




Terry Ronk (42) leads a group out of turn two during his heat race.

Pettitt came back to hold the




Brabec won, Weinrich was second. Tom Marksmeier of Norfolk placed third.

Mark Arduser of Battle placed fourth and Neil Bruns rounded out the top 5.



Following a lap five caution, Johnson was flag. challenged by Robert Osborne of Norfolk, but Johnson went back to work leaving the field behind.




