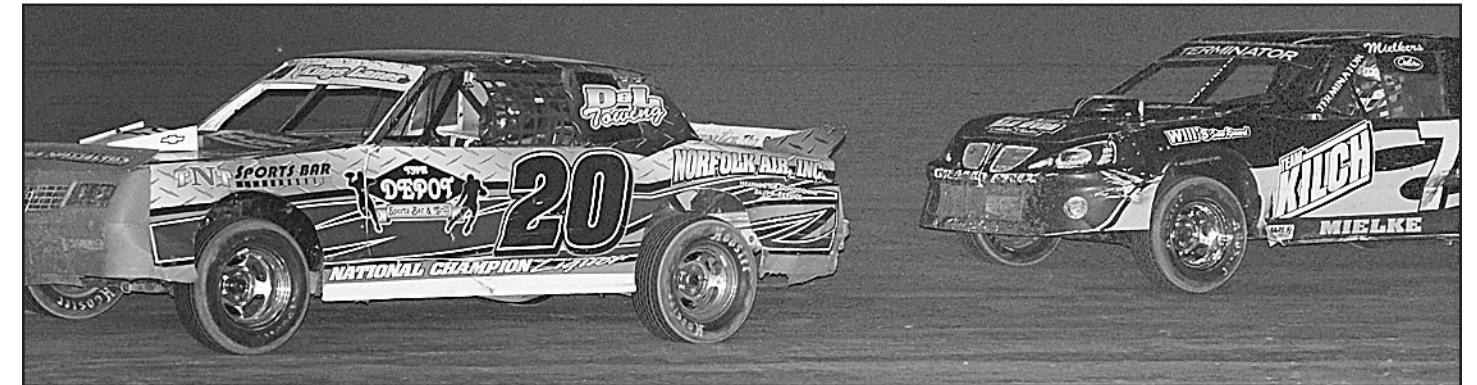


Jeremy Brabec (99) won his heat race, led 11 laps in the feature and finished third.

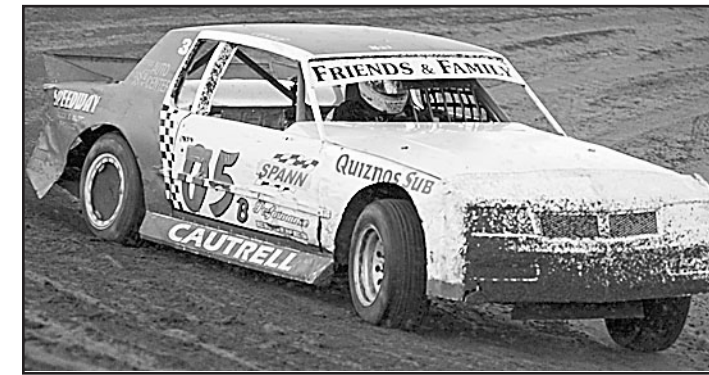

for the win. For the last 12 laps, Mielke made several attempts. Lapped traffic was a concern, when Haase caught the back markers on lap 10.

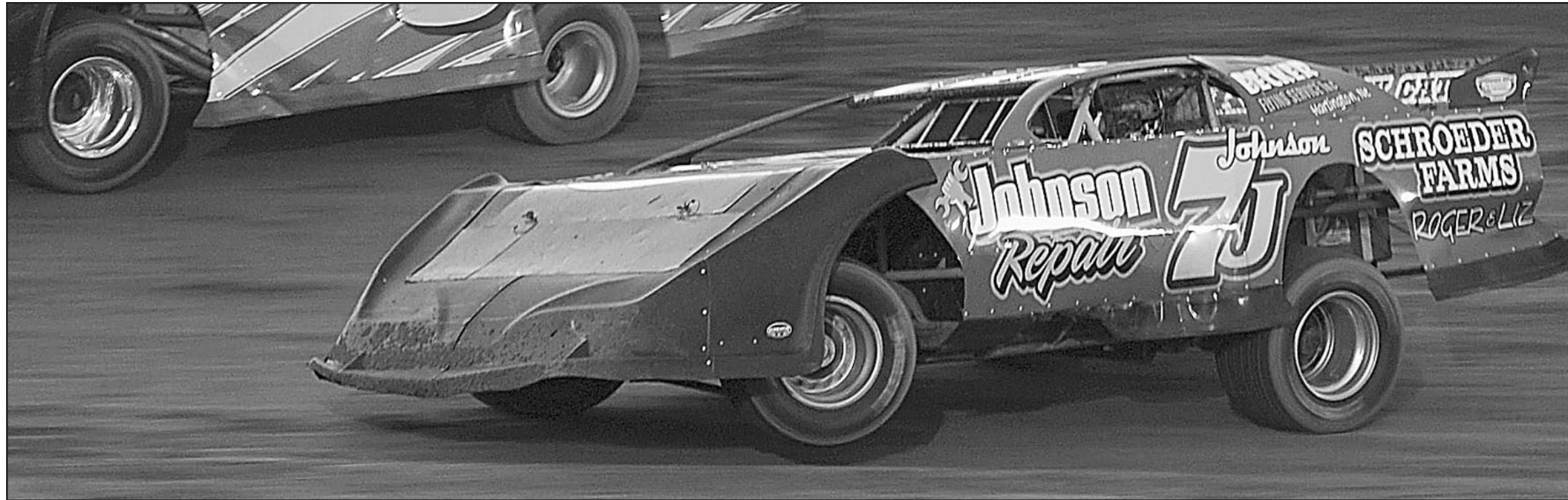
Haase made it by and Mielke had to change lines. Haase took his third win of the season matching Mielke's efforts.

Following a caution on lap 11, Chris Johnson ran the low side and Jim Johnson tried to run the high side.

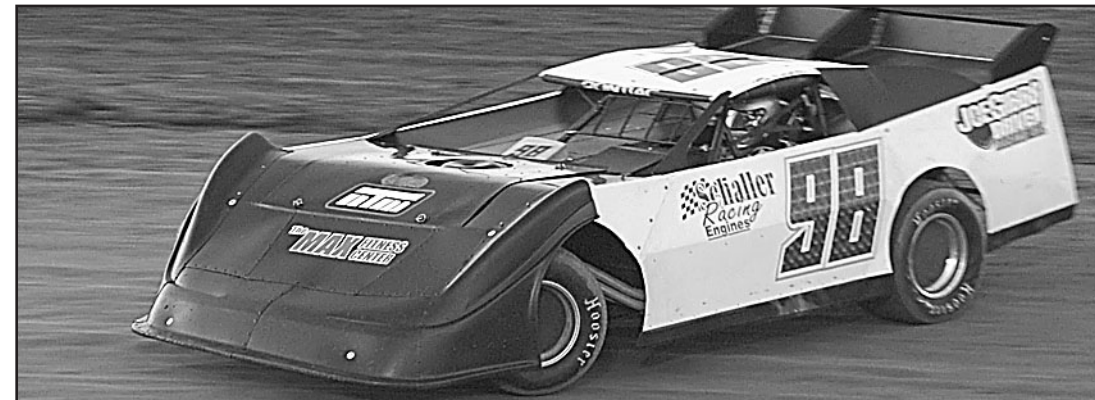
As the laps clicked down, Jim Johnson's car got faster. It was evident when Jim Johnson pushed his brother

Fourth went to Robert Osborne of Norfolk and rounding out the top 5 was Mike Benson of Wakefield.

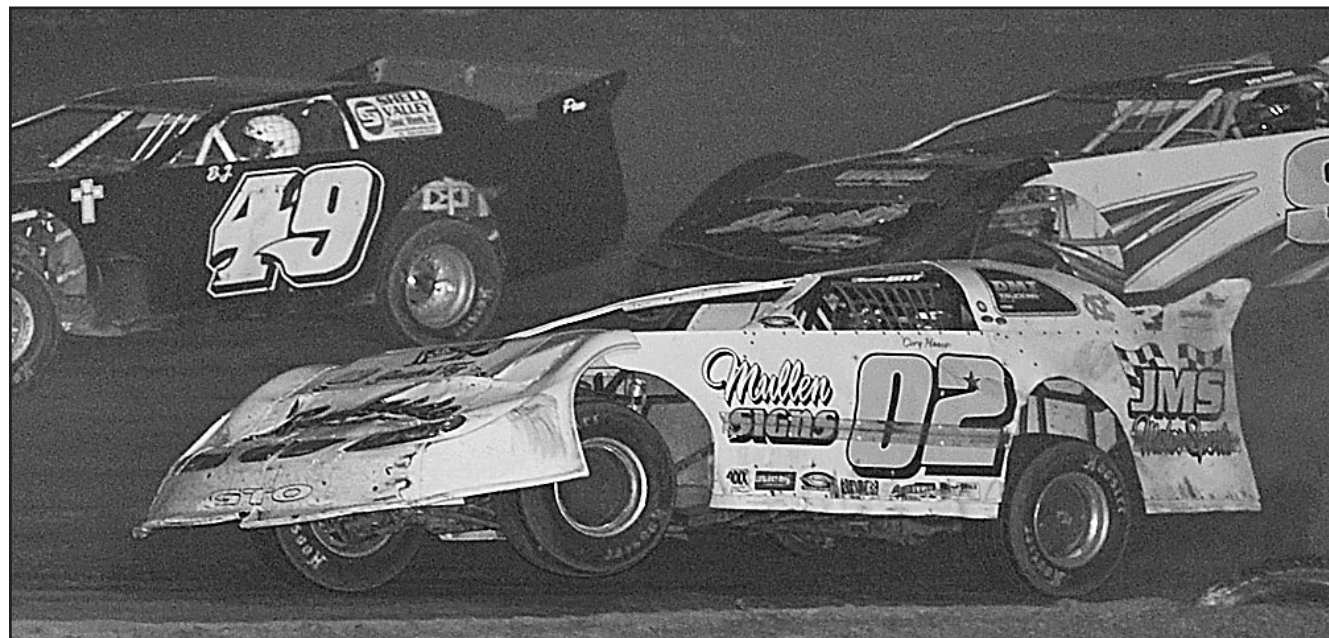
Will Schaller (98) made an appearance at the track. He finished 10th in the feature.
