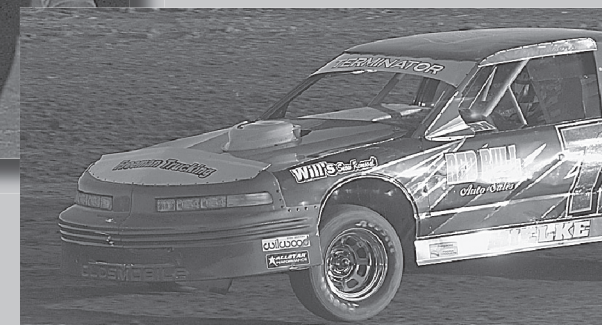

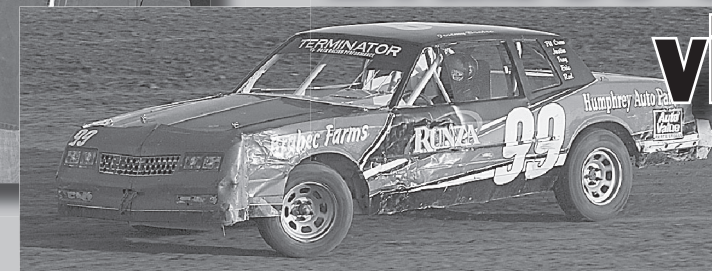

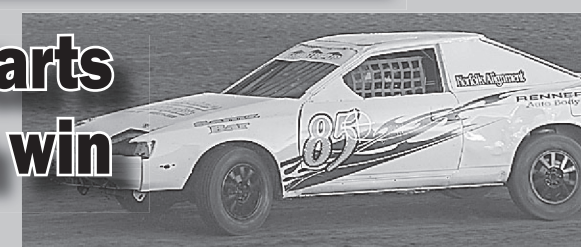

Neil Bruns (74) took home a fifth place, while Jim Kimmel (17) placed sixth.

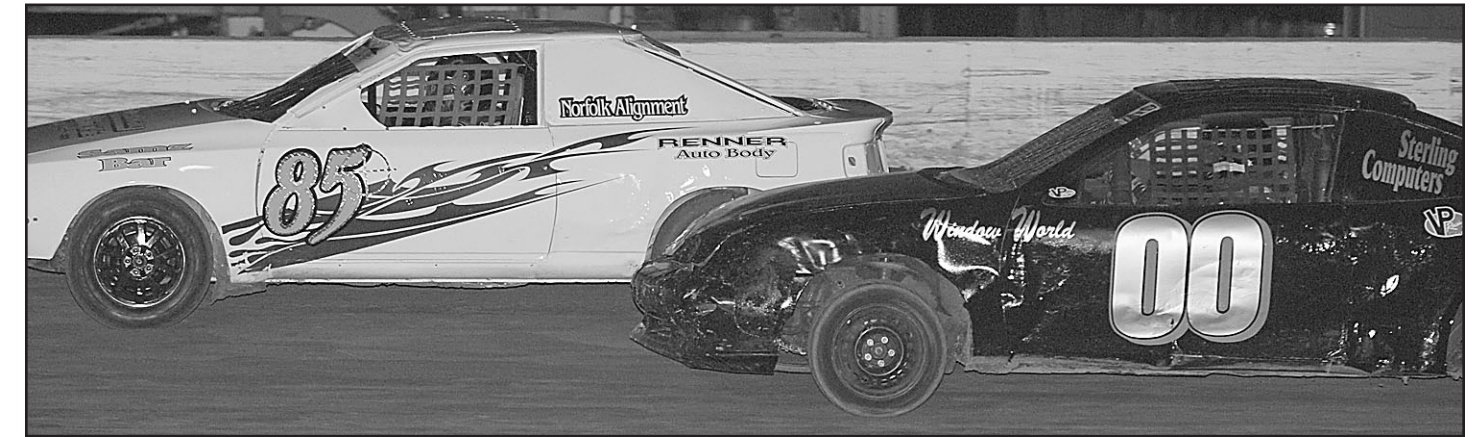


Terry Ronk (42) leads a group out of turn two during his heat race.

took home third, Shannon Pospisil of Norfolk was fourth and Larry Lehman of Norfolk round out the top 5.

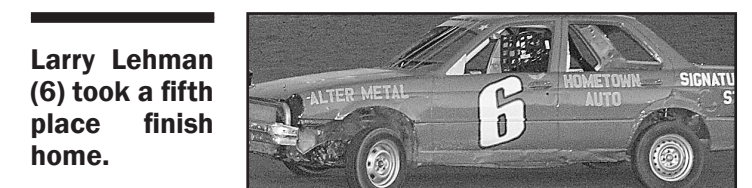

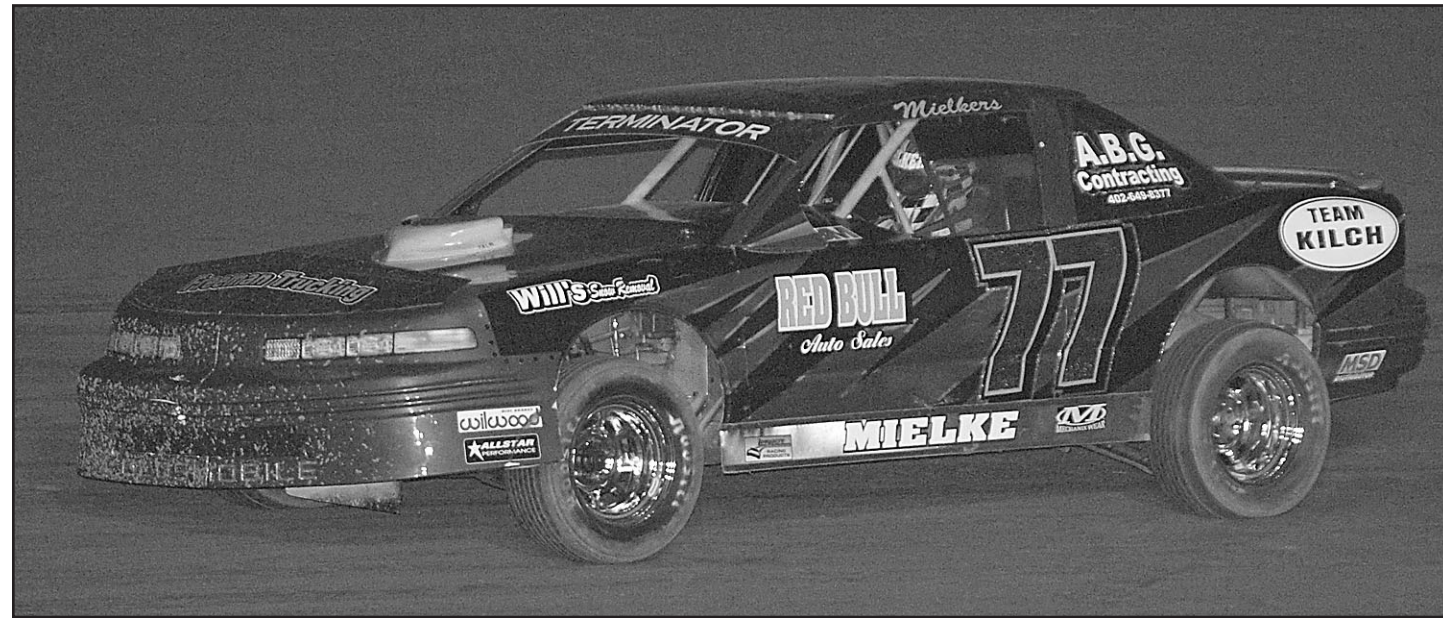

TeJay Mielke of Norfolk took the Street Stock division "A" feature. He blasted away from the field, but a late race caution bunched the field.

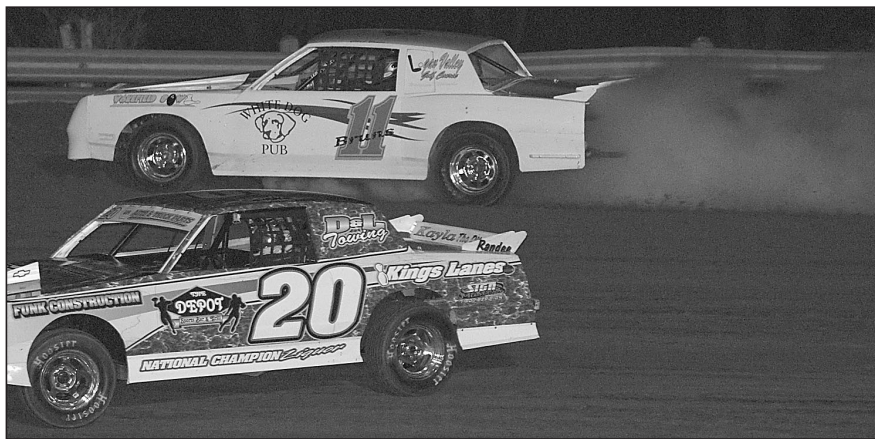
Troy Bruns of Wayne made an attempt on the restart, however, Mielke powered away from the field again.

Kimmel came back through the field to finish sixth.

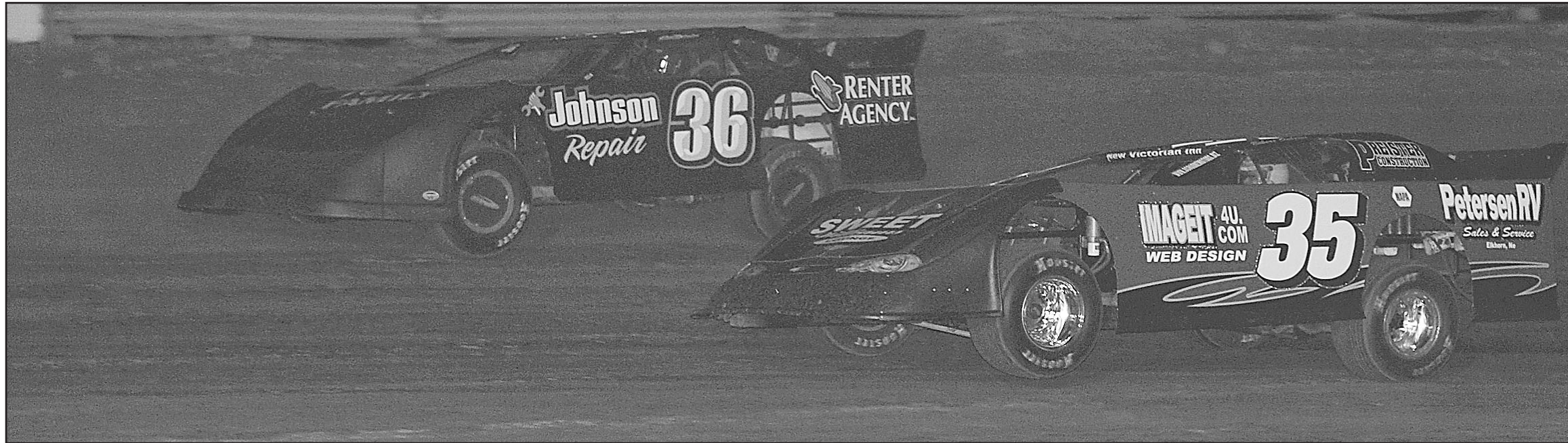


Jim Kimmel (17) loses a tire while battling for the win in the "A" feature. He recovered to finish sixth.



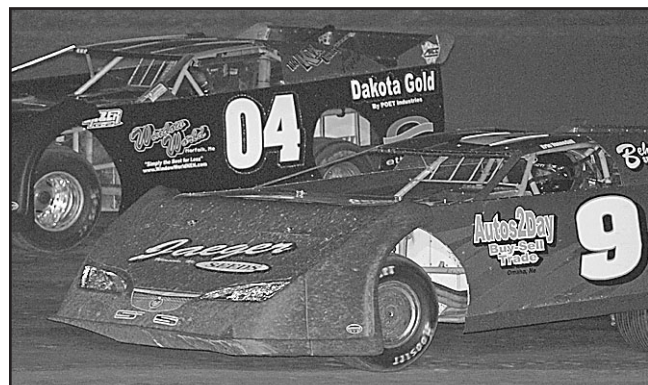
Kevin Haase (9) leads Tom Marksmeier (92) and Mark Arduser (4) down the frontstretch.

## Johnson claims season opener

Grand National driver Jim Johnson of Plainview led all 25 laps in the "A" feature to pick up his first win of the season.

Following a lap five caution, Johnson was challenged by Robert Osborne of Norfolk, but Johnson went back to work leaving the field behind.

Johnson said something broke on his car and he had to slow up to survive to the finish. His lead was large enough as he took the checkered flag.

Osborne took second. It was a good battle for third spot between Ben Sukup and Chad Jensen, both of Norfolk and Eric

Vanosdall of Winside.

After the final caution, Vanosdall held the position for eight laps, before Jensen made the pass. Vanosdall came back and had the position for five more laps.

Sukup then stuck his nose and would finish third. Vanosdall was fourth and Jensen was fifth.
