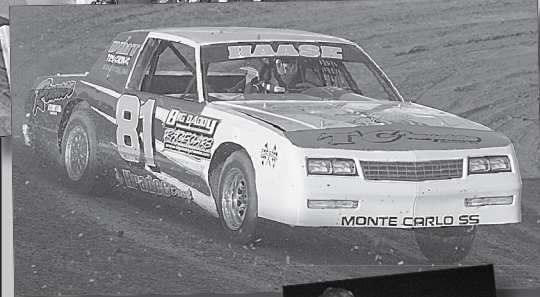

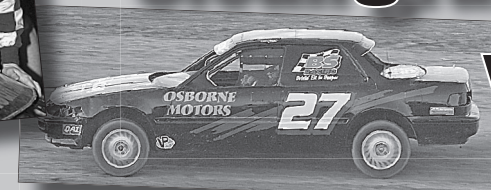

Doug Tomka of Stanton claimed the Grand National "A" feature, leading all 25 laps. Following a caution after lap four, Tomka pulled away from the field. Chris Johnson of Bloomfield restarted sixth and moved into the second by lap eight. Johnson went after Tomka. He closed the gap, but Tomka's lead was too great and he settled for second. Third went to Travis Birkley of Wakefield when he made a pass on Nick Opfer of Hartington, two laps from the end. Opfer finished fourth and Cory Haase of Norfolk rounded out the top 5. Tomka and Birkley each won their heat race. Tomka sits a top the points.

Jeremy Barg of Norfolk was fourth and Chase Osborne of Norfolk rounded out the top 5.



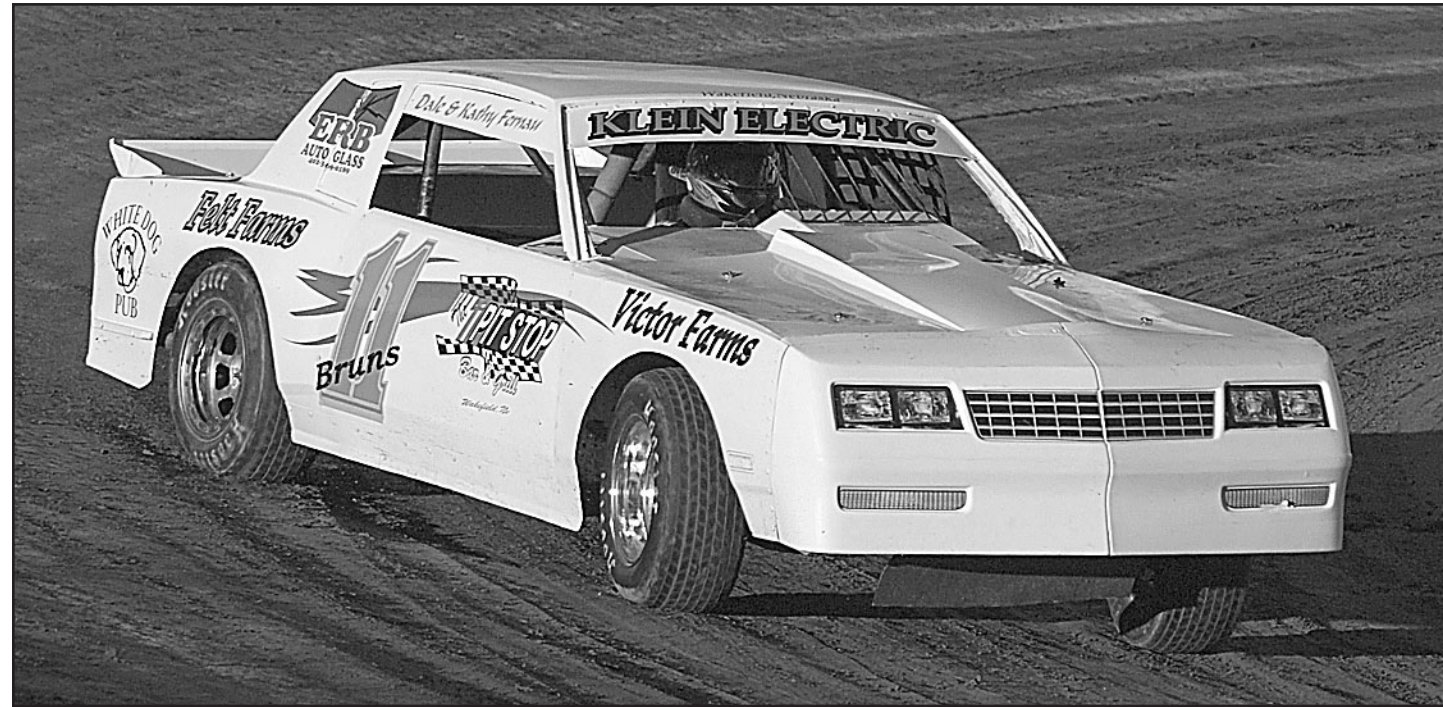
Grant Herbert (85) backed up his win from the previous night with a second place finish last week.

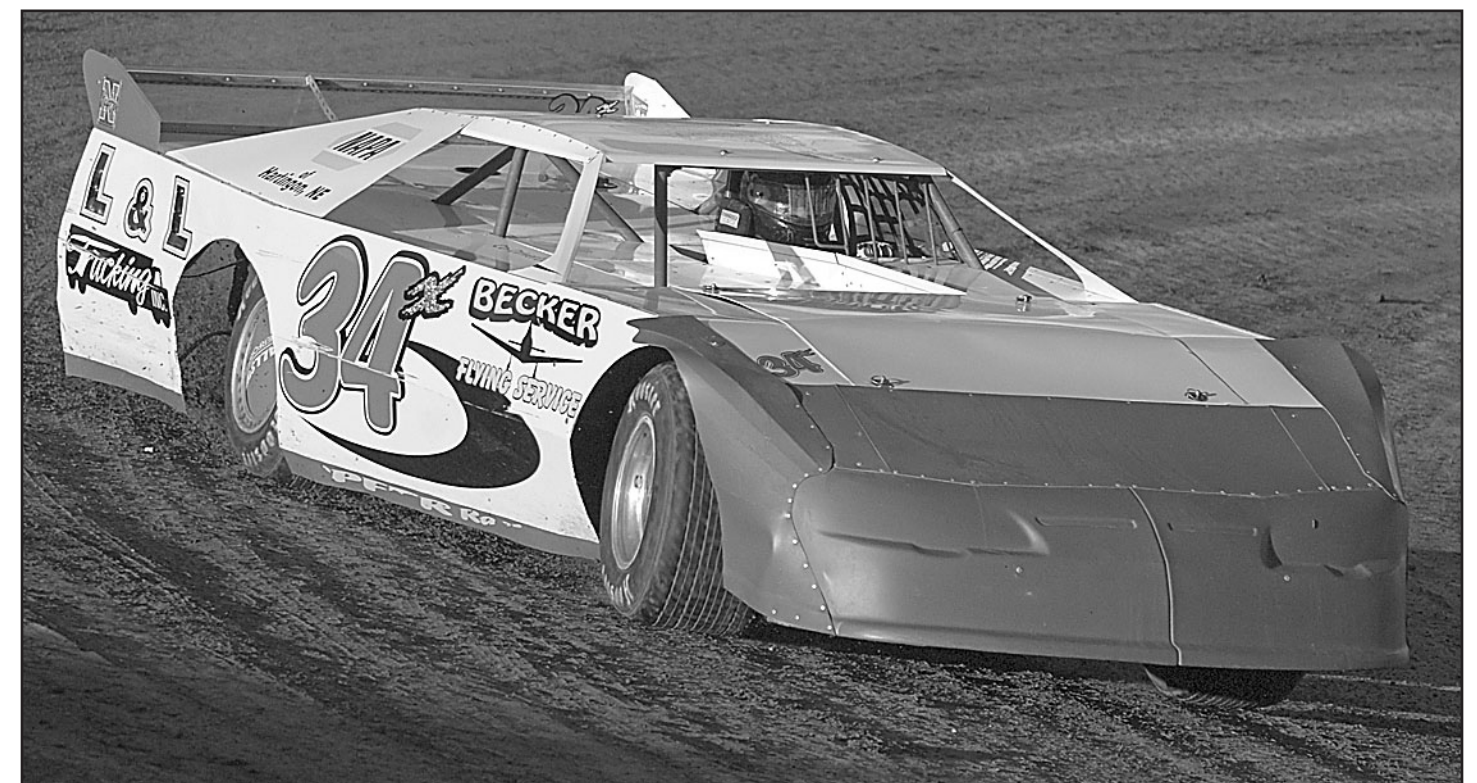

restart until Tate Weinrich of Hoskins slipped by on lap eight.

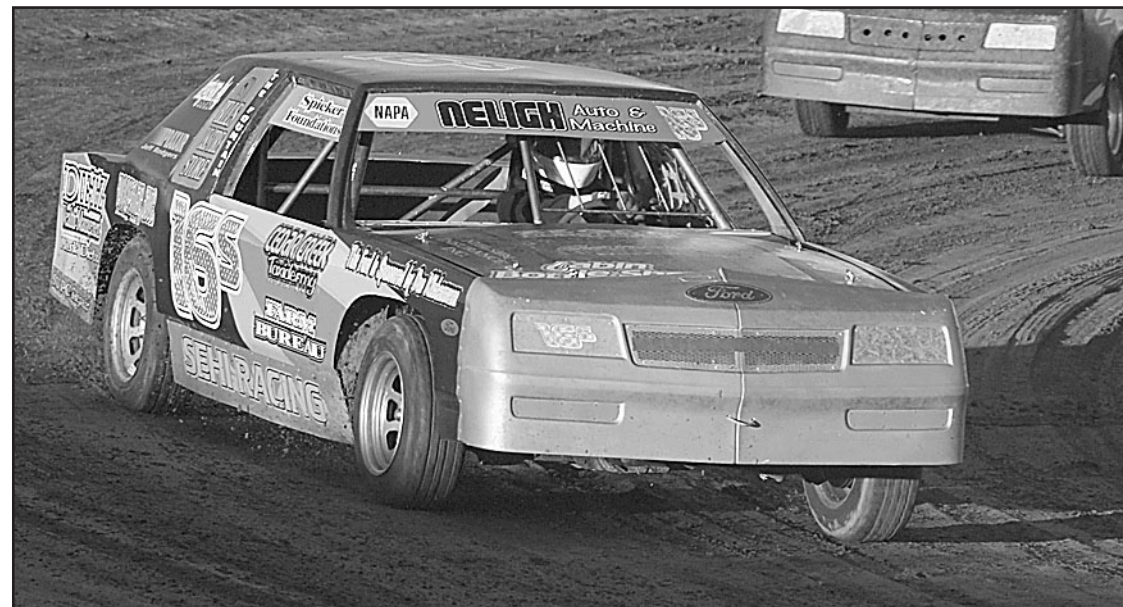
Three laps later Weinrich suffered a flat tire and pulled from the track giving Buck the second spot back.
